PRE -ENTRIES OPEN MAY 18

Pre-entries postmarked before MAY 18, 2022 will not be accepted. Entries must have clearly visible USPS postmark with the date. Pre-entries must be postmarked on/before close date of JUNE 08 , 2022. No metered mail, telephone, facsimile, email or incomplete entries will be accepted. The entry limit per judge (40/day) will be accepted in postmark order. If a class is full the dog will be put on a waiting list in order of receipt. Day of Trial Entries (if available) accepted up to 30 minutes before trial start

Ⓢ Bitches in season will run last. They should be crated away from trial arenas when not competing.

Ⓢ All dogs must be on leash when not competing.

Ⓢ Trial committee will draw run order prior to the trial.

Ⓢ Entry fees will only be refunded if request is received on or before pre-entry closing date (June 07).

ELIGIBILITY

All dogs nine months of age or older are eligible to participate in Herding Trials and JHD. No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any Test/Trial. Bitches in season shall run last.

ENTRIES & FEES :

⌚ In the event that any dog is deemed absent prior to JUNE 17, 2022, its' trial slot(s) will be filled from the waiting list and any entry fee(s) will be refunded to the original entrant only, unless the original entrant provides a substitute dog. Substitutions will be allowed if the substitute dog is owned by the original entrant.

⌚ Entry fees will not be refunded after JUNE 07, 2022 in the event a dog is absent, disqualified by a judge, or barred from competition by the trial committee. Entry fees will be refunded if excused in writing by a veterinarian.

⌚ Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God, public emergencies, acts of public enemy, strikes or other causes beyond the control of FLORIDA WORKING DOG CLUB INC.

⌚ Selling runs is not permitted unless the trial is full. All offers to buy or sell runs must be submitted to the show secretary

⌚ BLACK BIRCH FARM SOUTH will deposit entry fees in our bank account on or about JUNE ,08 2022. Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be considered a void entry. There is a \$25 service charge for returned checks. If entries are resubmitted, payment must be in the form of cash, Money Order or Cashiers' Check.

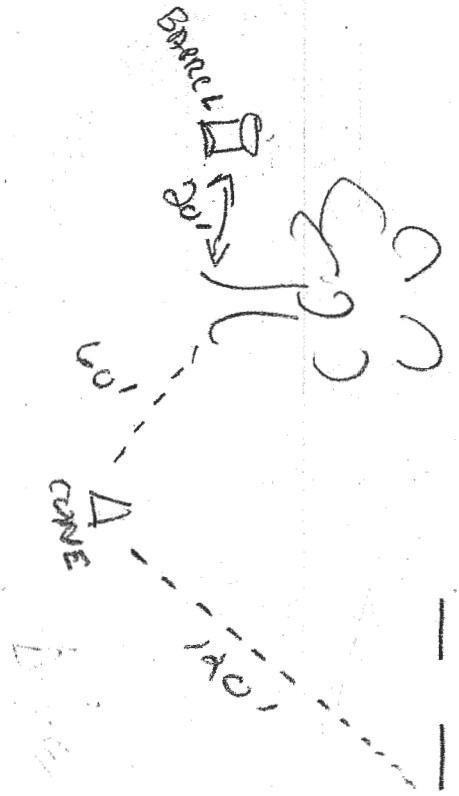

24 AVAILABLE RUNS –TIME LIMIT IS 15 MIN

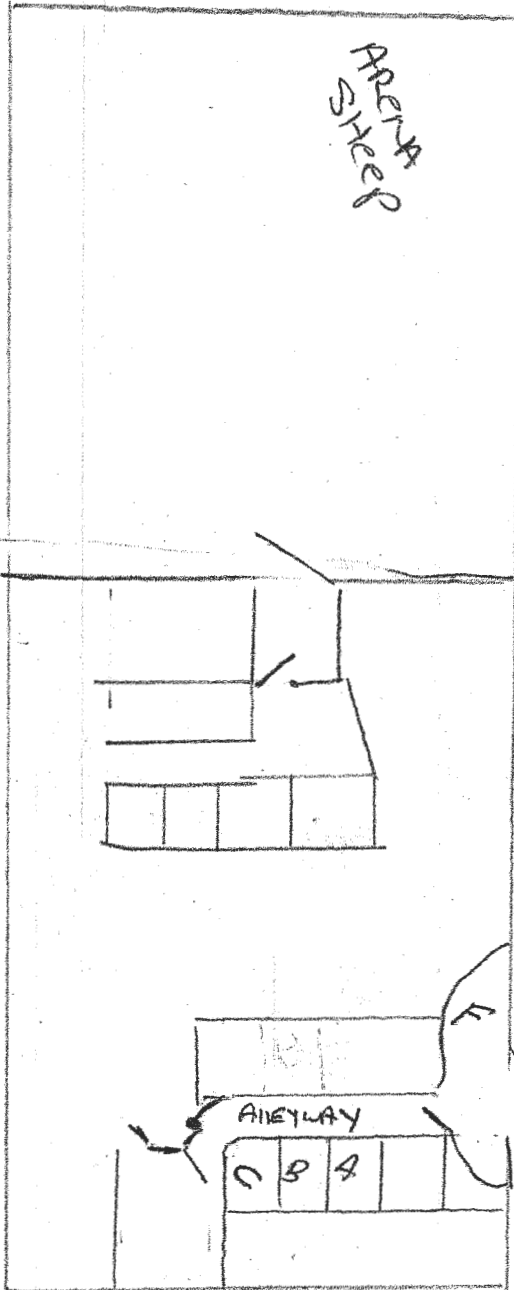
1. Take 9 sheep from Pen a,b, c or d- level 3 handlers may not go in the pen to assist, Level 2 may assist just inside the gate and Level 1 handlers may go inside to assist dog. No handlers may touch the livestock to assist. Level 1 handlers can bring their dogs in to the pen on line, but must remove the line to remove the stock. The pen gate may or may not be closed and it will depend on where the sorted sheep get assigned..Scoring ends when last sheep exits the pen.
2. Move them down alleyway to Pen F. scoring ends when gate to Pen F is closed
3. Gate sort 3 back into alleyway back to an assigned pen. Level 3 must sort marked sheep. Level 2 must sort 1 marked sheep and 2 unmarked. Level 3 may sort any 3 sheep. Scoring ends at Close of sort gate.
4. Take the 6 sheep from Pen F and (level 3) drive approx 120 ft thru center of panels. level 2 handlers must be 30 ft away from the 2 panels, Level 1 can fetch thru the panels. Scoring begins at Pen F gate open and ends when sheep are settled after the panel.
5. Leave the sheep and return to cone level 3 for a gather.
level 2 can go halfway and level 1 can be within 15 ft of sheep. Sheep will need to turn around the cone and then move onto Step 6. Scoring begins when the dog leaves the handler for the outrun and ends when the stock goes around the cone.
6. Drive or fetch them back to tree and sheep must go between the tree and the barrel. Scoring ends 10 ft after sheep exit between tree and barrel.
7. Drive or fetch back to Pen F and put sheep back into original pen with the 3 sheep you sorted on step 2. close all gates. Scoring ends when sheep are all back in the same pen.
