If you are using a GPS – don't put 'Hope' into the city function. Put "search all", and then choose the address that is found in "Fraser Valley".

Our farm is located about 15 km west of Hope, British Columbia in a beautiful valley surrounded by mountains. We are in an area where Hwy #1 parallels the mighty Fraser River on one side, and mountains on the other. Downriver is on the mountain side of the freeway. You can get there from either of the following exits:

Heading westbound on Hwy #1:

Take **exit #160** that says "Laidlaw, Hunter Creek, Rest area", go under the freeway and turn right at the first road (there's a stop sign at the exit, don't turn there or you'll go onto the freeway the wrong way!! Go to the next stop sign & turn right)). You are now running parallel with the freeway heading towards Chilliwack. Go about 4 km, and turn Left at McKay Road. First driveway on the right - long driveway, blue house, blue barns, blue garage, blue heelers, but happy people!!

Heading eastbound on Hwy #1:

Take the **exit #153** that says "Jones Lake, Laidlaw". Exit veers to the right - you are now running parallel with the Freeway, still heading towards Hope. 2 kms approx and right on McKay road. 1st driveway on the right - long driveway - blue buildings! Only farm that has sheep.

Some Travel Trivia: *The exit numbers begin at '0' at Horseshoe Bay, and express how many kilometers each exit is from Horseshoe Bay. Therefore, if you pass exit #140, you'll know that you only have 13 km left to go. ☺*

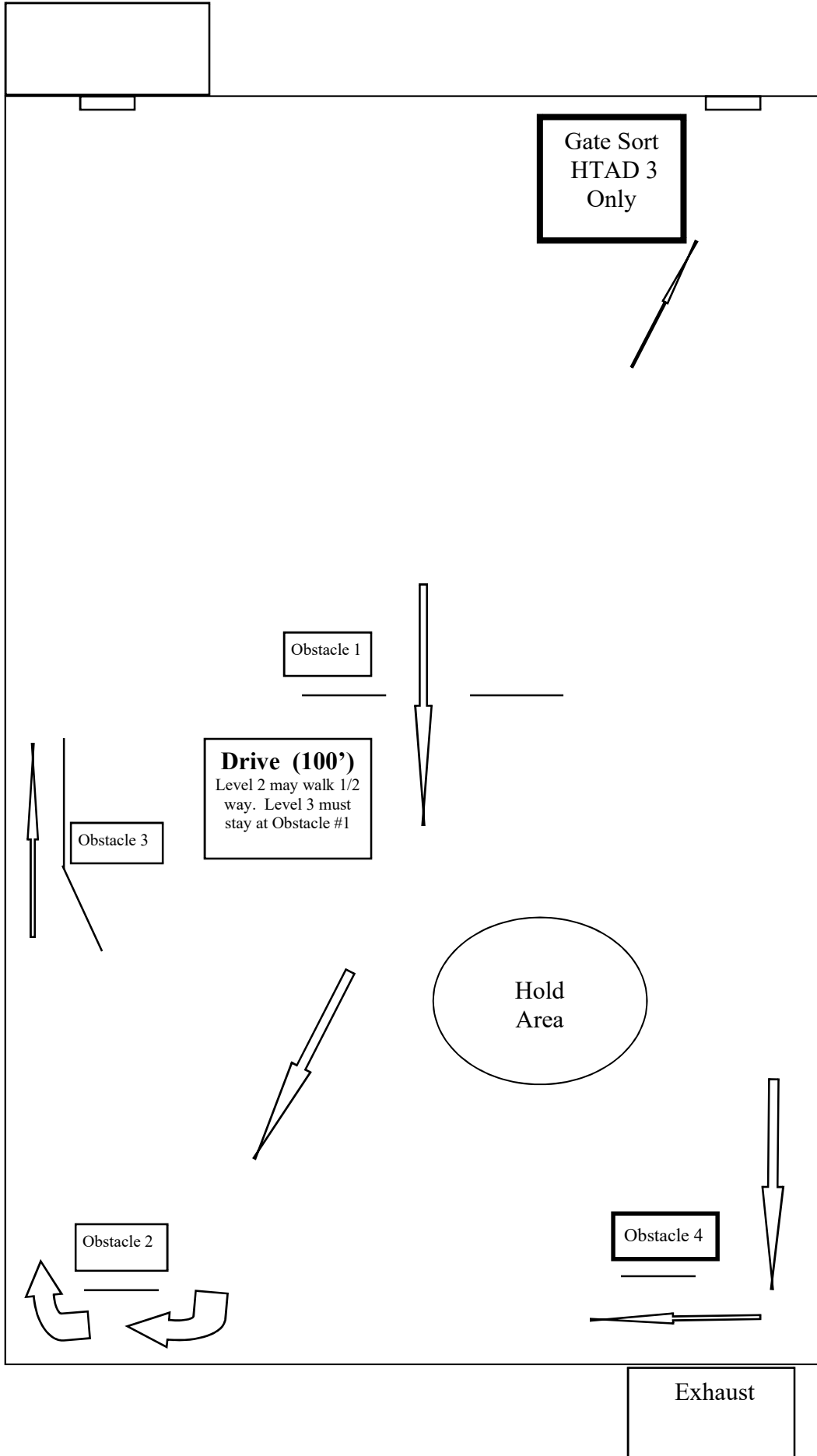

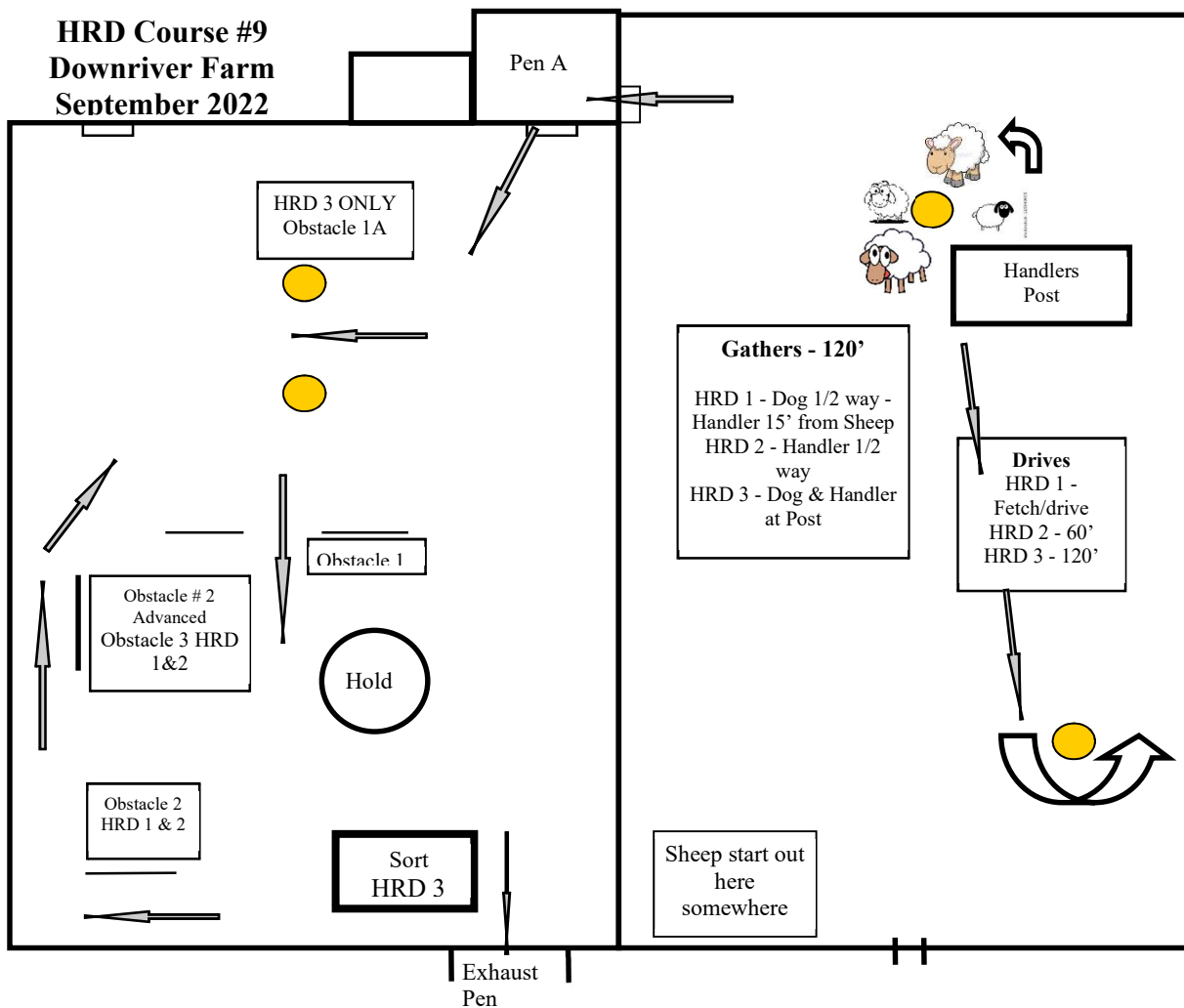
AHBA Arena Sheep

- Outrun - 10 pts
- Fetch/drive through Ob #1 15 pts
- Drive 10 pts
- Fetch/drive through Ob #2 10 pts
- Fetch/drive through Ob #3 15 pts
- Fetch/drive through Ob #4 10 pts
- Hold 10 pts
- HTAD 3 Only - Gate Sort 10 pts
- Exhaust 10 pts

Drive is located between Obstacles #1 & 2. For walking portion of level 2, dog & handler must be behind the sheep. Level 3 handlers must remain at Obstacle #1 until sheep enter Obstacle #2, at which time they may move. Tie is broken by score at Take Pen, if needed - than by the score at Obstacle #4 - if needed, then by time

1. Outrun, Lift & Fetch - 20 pts
2. Drive/Fetch around cone, then fetch down to Pen A & pen sheep - 20 pts
3. Take dog through Pen A - 5 pts
4. Take Pen into wooden arena - 5 pts
5. 3 Obstacles - 20 pts.
6. Control of stock in Arena - 5 pts
7. Hold - 10 pts
8. **Sort - HRD 3 ONLY - 10 pts**
9. Hold & Exhaust Sheep - 5 pts

1. Drive is located in field after outrun. Level 3 handlers must remain behind the line that runs the width of the arena, and is marked by the handler's post. Level 2 handlers may walk 1/2 way then must remain behind that width of the arena, and once the sheep gone around drive cone, handlers may move anywhere.
2. Tie is broken by score at Drives, than if needed by the score at OLF - and finally if needed by higher level.
3. Time: 12 minutes
