ELIGIBILITY: All dogs nine months of age or older are eligible to participate in Herding Trials and JHD. Dogs classified as Herding Dogs in AHBA are eligible for HERDING TEST (HCT) and may participate at six months of age or older. No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any Test/Trial. Bitches in season shall run in drawn running order without adjustment.

IMPORTANT. READ THIS BEFORE SIGNING RELEASE FORM

In consideration for participation in the Herding Test/Trial held by MAPLE GROVE FARM, VIVIAN KAY DELK, LESTER A KEZIAH or THE DELK FAMILY I (we) agree to assume all responsibility for any claim, loss or damage, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, which may be caused at or near the Herding Test/Trial, either directly or indirectly, by me or the dog or dogs I (we) have entered or brought to this Herding Test/Trial. I (we) will pay for injuries or replacement value in the event of the death of any livestock by my (our) dog. If injury to any stock is caused by my (our) dog entered or brought to this Herding Test/Trial, I (we) assume full responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay full market value of the injured animal in case of injury or the veterinary bill for the injury, whichever is agreed to by the Livestock Owner. - Livestock replacement costs are as follows: Sheep - \$400.00 Ducks - \$75
*AHBA, Maple Grove Farm, Vivian Kay Delk and all trial workers assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- Females in season will run last. They should be crated away from trial arenas when not competing.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing.
- Entry confirmation will be sent by email; please be sure to include your email address.
- Trial committee will draw run order prior to the trial.
- Entry fees will only be refunded if request is received on or before pre-entry closing date (June 14, 2024).

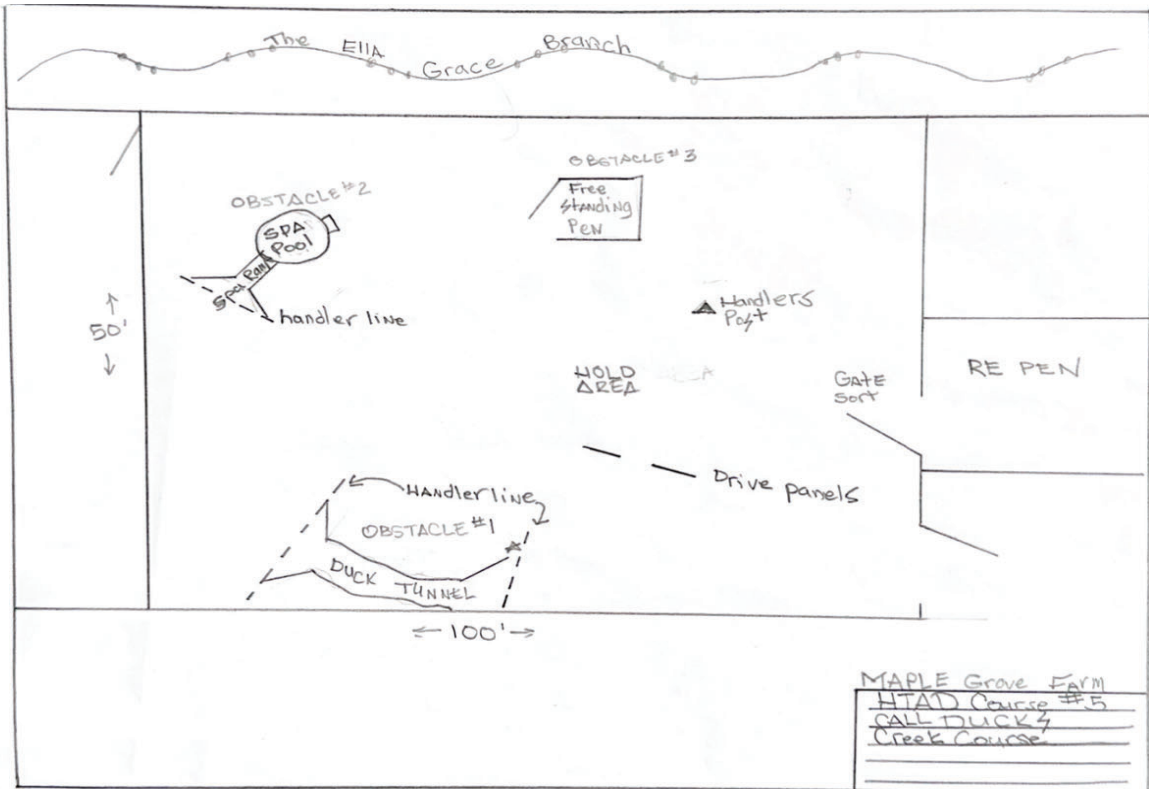

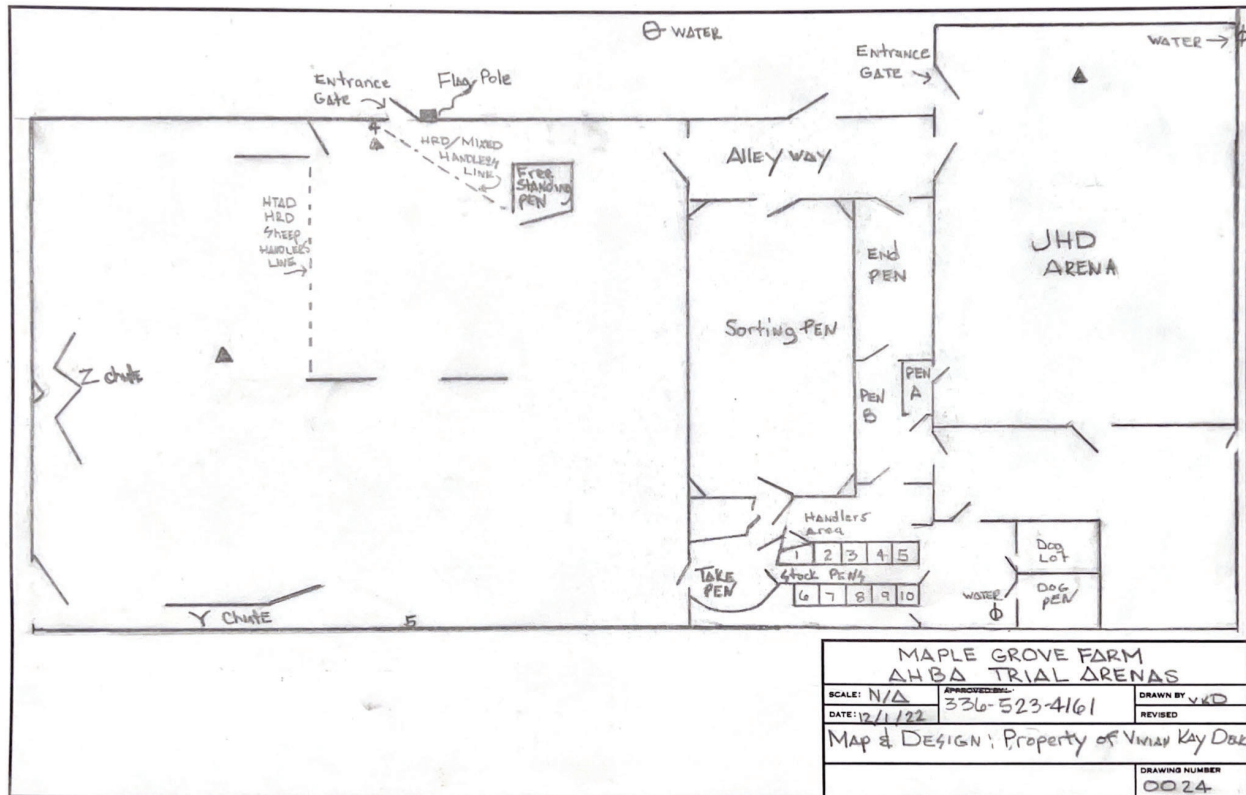

HTAD Call Ducks Course 5 - "Creek Course" Description

Stock: 5 Call Ducks

Time allowed: 12 minutes

Helpful Tips:

- All handlers cannot walk through the Drive Panels.
- Tunnel caution - take care of the stock if the dog enters the tunnel
- Dogs do not enter the Duck Spa Pool.
 - Level III - Handler and dog are at the post.
 - Level II - Dog is at the post and handler can be halfway.
 - Level I - Dog is halfway to the stock and the handler may go within 15' of the stock.

Handler and dog start at the post. Ducks are pushed out by the stock handlers(s).
Once the ducks settle:

- Level III - Gather/drive - handler remains at the post and sends the dog to gather the ducks counter clockwise then drives the ducks through the drive panels to Obstacle 1. Handler may leave the post when the ducks reach the Orange Cone. While remaining at the Orange Cone, the handler may assist the dog verbally to move the ducks through the tunnel. As ducks exit Obstacle 1, the handler may leave the Orange Cone.
- Levels I, II and III will fetch/drive the ducks to Obstacle 2 the dog drives the ducks up the Spa Ramp into the Spa Pool. Ducks should exit the Spa Pool and handler will fetch/drive to Obstacle 3 the Free Standing Pen and pen the ducks.

Handler will fetch/drive to the hold area.

From the hold, handler will reopen as follows:

- Level III - sort 3 ducks in one at a time then 2 ducks in.
- Level II - sort 3 ducks in then 2 ducks in.
- Level I - reopen

Herding Trial Arena Dog Sheep - Course Description

Stock: 5 Sheep

Time allowed: 12 minutes

1. ALL LEVELS pickup 5 sheep from take pen
2. ALL LEVELS fetch or drive sheep to cone turning sheep counterclockwise around
 - a. Level II & III handlers stay at cone and drive from cone to the Y chute
 - b. Level I may fetch or drive to the Y chute
3. Take sheep from Y chute to corner 2 and through Z chute
 - a. Level III handler remains at the cone and drives sheep from Y chute to corner and through Z chute
 - b. Level II handlers can move as soon as stock leave Y chute and help as needed to fetch or drive to corner and through Z chute
 - c. Level I handlers may fetch or drive from Y chute to corner and through Z chute
4. From the Z chute, go to corner 3, turn stock and load in exam pen/panels
 - a. Level III handler remains at cone until stock has been driven to corner 3, then may move about as necessary
 - b. Level I & II fetch or drive through Z chute, to corner and through exam panels
5. Level III ONLY: Once sheep are in exam pen, handler moves to the gate while dog holds the open side, open the gate and bring stock through, close the gate with stock under control
6. ALL LEVELS fetch or drive from exam pen through free standing panels, handler may cross through panels in level I & II, NOT in level III
7. ALL LEVELS Pen in free standing pen, take stock out and do a hold in area specified by judge
8. ALL LEVELS exhaust into alley (Gate A), and into end pen

Course Description - Herding Ranch Dog Sheep

Time limit: 12 minutes

1. ALL LEVELS Start with 5 sheep in alleyway
 - a. Level III gate sorts 3 sheep into end pen (1 marked) and reunite all 5 in alleyway
 - b. Levels I & II take all 5 sheep into end pen and bring back out into alleyway
2. ALL LEVELS Bring stock through sorting pen through connecting alley into take pen
3. ALL LEVELS Bring stock into AKC arena under control and fetch or drive through Y chute
4. ALL LEVELS Take stock across arena into exam panel
5. Take stock from exam panel through free standing panels and to number 5
 - a. Level III drives from handlers line to number 5
 - b. Level II drives from handlers line through free standing panels
 - c. Level I fetch or drive to number 5, handler may go through panels
6. ALL LEVELS Pen in freestanding pen then bring stock out of pen
7. ALL LEVELS Do a hold in area designated by judge
8. ALL LEVELS Reopen in take pen

HRD Course description may be carried with handler through course
