Permission has been granted by the American Herding Breeds Association (AHBA) to hold the Trials under the AHBA rules and regulations. Open to all dogs of the herding breeds and multi-purpose breeds with herding background, as listed in the AHBA Breeds List. Dogs must be nine months of age or older on or before date of trial to compete.

STOCK: mix breed Hair sheep \$300, mix breed call ducks \$35

ENTRIES AND FEES: **Pre-Entries open 01/15/2022 and close 02/15/2022.** Checks payable to Cheryl Padgett.

Pre-Entries: \$55/HRD each sheep & mixed run, \$45/HTAD sheep run, \$35/HTAD duck run.

Saturday & Sunday trials limited to a maximum of 40 runs each. If trial fills, pre-entry compete runs take precedence over FEO runs, regardless of date received. Gate entries (if available) close ½ hour before each class begins. Entry limits may be adjusted based on pre-entries. Run orders will be drawn prior to the trial.

AWARDS: Qualifying Ribbons, 1st – 4th Placement Ribbons, High in Trial each day, Weekend High Combined Awards for each level will be calculated using dog's six highest scores.

Gates open at 7am. Parking in lower pasture only. Trial starts at 7:45 with meeting before each class.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- All trials will be conducted under the rules and regulations of AHBA. Rules are available at <http://www.ahba-herding.org>
- For Exhibition Only (FEO) runs are allowed at this trial, and you may run your dog in a class for which it has already qualified. Sanctioned runs take priority.
- A registration/tracking number is required for ALL dogs. If your dog is not registered with another organization (AKC, UKC, ABCA, etc.), you must apply for a registration number with AHBA.
- Bitches in season will run in draw order.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. Entry fees will only be refunded if the refund request is received before the pre-entry closing date, no entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot be opened or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Acts of God, or public emergency. Substitutions allowed with dogs that you own.
- The host and/or their agents shall assume no responsibility for injury to participant, spectator or dog.
- Judges may be substituted.
- All dogs must always be leashed or crated except when competing. Please clean up after your dogs.
- For the safety of your dogs and others all dogs must have current vaccinations against rabies, distemper/parvo, you are asked to bring a copy of the rabies certificate with you.
- There will be a \$35.00 service charge for any returned checks.

Hardrock Farm AHBA Trial – HRD Sheep

Time: 15 minutes, warnings at 7 and 3 minutes

Tie Breaker: #1 GATHER, #2 SORT, #3 DRIVE, #4 TIME

Tasks must be attempted in order. Handler is responsible for resetting all gates including chute back gate and head gate.

Course will start with 5 head of stock in Pens 5, 6, 7 and 8, small amount of feed in feed bunk and all course gates reset.

Task	Possible Score
Handler is responsible to place feed in feed bunk on way out to report to judge at start of run.	
PEN #1 – move stock from Pen Specified by Judge through Front Alley into Pen 1 <i>Starts when handler opens gate of Judge Specified Pen, ends with stock in Pen 1 and gate closed</i>	5
PEN #2 – move stock from Pen 1 to Pasture <i>Starts when Pen #1 is complete, ends with stock in Pasture and gate closed</i>	5
DRIVE – move stock to feed bunk, call dog off and move towards Obstacle HRD III handler must stay behind dog, HRD II must not be in front of dog, HRD I handler may move anywhere <i>Starts when Pen #2 is complete, ends with stock is settled at feed bunk with dog and handler near obstacle.</i>	15
FREESTANDING OBSTACLE #1 – move stock through Obstacle, Wide Alley and into Pen B <i>Starts when Drive is complete, ends with stock in Pen B and gates closed</i>	15
GATHER and HRDIII FREESTANDING OBSTACLE #2 – send dog to gather stock into Front Alley Stock will be pushed out of Pen B for Gather HRD III dog and handler go to obstacle, where the handler remains while dog is sent to gather the stock, stock should be gathered to Free Standing Obstacle #2, pass through the obstacle and moved into Front Alley HRD II/HRD I dog and handler may go halfway to stock where the dog remains, HRDI handler may move up halfway towards stock before sending dog, stock is gathered and taken into Front Alley <i>Starts when dog leaves for gather, ends with stock in Front Alley and gate closed</i>	15
PEN #3 – move stock from Front Alley through Pen 1 into Pen 2 <i>Starts when Gather is complete, ends with stock in Pen 2 and gate closed</i>	5
HRD III ONLY SORT – sort 3 head into Pen 3 from Pen 2, then reunite all in Pen 2 Sort direction at handler's discretion <i>Starts when Pen #3 is complete, ends with stock in Pen 2 and gate closed</i>	10
FOOTBATH OBSTACLE – move stock from Pen 2 thru Footbath into Pen 4 <i>Starts when Pen #3/Sort is complete, ends with stock in Pen 4</i>	15
CHUTE OBSTACLE – move stock from Pen 4 thru Chute and Back Alley into open pen <i>Starts when Footbath is complete, ends with stock re-penned and all gates reset</i>	15

Hardrock Farm AHBA Trial – HRD Mixed Sheep & Ducks

Time: 15 minutes, warnings at 7 and 3 minutes

Tie Breaker: #1 GATHER, #2 SORT, #3 DRIVE, #4 TIME

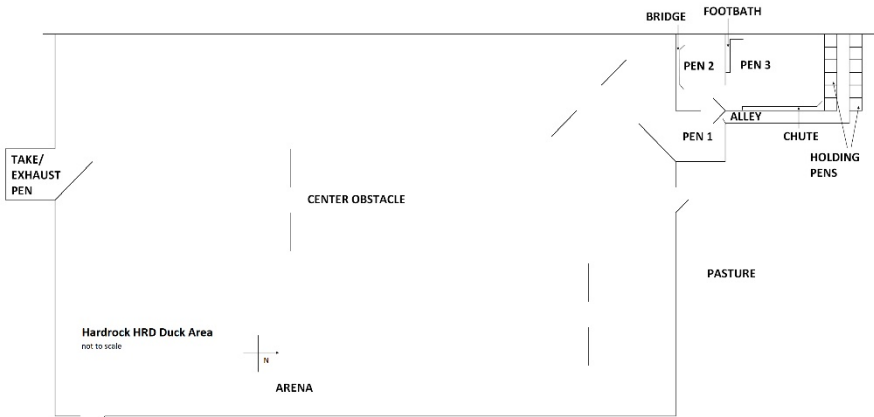
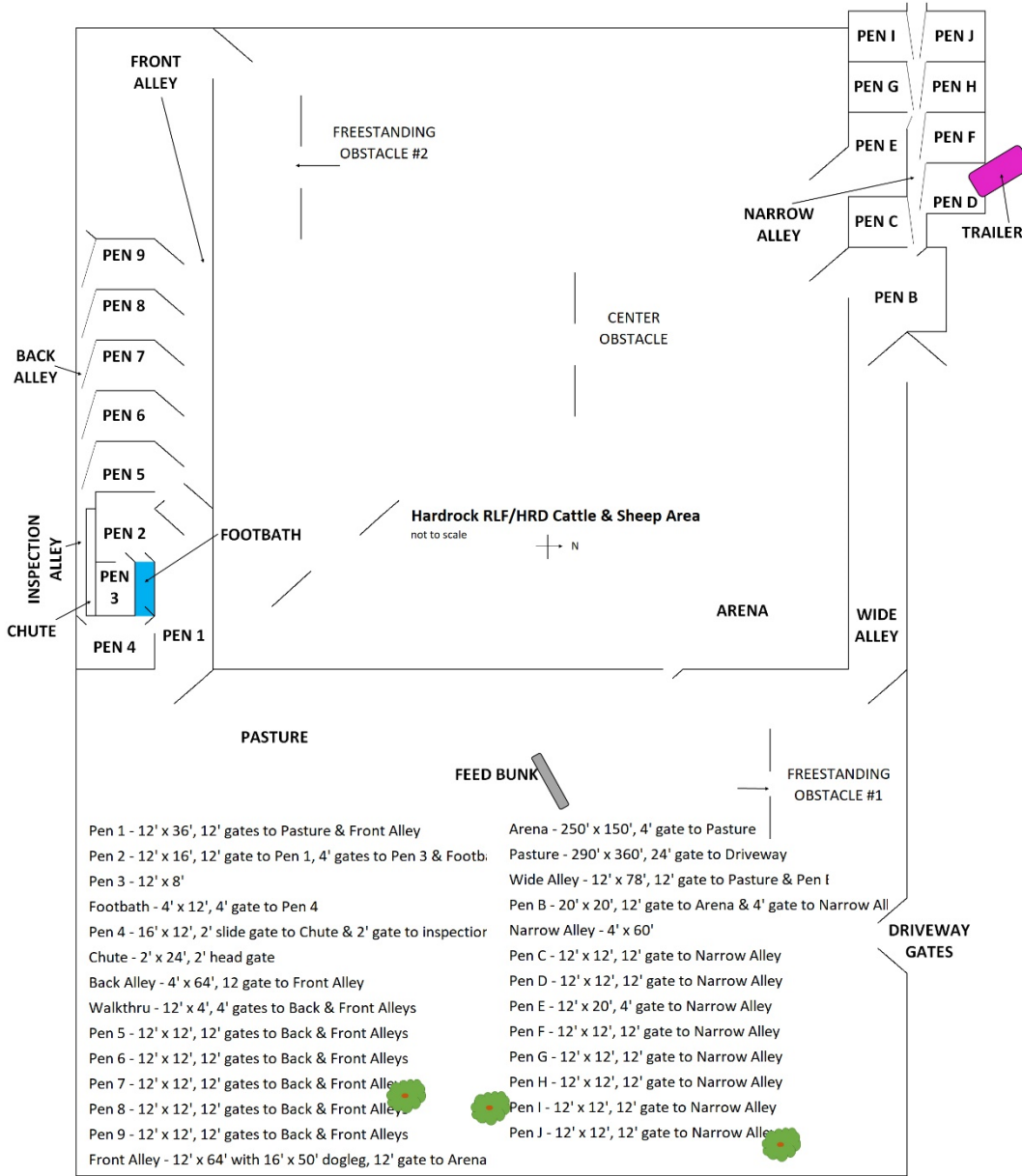
Tasks must be attempted in order. Handler is responsible for resetting all gates including chute back/head gates.

Course will start with 5 head of sheep in Pens G, H, I and J with Trailer gate open, 5 head of ducks will be set out for Gather and all gates reset.

Task	Possible Score
SHEEP PEN #1 – move stock from Judge Specified Pen through Narrow Alley into Pen B <i>Starts when handler opens gate Judge Specified Pen, ends with stock in Pen B and gate closed</i>	5
HRD III ONLY SHEEP SORT – sort 3 head into Pen C from Pen B, then reunite all in Pen B Sort direction at handler's discretion <i>Starts when Pen #1 is complete, ends with stock in Pen B and gate closed</i>	10
SHEEP DRIVE – move stock into Arena and Drive to Freestanding Obstacle HRD III handler must stay behind dog, HRD II must not be in front of dog, HRD I handler may move anywhere <i>Starts when Pen #1/Sort is complete, ends with stock is near obstacle.</i>	15
SHEEP FREESTANDING OBSTACLE #1 – move stock through Obstacle and into Pen B <i>Starts when Drive is complete, ends with stock in Pen B and gates closed</i>	15
SHEEP TASK #1 TRAILER – move stock from Pen B through Narrow Alley and Pen D to load stock into trailer Unload stock and move stock back through Pen D and Narrow Alley into Pen B (leave trailer open) <i>Starts when Freestanding Obstacle is complete, ends with stock in Pen B and gate closed</i>	10
SHEEP PEN #2 – move stock from Pen B through Narrow Alley into open pen Advanced handler stays at gate while dog moves stock out of pen, Open handler may move anywhere <i>Starts when Trailer is complete, ends with stock in open pen and all gates reset</i>	5
Time will stop when gate for SHEEP PEN #2 is closed. Time will restart when DUCK GATHER starts.	
DUCK GATHER & HRDIII ONLY FREESTANDING OBSTACLE #2 Send dog to gather stock into Pen 1 HRDIII handler must stay behind cone until dog is sent and must bring stock through Freestanding Obstacle. HRD II/HRD I dog and handler may go halfway to stock where the dog remains, HRDI handler may move up halfway towards stock before sending dog, stock is gathered and taken into Pen 1 <i>Starts when dog leaves for Gather, ends with stock in Pen 1 and gate closed</i>	15
DUCK PEN #3 – move stock from Pen 1 through Pen 2 into Pen 3 <i>Starts when Gather is complete, ends with stock in Pen 3 and gate closed</i>	5
DUCK CHUTE – move stock into Chute for inspect/doctor Advanced handler treats stock for parasites, Open handler inspects stock, release into Pen 3 <i>Starts when Pen #3 is complete, ends with stock in Pen 3 and Chute gates closed</i>	15
DUCK PEN #4 – move stock from Pen 3 through Pens 2 & 1 into Alley <i>Starts when Chute is complete, ends with stock in Pen 2 and all gates reset</i>	5

Hardrock Farm AHBA Saturday Trial – HTAD Course 5 Sheep & Ducks

Time: sheep 10 minutes, warning at 3 minutes

ducks 7 minutes, warning at 2 minutes

Task Possible Score

GATHER/TAKE PEN

10

GATHER ON SATURDAY – stock will be setout, all levels will Gather to Obstacle #1

Level I set dog halfway between Obstacle #1 and stock and then handler may move within 15' of stock.

Level II set the dog at Obstacle #1 and then handler may move halfway to the stock.

Level III dog and handler must stay at Obstacle #1.

TAKE PEN ON SUNDAY – all levels will pull the stock out of the pen, then continue to Obstacle #1

Level I may go into the pen and help dog if needed.

Level II may go into the pen but may NOT help the dog.

Level III may not go into the pen.

OBSTACLE #1 – all levels put the stock thru the obstacle, then continue to Obstacle #2

FETCH/DRIVE – all levels will take the stock towards Obstacle #2 past “drive line”

15

Level I may accompany stock.

Level II may accompany stock half the distance, then must drive the remainder.

Level III must stay at Obstacle #1 and drive stock.

OBSTACLE #2 – all levels put the stock thru the obstacle, then continue to Obstacle #3

10

OBSTACLE #3 – all levels put the stock thru the obstacle, then continue to Obstacle #4

10

OBSTACLE #4 – all levels put the stock thru the obstacle, then continue to Hold

15

HOLD – all levels will hold stock in designated area, then continue to Sort/Repen

GATE SORT/RIBBON PULL

10

Level III ONLY.

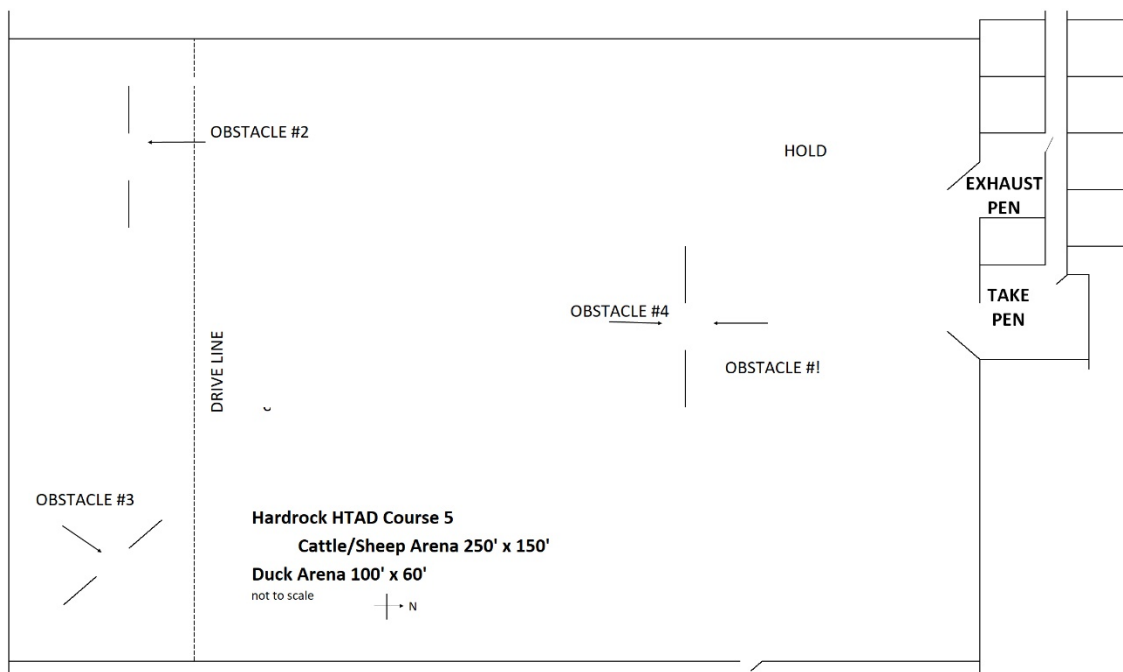
SHEEP GATE SORT ON SATURDAY – Sort 2 head into Exhaust Pen

SHEEP RIBBON PULL ON SUNDAY – Pull ribbon from sheep

DUCK GATE SORT BOTH DAYS – Sort 2 head into Exhaust Pen

REPEN – all levels will repen stock into Exhaust Pen from Arena

No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any Test/Trial. Bitches in season shall run in drawn running order without adjustment.
