AGREEMENT

In consideration for participation in an event sanctioned by the American Herding Breed Association (AHBA). I agree to assume all responsibility for any claim, loss, or damage, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, which may be caused at or near this event, either directly or indirectly, by me or the dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event. I further agree that I will hold the AHBA, its officers, directors, agents, and members harmless and defend them from any and all liability for any injury, claim, damage, or loss, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, caused at or near this event, whether directly or indirectly, by me or any dog I have entered in or brought to this event. I agree to indemnify the AHBA, its officers, directors, agents and members for any loss, cost or expense including attorney's fees and costs, to which the AHBA, its officers, directors, agents, or members might be subject as a result of any claim, suit, loss, or damage caused in any way by any act or negligence on my part or on the part of any dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event. I acknowledge that while the AHBA may provide sanctioning for this event with regard to the issuing of titles, it does not have and does not exercise control over the conduct of the event or those present. I certify and represent that the dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event is/are not a hazard to other dogs, other animals, or to people.

I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test and Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

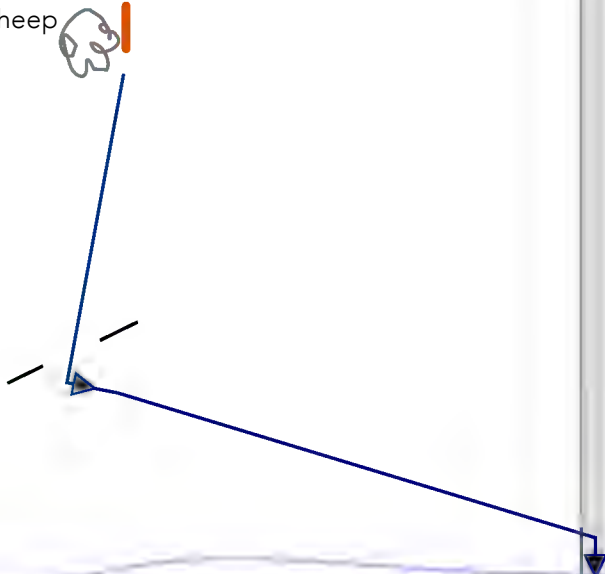

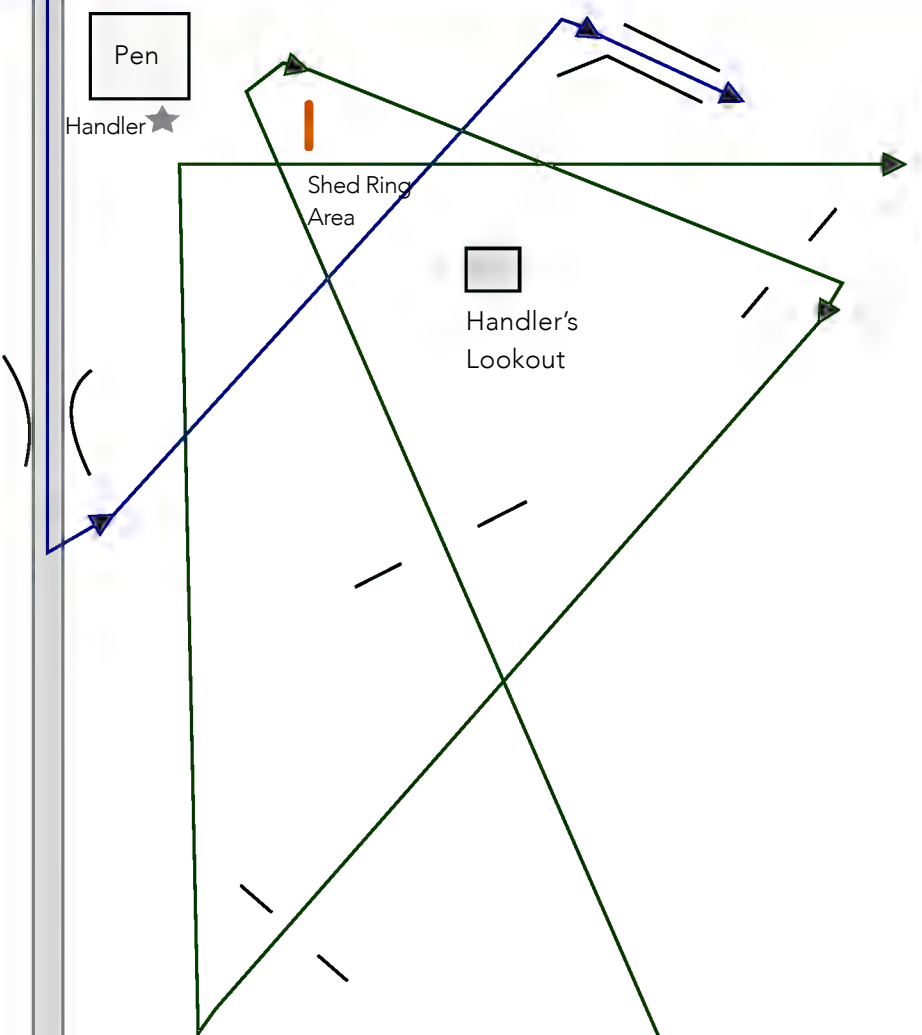

Level 3 HRD Course - Saturday

1. Handler and dog will start at the Handler's Outlook Post. Handler sends dog from their side to gather 5 sheep in Field One.
2. Bring sheep through the dog leg Fetch Panels. After the sheep pass through the fetch panels, bring sheep to the road, keep the sheep on the road and proceed to the Bridge. The handler may leave the Post once the sheep get to the road.
3. Handler, dog and all 5 sheep must go over Bridge.
4. After the Bridge, proceed to Y-Chute. Handler may choose either side to stand to help. The handler can not move from that side until the last sheep enters the Y-Chute. Once all sheep go through, head to shed ring area.
5. Bring sheep to Shed Ring area to shed off any 2 sheep. Then pen those two sheep.
6. Handler will remain at the pen and set-up their dog for a look back to gather 5 more sheep. After sheep are lifted, fetch them through the fetch panels and join the 5 sheep up with the other 3 sheep.
7. Handler will remain at the pen. Take all 8 sheep clockwise around the Cone, then start the driveway to the Drive Away Panels. After making or breaking the Drive Away Panels, proceed to the Cross Drive Panels. After the cross drive panels, bring all 8 sheep back to pen.
8. Once the 8 sheep get to the pen, let the 2 sheep out of the Pen, the handler, dog and sheep will walk to the Duck Arena Gate.
9. The handler and the dog will do a hold off the gate. Judge will call the hold. After the hold, let sheep into arena and close gate.

The run is complete.

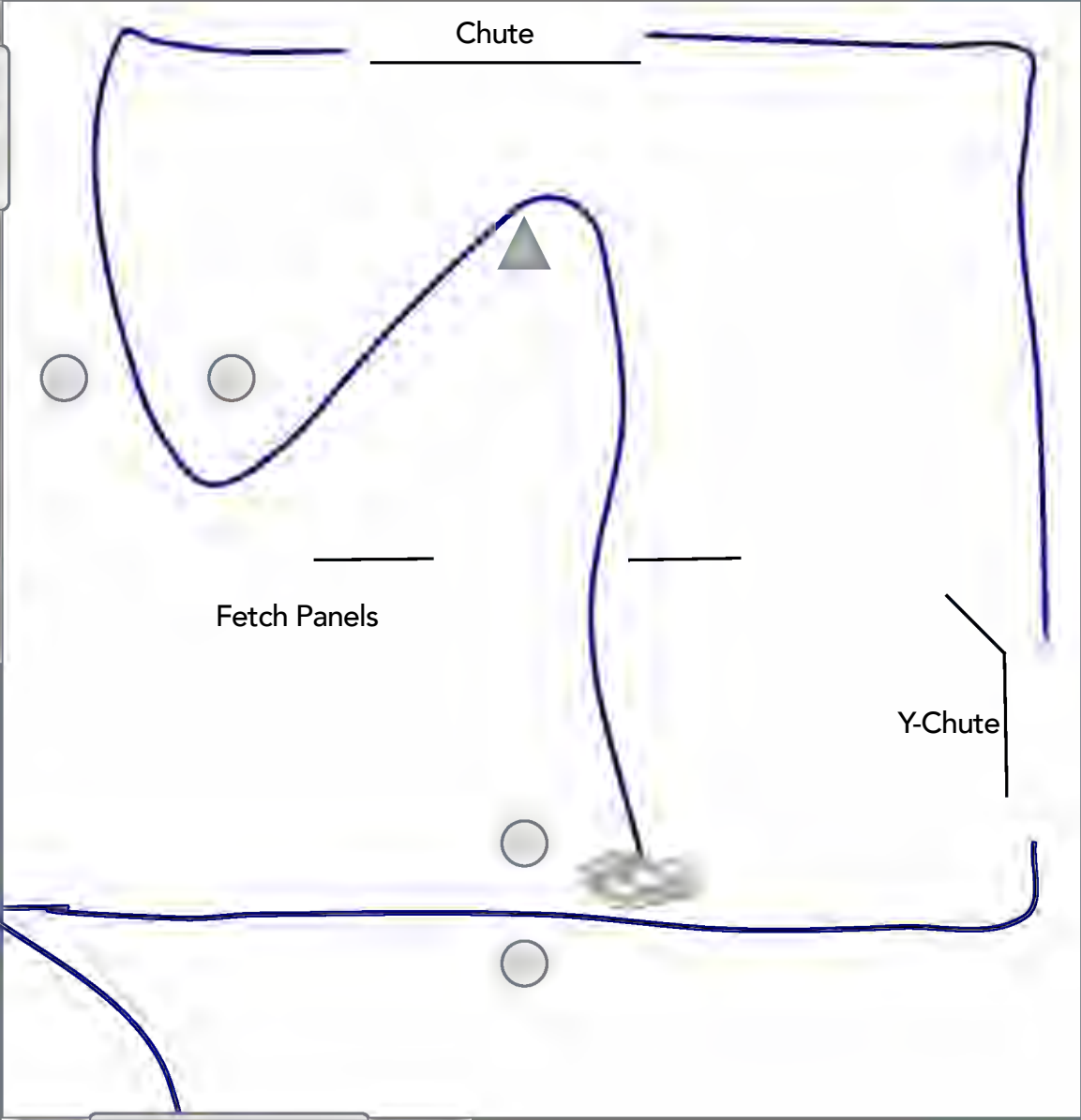
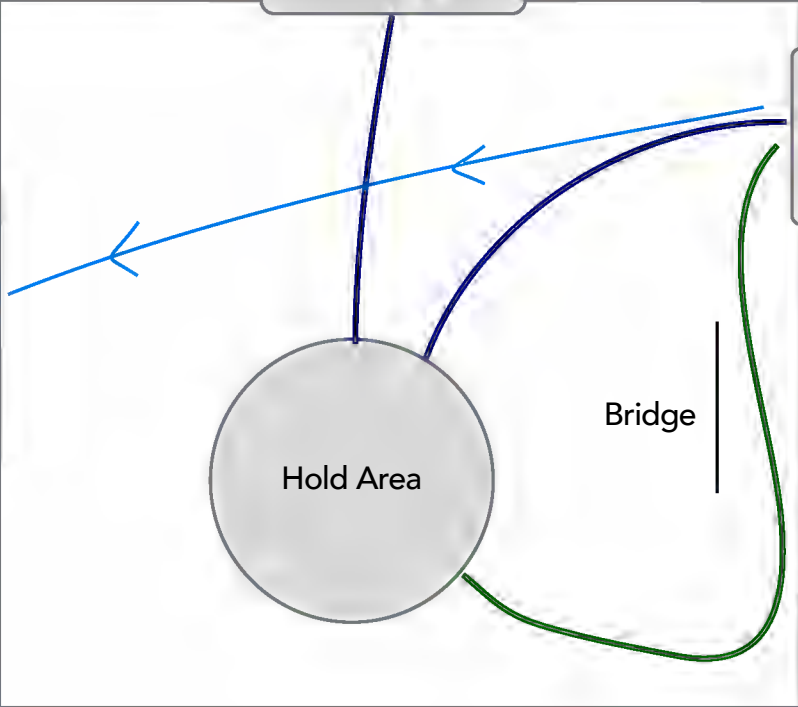
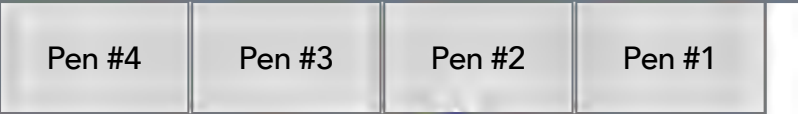

HRD Level II Description

1. Handler and dog will go into the Duck Arena off leash and gather up 5 sheep. Then proceed to Bridge.
2. Handler, dog and 5 sheep will all go over the bridge. Then let all 5 sheep into the Main Arena.
4. Handler and Dog will go into Pen #2 and take out 10 sheep and bring them into the Duck Arena. Handler must stay at the gate, while the dog pulls the sheep out.
5. Then do a Hold anywhere in the Duck Arena. Once the Judge calls a hold, proceed to the gate and sort any 5 sheep into the Main Arena.
6. Take the remaining 5 and put in Trailer.
7. Handler and dog will go into the Main Arena. Handler will place dog at Handler's Post. The handler may stay at the Handler's Post to send their dog or walk half way to the sheep before sending their dog.
8. Fetch the sheep through the fetch panels to the Handler's Post.
9. Move the sheep counter clockwise around the post and start heading towards the barrels. Handler must stay at the post and drive the sheep through the barrels.
10. After making or breaking the barrels, the handler can leave the post and head to chute. The gate will be close on the other end. Push sheep into chute. Handler can help push sheep through chute if they get stuck. Dog must go through the chute. Open gate to let the sheep out. Remember to close the gate after.
10. Then proceed to the Y-Chute and move all sheep through Y-Chute.
11. Handler will stay at the top of the Y-Chute, during the crossdrive through Barrels #2 and to the fence. The handler can leave the Y-chute when the sheep make or break the barrels.
12. Handler and dog will do a hold off the gate before repenning the sheep.

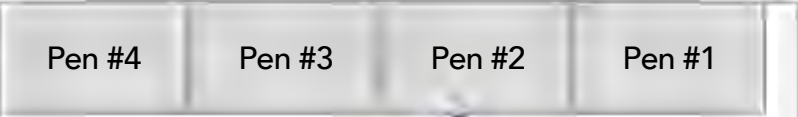

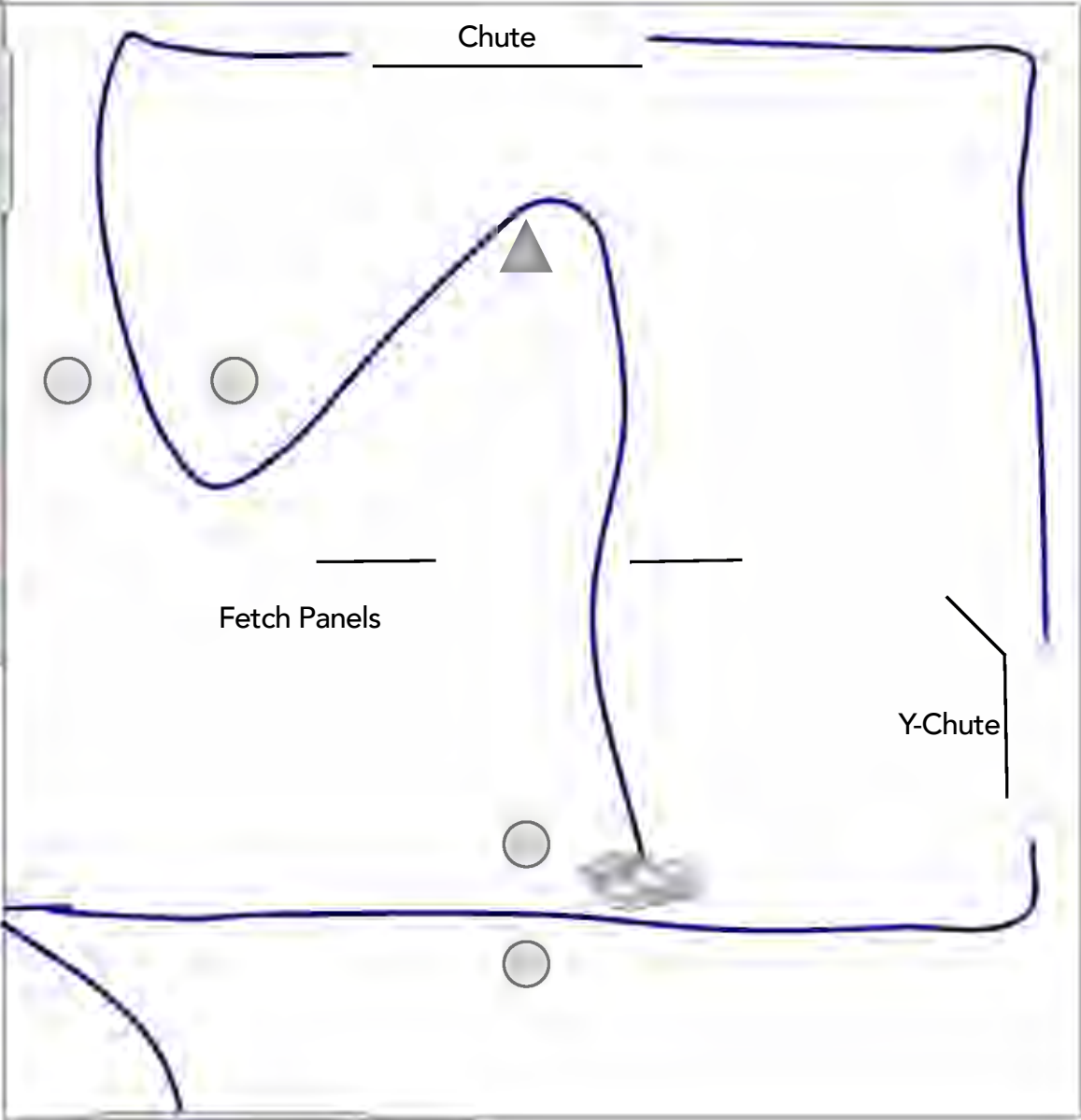

Level 1 HRD Course Description - Saturday

Level 1 Handler may walk everywhere. They can not enter the Chute or Footbath.

1. Handler and dog will go into the Duck Arena on leash and remove leash before setting their dog up to gather 5 sheep. Then bring the 5 sheep to the bridge. Handler, dog and sheep all must go over the Bridge.
2. Then let all 5 sheep into the Main Arena.
2. Handler and Dog will go into Pen #2 and take out 10 sheep and bring them into the Duck Arena. Handler can assist in getting sheep out of pen but can not touch their dog. Once back into the Duck Arena, do a Hold. The Judge will call the hold.
3. Bring the ten sheep to the Main Arena gate and sort any 5 sheep into the arena. Leave the remaining 5 in the Duck arena. The stock setters will remove stock.
4. Handler and dog will go into the Main Arena. Handler will place dog at Fetch Panels. The handler may stay at the Fetch Panels to send their dog from their side or walk half way to the sheep before sending their dog.
5. Fetch the sheep through the fetch panels and to the Handler's Post. Move the sheep counter clockwise around the handlers post and start towards the barrels. Handler may walk through the barrels.
6. After the barrels, proceed to the chute. The gate will be close on the other end. Push sheep into chute. Handler can help push sheep through chute if they get stuck. Dog must go through the chute. Open the gate to let the sheep out. Remember to close the gate after.
7. Head to the Y-Chute, after the last sheep enters the Y-Chute, the handler may leave and start the crossdrive.
8. Handler can walk between Barrel's #2 to the fence on the crossdrive. Then proceed to the re-pen gate.
8. Handler and dog will re-pen the sheep into the exhaust pen.

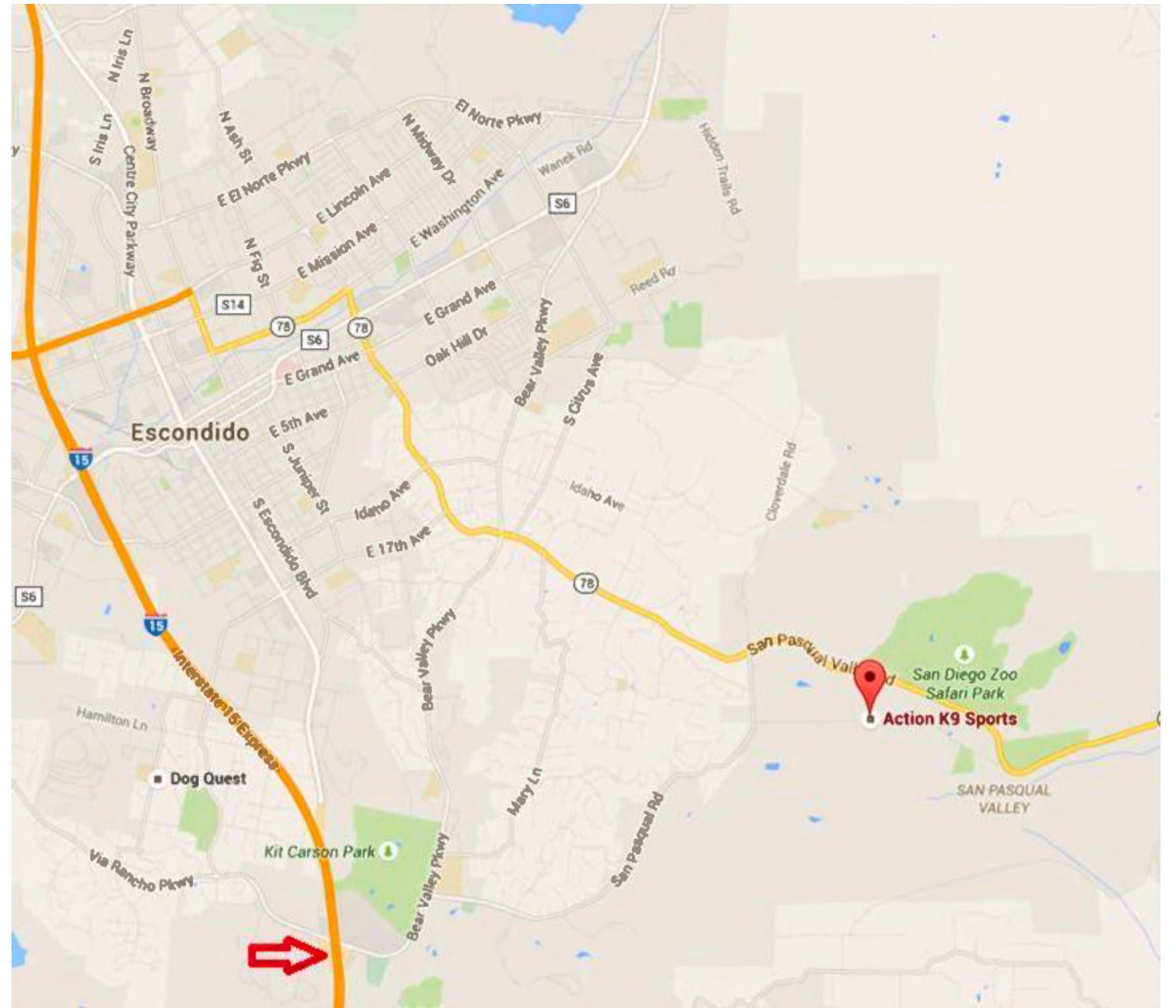

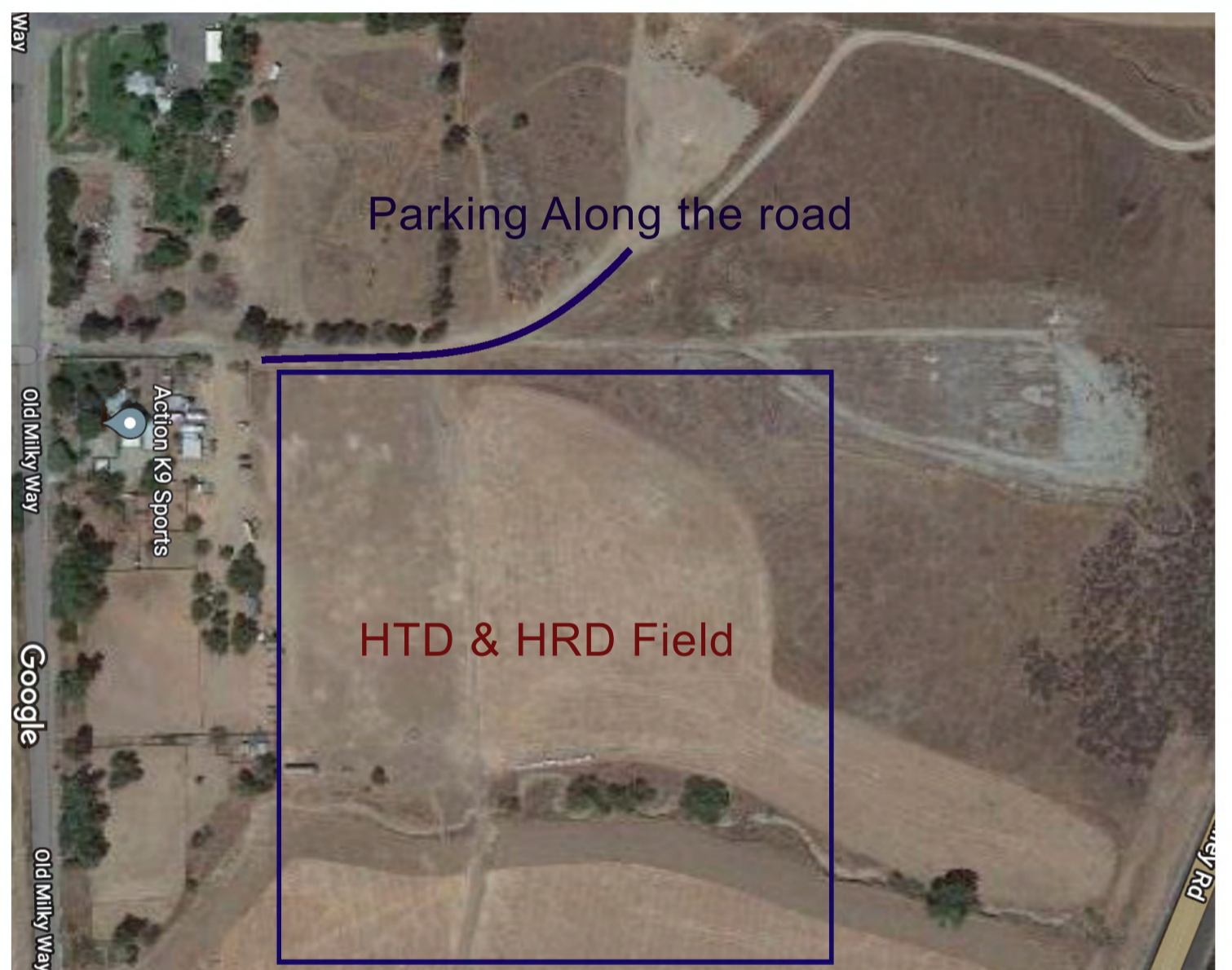

Cell and Landline phones available.

FIRE:

Dial 911 All dogs should be crated or leashed securely and owners/handlers must make sure that they, their dogs and vehicles are out of driveways that Fire and Emergency vehicles would use for approach to the site of the fire. Escondido Fire Department responds at this site.

Forest Fire:

All people and their secured dogs should immediately follow fire/emergency personnel evacuation directions and orders

Earthquake:

Remain on the site with dogs secured. Use arenas for emergency animal housing if necessary. Use barn or house if safe. Wait for instructions via radio.

FOR ALL INJURIES:

First Aid Kit is at Trial Secretary's area

INJURY OR HEALTH PROBLEM WITH A PERSON:

If injury is immediately life-threatening-- Dial 911 immediately for the emergency response team for the area. For serious, but not immediately life-threatening injury or illness Dial 442-281-5000 to alert Palomar Medical Center, 2185 Citracado Parkway, Escondido, CA 92029. Proceed with victim to the hospital.

- Right at stop sign onto Old San Pasqual.
- Left at light onto Hwy 78.
- Left at light on Valley Parkway.
- Go through downtown Escondido, past I-15. Right on Auto Park Way.
- Left at Citracado Parkway
- Palomar Medical Center on right.

Alert the veterinarian on call 760-738-9600. Owner and dog should proceed to:
