Moon Creek Farm AHBA HRD Trial Course is done with 10 sheep

Course time: 20 minutes All gates must be returned to their original configuration by the end of the course.

15 pts. 1) PEN WORK

Handler and/or dog enter the take pen gate and will need to move sheep from pen 1 into take pen then move sheep from pen 2 into pen 1 then move sheep from pen 3 into pen 2, then go to exhaust pen and move the sheep into pen 4. Handler and dog will exit through the exhaust pen into the arena. Exercise ends when the exhaust pen gate is closed.

15 pts. 2) GATHER

Take sheep out of take pen and set on the grain pan. Handler and dog go to appropriate post and send dog to gather the sheep, must bring sheep through the fetch panels. Exercise ends when sheep get to post A.

Level I - Handler will leave dog at post B and Handler may move within 15 feet of the sheep.

Level II - Handler will leave dog at post A and Handler may be anywhere between post A and B.

Level III - Handler and dog stay at post A. Handler stays at post A until sheep reach post A.

15 pts. 3) FETCH/DRIVE TO OBSTACLE #3 FOOT BATH

Handler and dog may fetch/drive the sheep to obstacle #3 the foot bath. Take sheep through the foot bath and then to gate A. Handler may not enter obstacle. Exercise ends when sheep enter through gate A and is closed

Level I - Handler and dog may fetch to the entrance of the foot bath. The handler may not enter the Obstacle.

Level II - Handler will stand at post A and drive the sheep through the foot bath. Handler may leave Post once the sheep reach the entrance to the foot bath either to assist your dog or go to gate A.

Level III - Handler will stand at post A and drive the sheep through the foot bath. Handler may leave post once the sheep are in the foot bath obstacle to go to gate A.

15 pts. 4) FIGURE 8 AND PANEL 2 FETCH/DRIVE

Handler and dog will enter the figure 8 through the middle and proceed to the right, go around the panel and back through the middle to the left, then around the panel and back through the middle of the figure 8 and proceed to panel 2. Exercise ends when sheep exit through gate B and gate is closed.

Level I – Handler and dog may fetch/drive to the figure 8 and to panel 2. Handler may not enter panel 2.

Level II – Handler and dog may fetch/drive to the figure 8 and to panel 2. Handler may not enter panel 2.

Level III – Handler and dog may fetch/drive to figure 8, after figure 8 is completed handler will stand in the middle of the figure 8 and drive the sheep to panel 2. Handler may leave the area when sheep exit the panel.

10 pts. 5) LANE DRIVE

Level III ONLY.....Handler and dog will take sheep out of gate C into the large field and go to the right and do a lane drive within the marked lane. Handler will stand at cone and drive/cross drive the sheep up through the lane. Exercise ends when sheep are returned to large arena and gate is closed.

15 pts. 6) FREE STANDING PEN

All levels will pen sheep. Exercise ends when sheep have been penned and now taken out, pen gate is closed.

15 pts 7) SORT

All levels will go to the exhaust pen and sort in any 5 sheep, close the gate and take the remaining 5 sheep away from the exhaust gate either by fetch or drive to the grain pan and then bring back to the exhaust pen and exhaust the remaining sheep. Exercise ends when gate is closed.
