- This trial shall be run under all AHBA rules and regulations. FMI: www.ahba-herding.org
- Use official AHBA entry form
- Each individual is responsible for any damage caused by himself, his family or his dog while in the trial arena or on the trial grounds. Livestock replacement costs are as follows: Ducks - \$50, Turkeys - \$75, Geese - \$150.00, Sheep - \$200.00, Goats - \$300.00. AHBA, Carolina Canine Pet & Performance, Not Quite Right Farm, and all trial workers assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- Bitches in season will run last in test runs. They should be crated away from trial arenas when not competing.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing.
- Entry confirmation will be sent by email; please be sure to include your email address.
- Trial committee will determine run order prior to the trial.
- Entry fees will only be refunded if request is received before pre-entry closing date.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From points to the west, take Hwy 421 South. Take a LEFT onto Hwy 902. Take a RIGHT onto Dewitt Smith Rd. Take a RIGHT onto Guthrie Rd. Arena entrance is on the RIGHT.

From points to the east, take Hwy 64 West. Take Exit 386 for Business 64 into Pittsboro. Take 2nd exit on traffic

circle to remain on Business 64 (West St). Take a LEFT onto Hwy 87. Take a RIGHT onto Old Goldston Rd (this is a marked detour). Take a RIGHT onto Hwy 87. Take a RIGHT onto Hwy 902. Continue straight (stay on LEFT fork) onto Pittsboro Goldston Rd. Take a RIGHT onto Dewitt Smith Rd. Take a LEFT onto Guthrie Rd. Arena entrance is on the right.

NOTE: If using a Garmin, Google Maps, or some other GPS system, most do not take you to the correct location. The drive for the arena is on the RIGHT whether coming from points east or west.

All dogs nine months of age or older are eligible to participate in Herding Trials and JHD. Dogs classified as Herding Dogs in AHBA are eligible for HERDING TEST (HCT) and may participate at six months of age or older. No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any Test/Trial. Bitches in season shall run in drawn running order without adjustment.

Tie Breaker: Graze then Drive

Take and gather

Stock are moved from take pen to arena corner. The dog and handler drop back to their gather positions and dog is sent on a gather, ending just before the handler post. 20pt

1. Dog halfway from post to stock, handler up to 15 ft
2. Dog at handler post, handler up to half way
3. Dog and handler at post

Drive

Stock are taken clockwise around post to fenceline between cones, then down fenceline to corner. 20/25pt

1. Fetch or Drive
2. Drive from post through cones and turn sheep down fenceline, may fetch or drive at that point to the corner
3. Handler remains at post until stock reach corner.

Graze

Stock are taken down bottom fenceline to gate, and enter graze. Dog and handler maintain stock in graze for 3 min. Stock are then taken through the marked trees and into 40 x 50 area. 20/25pt

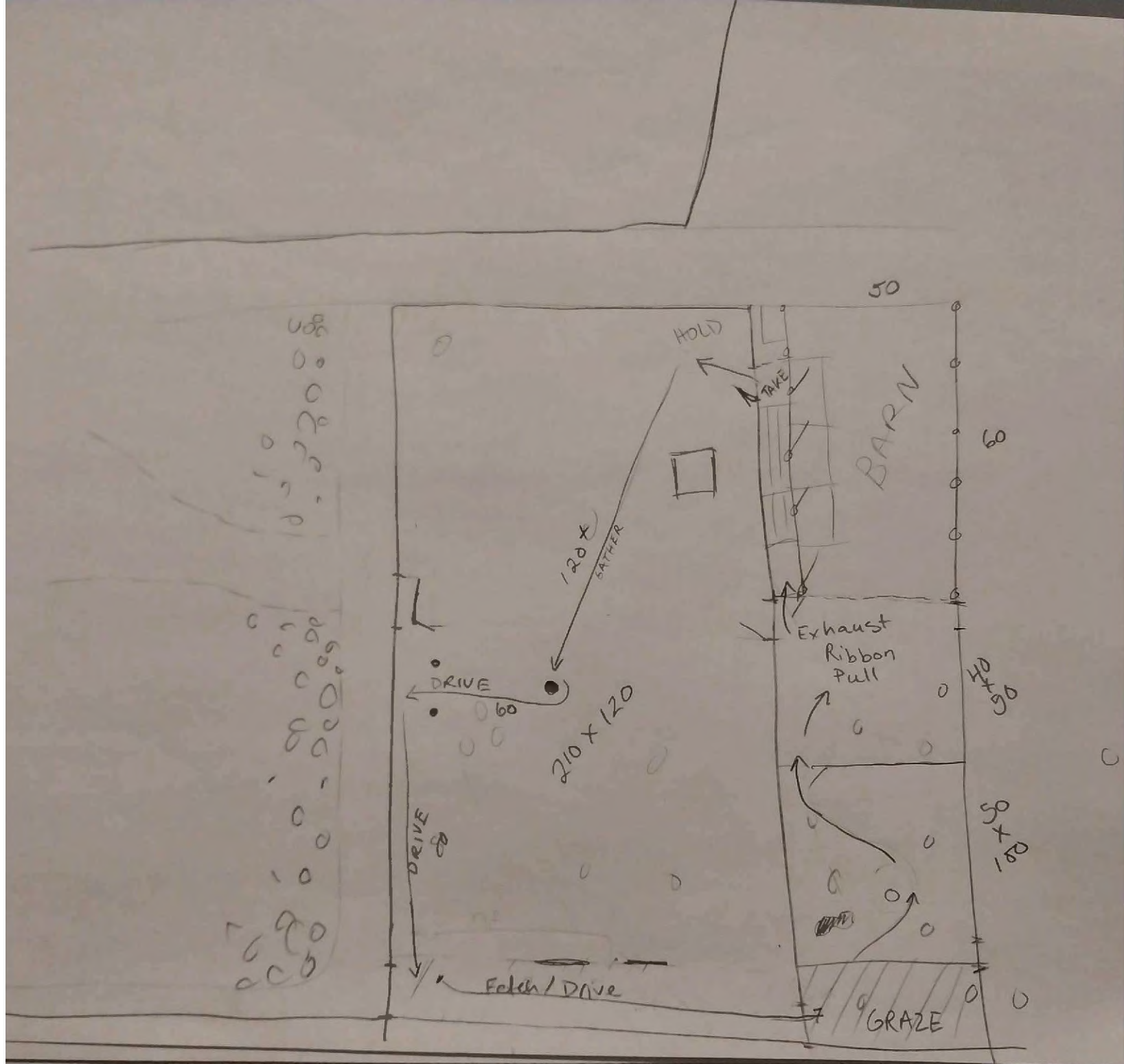
1. Handler may be in the graze
2. Handler may be in the graze, dog remains out of graze
3. Handler and dog must work from outside graze to maintain flock

Sort (Ribbon Pull)

Stock are pulled to the middle of the area, and ribbon is pulled. All levels. 20pt

Exhaust

Stock are exhausted into small pen next to barn. Run ends when gate closes. 10pt



HRD at NQR Farm for May 2024 POULTRY

Tie breakers: Bridge then gather

Take

Stock are moved from take pen into chute, then into poultry arena. Ends when gate closes to chute. 10 pts

1. Handler may accompany dog
2. Handler may enter front of take pen
3. Handler cannot enter take pen

Pen

Stock are taken counterclockwise into freestanding pen. 10pts

Gather

Pen gate is opened and dog and handler drop back to near fenceline chute for gather. 20pt

- 1 Dog halfway to stock pen, handler up to 15ft
- 2.Dog near chute opening, handler up to halfway
- 3.Dog and handler near chute opening

Drive. 20pt

STock are taken through the chute after the gather and driven to near the gate to the bridge 20pt

1. Fetch or drive
2. Drive from opening of chute to gate area
3. Drive from opening of chute to gate area

Bridge 20pt

STock is taken through the gate and over the freestanding bridge over the water, turned left at the end of bridge and brought through the water back to arena fence to near gate.

- 1.All levels may be on either side of the bridge to bring stock over, turn and bring to gate.

Sort 10pt

STock is taken down fenceline to hold pen. STock is sorted 2 in, hold off 3. 10 pts

1. Continue to exhaust
2. Cotinue to exhaust
3. Sort

Exhaust

Stock are exhausted into hold pen.. 10pt
