Uncontrolled nuisance barking dogs will be asked to leave.

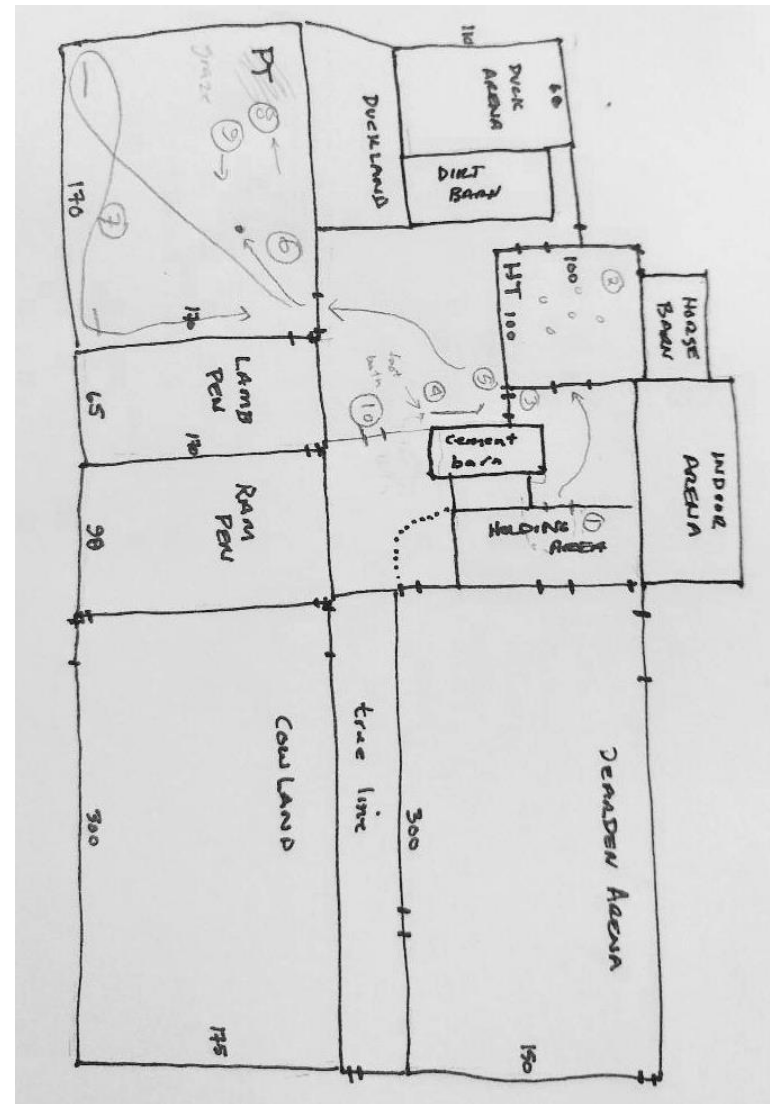
Duck runs in Trial D may be running concurrently with hooved stock runs in Trial C. Trial C will have priority in run order. Duck runs in Trial C may be running concurrently with hooved stock runs in Trial D. Trial D will have priority in run order.

Sheep Smith Farm – AHBA trial 10/21

- 1. 10 points: All levels:** Take pen and walk to HT
- 2. 10 points: All levels:** Go through barrel obstacle in HT
- 3. 10 points:** Sort 5 sheep out of HT – 5 marked for **Level III**, 2 marked for **Level II** any 5 for **level I**
- 4. 10 points:** Take the 5 (2) to narrow walk way and put through chute with footbat
- 5. 10 points:** Go get the 5 (8) remaining out of HT and reunite and take to PT gate – hold at gate – drive or fetch
- 6. 10 points (0) :** For Level III drive to a bucket 60 feet from gate– level II and level I immediately proceed to obstacle without drive and do not earn 10 points; obstacle is the PT obstacles in the corners
- 7. 10 points:** Do a half figure eight around the PT obstacles and bring sheep back to PT gate – drive or fetch
- 8. 10 points: Level III and II** drive sheep to graze from PT gate at duck pen 60 ft distance – have dog hold sheep – call off dog
- 9. 10 points:** Send dog on a gather from 120 ft distance at level III and II, level II handler may go to 60 ft.; dog is 60 ft. and handler can go to 15 ft at level I
- 10. 10 points:** Take sheep to re-pen at cement barn and exhaust and show a hold off the gate
