- All dogs must be on leash or crated when not competing. Please clean up after your dogs. Please bring proof of vaccinations for your dog(s).
- Bitches in season will run last. Please make sure trial secretary is notified upon arrival.
- Depending on the number of pre-entries, judges may work only one day or divide the load over 2 days.

**Directions...**We are slightly less than one hour north of Chattanooga, TN and more than an hour from Knoxville, TN. Because there is no residence at trial site GPS will only get you close at 2505 Cottonport Rd. Dayton, TN 37321. Please read the directions below.

From Dayton...take HWY 30 East towards Athens. You will go approximately 4 miles and begin looking for street sign for Cottonport Rd. on your right. Turn right and go just over 2.5 miles until you see a road sign for Purser Rd. on your right.

From Interstate 75...Take Athens Exit #49. This is Tennessee State Highway 30. Take HWY 30W until you cross the Tennessee River. You will pass Rocky Market on your left. Just beside Rocky Market is a street sign for Cottonport Rd. DO NOT TURN HERE. You will go another 2.5 miles and see another Cottonport Rd. street sign on your left. Turn here and go just over 2.5 miles until you see a road sign for Purser Rd. on your right.

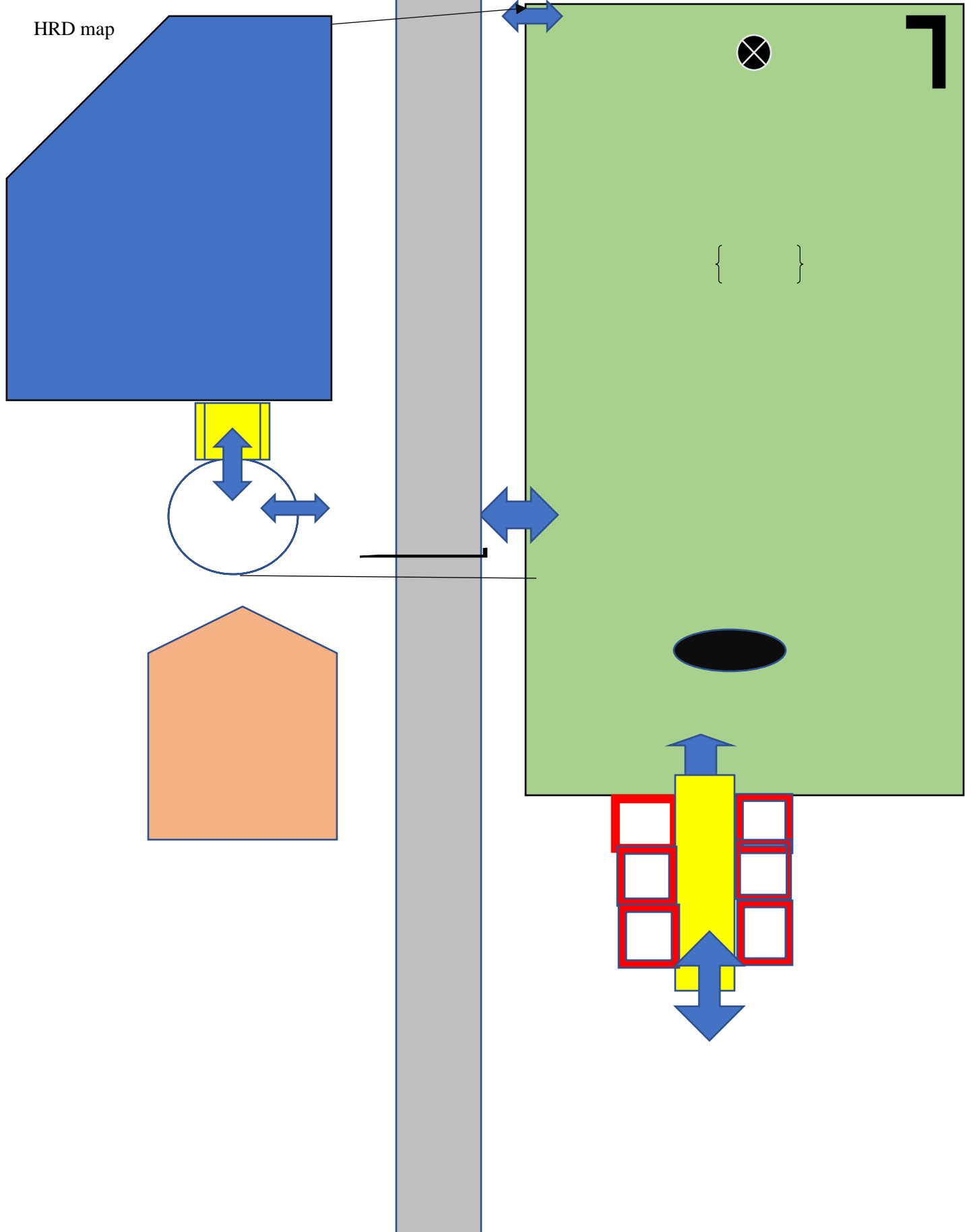
**YOU will turn left onto a gravel road directly across the road from Purser Road sign. Onto Dixie Roads Farm. Cottonport Road in Rhea County makes an 8 mile loop so it can be confusing.** Please call Tommye Ann if you need assistance

## Course Description-Herding Ranch Dog

1. **Take Pen** 5 sheep will be in holding pens. The judge will direct you to a pen number. you will move the sheep into sorting alley and close holding pen gate. Level III handler may not enter holding pen. Level II handler may enter pen but not assist dog. Level I handler may enter and assist dog in moving sheep to sort alley. All levels will take sheep from Sort Alley to feeder. Small feed bags may be picked up before entering take pen Handler will call dog away from sheep to walk with handler to handler's post. (big tree) **5 points**
2. **Outrun, Lift and Fetch** All levels will send dog to gather sheep from feed bunk take thru panels and then bring behind handler's post. Level III handler must remain at post for outrun, fetch and gather. Level II handler may walk halfway between handler's post and feed bunk. Level I handler may be no closer than 15 feet from sheep. **15 points**
3. **Obstacle 1** sheep should go thru panels **10 points**
4. **Obstacle 2** All levels will drive sheep from handler's post to corner footbath (obstacle 2) Level III handlers may only leave handler's post after dog passes in front of handler after circling handler's post. All handlers must walk behind dog but may not walk thru footbath.)All levels may assist dog with the footbath (Obstacle 2) and then take sheep thru corner gate A. All handlers should enter this area in control of stock.**15 points**
5. **Drive** dog will drive sheep down dirt road. All handlers must stay behind dog until sheep pass the corner post of triangled field. **10 points**
6. **Obstacle 3 Y Chute** All levels shall put sheep thru alley chute where handler should review overall health of sheep and check eartags. **15 points**
7. **Round pen** Sheep will be placed in round pen. **5 points**
8. **Sort** Level III handlers will sort the 2 lambs from group using the sorting area . **10 points**
9. **Hold** All levels will take 5 sheep from the round pen across gravel road and back to sorting alley of holding pens. Judge will direct handler's as to hold area...once judge calls hold, Handler should walk to sorting alley gate and reopen sheep in sorting alley.**15points**

### Course Map is Color Coded

Green	Hooved Arena	120*280*140*302
Red	Holding Pens	Each of the 6 pens is 16*16
Yellow	Sorting Alley	16*48 this is attached to the holding pens with 16 ft gates
Blue	Gates	Look for blue arrows gates may be 16 ft, 12 ft or 8 ft
Grey	Gravel Road	Approximately 8 ft wide
Black	Obstacles	12 or 8 ft panels with 2 ft alley width 12 ft between drive panels
Blue Outline	Round Pen	50 ft diameter
Yellow	Sort Pen	12x18
Brownish	Feed bunk and x marks the handler's post which is a large tree.	
Light Orange	Pavilion	24*36
