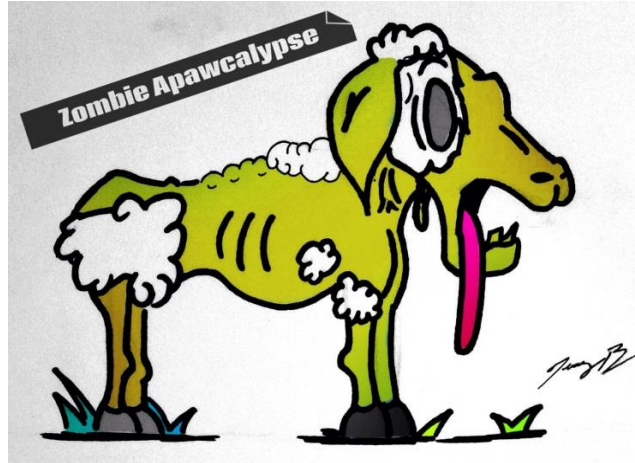

Directions

From Las Cruces:

Take I-10 to Exit 162 (Chaparral/Anthony/HWY404) – last exit out of NM. Turn left towards Chaparral and go until it deadends into the turnaround. Go left and take an immediate right onto Lisa. Go to DeLara Estates Drive (across from the Sheriff's office and Segura's Auto and turn right. Come down until it turns to dirt road and take the first real left after that onto County Road A074. Come down past the stop sign in the middle of the road staying to the right. My house is after that on the left – look for the dog signs. Come through the green gate and latch behind you. Park in the front and come to the back. Dogs should be on leash and I have dog crates if you need one.

From West El Paso:

Take I-10 to Exit 162 (Chaparral/Anthony/HWY404) – first exit in NM. Turn right towards Chaparral and go until it deadends into the turnaround. Go left and take an immediate right onto Lisa. Go to DeLara Estates Drive (across from the Sheriff's office and Segura's Auto) and turn right. Come down until it turns to dirt road and take the first real left after that onto County Road A074. Come down past the stop sign in the middle of the road staying to the right. My house is after that on the left – look for the dog signs. Come through the green gate and latch behind you. Park in the front and come to the back. Dogs should be on leash and I have dog crates if you need one.

From East El Paso:

Take Loop 375 to McCombs. Exit McCombs and turn toward Chaparral and stay on McCombs until it deadends into Lisa. Turn left. Go to DeLara Estates Drive (across from the Sheriff's office) and turn left. Come down until it turns to dirt road and take the first real left after that onto County Road A074. Come down past the stop sign in the middle of the road staying to the right. My house is after that on the left – look for the dog signs. Come through the green gate and latch behind you. Park in the front and come to the back. Dogs should be on leash and I have dog crates if you need one.

If you want to take 54:

Exit MLK/Kenworthy and turn towards Chaparral. Go until you come to the turnaround. Go through it and take an immediate right onto Lisa. Go to DeLara Estates Drive (across from the Sheriff's office and Segura's Auto) and turn right. Come down until it turns to dirt road and take the first real left after that onto County Road A074. Come down past the stop sign in the middle of the road staying to the right. My house is after that on the left – look for the dog signs. Come through the green gate and latch behind you. Park in the front and come to the back. Dogs should be on leash and I have dog crates if you need one.

Level III (Only) Ranch Sheep – Arenas A & D

Begin in Arena A pens. Remove 5 sheep from holding pen and take to Arena A. Begin the 60 ft drive from cone through panels, handler remains at cone. Once through the panels handler proceeds to the free-standing pen and sheep are penned. All sheep do not need to be penned in order to move on. Sheep are left in Arena A and the team proceeds to Arena C.

Dog and handler proceed to the cone for the 120ft outrun. 5 sheep are in the corner. Sheep are collected and either brought to the handler or taken to the road for the 60ft drive up the road. The drive and the road are judged at the same time. At the completion of the drive the dog and handler take the sheep to the hold/graze area for 1 minute.

Dog and handler will leave the sheep and go back to Arena A and collect the sheep. 3 marked sheep will be put into the pen, either by sorting at the gate to the holding area or sorting at the pen. The last 2 will then be put in the pen with the 3 sheep and the run completed.

Gate Sort (Holding Area gate or Pen gate) – 10 pts

Level I & II (only) Ranch Mixed (goats and geese) – Arenas B & C

Begin in Arena B pens. Remove 5 geese from holding pen and take into Arena B. Geese will be fetched (Level I) or driven (Level II) 60 ft down the road in Arena B. This is the first option for the drive for Level II. Once completed, the dog and handler will leave the geese and proceed to Arena C.

The goats will be at the far cone and in Level I the dog will be placed halfway and the handler may go to within 15 feet. In level II, the dog is at the post by the gate and the handler may go halfway. Goats will be collected and taken to the handler cone. From there the Level II second option for the drive is to drive the goats to the middle cone (60 feet). Level I can fetch to the panels. The goats will then be either fetched or driven around the back two panels in either direction. Goats will be taken to the middle of the arena and a hold will be done. They will then be left in Arena C and the team will proceed to Arena B.

After collecting the geese, the geese will be taken into the holding area and put into their original pen.
