Sheep are barbados blackbelly crosses/ Drents heideschaap, ducks are kakhi  
campbell crosses,  
cattle are Holstein

Replacement fee sheep : 200 euro, replacement fee Ducks : 20 euro,  
replacement fee cattle : daily value  
Handlers meeting Trial 1 is at 8.30

Limited to 40 runs per judge per day.

**Entry information:**

- A dog may enter at any level for which it is trained, as long as it is 9 months old or older
- Any registration number will do, as long as you keep the same number for all AHBA trials. When you don't have any registration number, you can apply for a tracking number by using the AHBA tracking number request form from the AHBA website
- Costs Pre entry sheep and ducks 25 euro per run, Cattle 30 euro per run.
  - Day of ( if available) + 5 euro per run.
- Entry date July 19 no entries accepted before July 19. Entries close August 10

No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of DWAS.

Draw will be posted prior to start of trial.

Bitches in season will run in draw order.

Bitches in season will remain crated or in the car when not competing. Please consider the other contestants dogs.

All dogs must be on leash or crated when not competing.

Changes and/or substitutions, must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing the evening before the trial.

Any change requests, including substitutions, must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing the evening before the trial.

Entry fees will be refunded only when a dog has been certified by a licensed veterinarian as unable to compete due to sickness or injury. Owner will be responsible for all vet fees.

Run limits and judging assignments are subject to change.

Selling runs will not be permitted. If the trial is full and you wish to sell a run, the transaction must be handled by the trial secretary. All offers to buy or sell runs must be submitted in writing.

Please clean up after your dogs.

This trial is being held on private property. You understand by your attendance and/or entry that the Show/Trial Committee and Hosts have the right to refuse or excuse any entry or spectator for good cause. Good cause would be violation of the private property owners' rights or violation of the AHBA show rules. For the safety of your dogs and others all dogs must have current vaccinations

- **Awards:**

Qualifying ribbons for qualifying runs. Ribbons for place 1 through 4, Big Ribbon for High in Trial and High Combined ( score of all stock)

- **Food and drinks:**

Coffee, tea and cakes are free for everyone.

If you bring something it will be much appreciated.

Lunch will be available for a small donation to the club to cover the costs.

- **Directions to trial site:**

From Arnhem ( A12) take A 50 to Zwolle. Then A 28 towards Groningen/Meppel. Then A 32 towards Meppel/Leeuwarden. Exit Wolvega N 351 towards Oosterwolde. First roundabout take left ( N 353) to Oldeberkoop. Next roundabout take a right towards Gorredijk. ( N 380) At the curve keep going straight towards Jubbega. After 5 km. You come to Hoornsterzwaag. JJ RANCH is nr. 42 on your right.

### **Coursedescription HRD**

#### **Course Sheep/Cattle**

5 head of stock are set in the square pen.

#### **Sorting (15 points)**

Sort 3 animals to the holding pen. The sort is at gate "D"

Sorted stock go into pen 1

After the sort, let the 2 remaining join the 3 in pen 1

#### **Penwork (10 points)**

Take the stock out of the holding pen to the take pen.

Ends when stock are in the take pen and gate "E" is closed.

Take the stock from the take pen through gate "D" to the square pen.

Ends when the stock are in the square pen and gate "D" is closed.

#### **Specific task 1 (10 points)**

Take stock out into arena through gates "G". Feed the stock in the feeding tray.

Take dog with you (when stock are eating) to the pole at the top.

Ends when the handler is with the dog at the top of the arena at the pole.

#### **Gather (15 points)**

Pole is set at 150 ft.

For HRD I the dog may be taken to a point halfway between the designated handler's post and the stock, and the handler may go to within 15 ft. of the stock. For HRD II, the dog is set at the post, and the handler may go halfway to the stock. For HRD III, the dog and handler both are at the post.

Ends when the stock are near the pole.

#### **Spec task for Level III ( 10 points)**

Put stock in upper left corner pen and hold

#### **Chute work (10 points)**

Take the stock with you after the gather to the chute. Put the stock through the chute.

Ends when stock are through the chute.

Level I can fetch through the chute, Level II must drive from post to the chute. Level III must remain at the pole while dog drives stock through the chute

**Penwork 2 (10 points)**

Take the stock through gate "H" to the side pen. Let the stock out at the back to go to the duck pond 2 pen. Exit the duck pen at the other side to go into the yard. Use gate "I" to go into the duck pen.

Ends when you are at gate "J".

**Specific task 2 (15 points)**

Open gate "J" to take the stock to the yard. Then take the stock through the yard to gate "A" into the square pen.

Ends when the stock are in the square pen and gate "A" is closed.

**Penwork 3 (5 Points)**

Open gate "C". Gather stock from the square pen and push them through the alleyway (gate "F") to the holding pens.

Time ends when all gates are closed and dog and handler are back in the takepen.

Time allowed 21 minutes.

Warning at 10 minutes and 3 minute warning.

Tie breaker:

- Points on the sort
- Points on specific task 2.
- Points on the chute

Size of chute: Entrance 8ft, exit 4 ft, length = 16 ft Size of Pen 3 : 9 ft x 16 ft. Size HP = 12 x 12 ft Size SP 27 x 33 ft. Size AW : entrance 9 ft wide, exit 3 ft wide. Total length 20ft. Size of holdingpens 1 & 2 : 9 x 15 ft.

## Course Ducks

5 ducks are set in the takepen

**Sorting** (15 points)

Sort 3 ducks into the holdingpen

After the sort, let the 3 ducks join the 2 in the pen.

**Penwork** (10 points)

Take all ducks out of the take pen and settle the ducks at the back fence.

**Specific task 1** ( 10 points)

Put ducks in the circle and hold.

Take your dog with you to the pole.

**Gather** (15 points)

Pole is set at 75 ft.

Ends when the ducks are near the pole.

For HRD I the dog may be taken to a point halfway between the designated handler's post and the stock, and the handler may go to within 15 ft. of the stock. For HRD II, the dog is set at the post, and the handler may go halfway to the stock. For HRD III, the dog and handler both are at the post.

**Specific task for level III** (10 points)

Put ducks in left corner pen and hold

**Chutework** (10 points)

Take the ducks to the chute and put them through. Task end when the ducks are through the chute.

Level I can fetch through the chute, Level II must drive from post to the chute. Level III must remain at the pole while dog drives stock through the chute

**Specific task 2** (15 points)

From the chute, take the ducks to the side pen, close the gate and take them back out

**Penwork** (5 points)

Repen ducks in the takepen, then move them in the alleyway and shut the gate.

Time ends when dog and handler are in the arena and the takepen gate is closed.

Time for ducks 15 minutes 3 minute warning time at 12 minutes.

Ties will be broken by :

- Score on sorting work.
- Score on Specific task 2.
- Score on chutework.

Exit of chute 2 ft , length (not counting the wings) 8ft Entrance 6 ft Gate to pen B = 3ft.
