I acknowledge that while the AHBA may provide sanctioning for this event with regard to the issuing of titles, it does not have and does not exercise control over the conduct of the event or those present. I certify and represent that the dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event is/are not a hazard to other dogs, other animals, or to people. HTAD Course #5 Description

Gather- Stock will be set out off the fence to the east side of the arena. Handlers post is 100' away (50' for ducks) Ducks and Sheep all levels Stock will be taken clockwise around post. Cattle all levels pass Handlers Post on East Side.

III- Handler stays at post and sends dog to gather, can move as soon as stock are headed towards obstacle #1

II-Handler may leave dog at handlers post and go ½ way towards stock.

I- Handler may leave dog ½ way from HP to stock and then may walk within 15' (10' for ducks)

Scoring ends when stock have gone around HP and are headed towards Obstacle #1

Obstacle #1- Stock will enter at south end of chute.

III- Handlers will remain at opening of chute until all stock have exited.

II- Handlers will remain along wing of chute until all stock have exited

I- Handlers may walk anywhere along outside of obstacle, they may not enter it.

Scoring ends when stock have exited the chute.

Drive #1-50'(25' for ducks) /Obstacle #2 After the stock have exited obstacle #1 they are taken North along fence and turned east. Once the stock arrived at the cone, placed 20' feet of north fence & 60' from east fence (10' & 30' for ducks) the stock will be driven in II & II, fetched for I to the opening of obstacle # 2

III- handlers will remain at cone until stock are at the opening of obstacle # 2

II- handlers may accompany the stock ½ way to obstacle # 2, then remain there for the rest of the drive.

I- Handlers may accompany the stock to obstacle # 2, but may not walk through it

Scoring ends when stock exit obstacle #2

Hold- the stock is taken to the hold area and briefly held in place. There is no required position for the dog or handler. The judge signals the end of the hold/settle. Judging ends at judges signal.

Drive # 2-50'(25' for ducks) Stock is fetched/driven south along fence to cone. From cone stock is fetched/driven towards obstacle # 3

III- handlers will remain at cone until stock arrive at opening of obstacle # 3.

II- Handlers may accompany stock ½ way to obstacle # 3, then remain until stock has arrived at opening of obstacle # 3

I- Handlers may accompany stock to obstacle # 3

Scoring ends when stock reach a point 10'(5' for ducks) in front of obstacle # 3.

Obstacle # 3- stock is moved south through free standing panels.

Handlers at all levels must remain at panels and may not walk through.

Stock is then taken to the Shed area for cattle or the repen gate for sheep & ducks.

Scoring ends when stock arrive either at the shed area or repen gate.

Shed- Cattle- Level III- Cattle will be fetched or driven southwest to shed area. 1 head is separated/shed from the 2. Judge will call a "shed"- no hold is needed.

Scoring ends when judge calls the shed.

Sort- Sheep & Ducks- Level III- stock will be taken to the Repen gate. 2 marked sheep (any 2 ducks) will be sorted into the repen.

Scoring ends when stock sorted have been penned.

Repen- For level III remaining stock will be repenned. II & I all stock will be repenned.

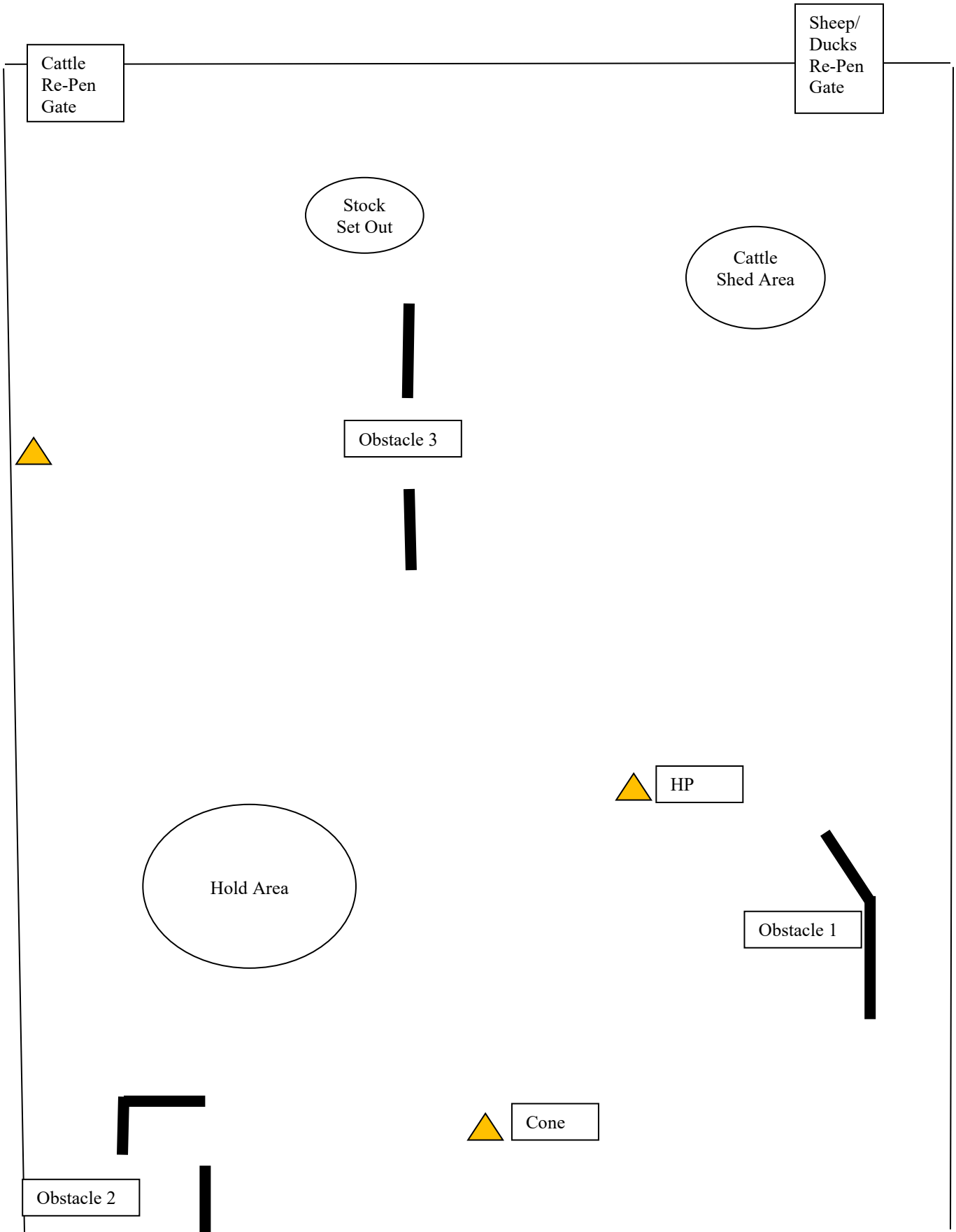
Scoring ends when all stock are repenned and gate is closed.

HRD Course Description

Gather- Stock will be set out off the fence to the north of the arena in the field. Handlers post is 100' away . Sheep all levels Stock will be taken clockwise around post.

III- Handler stays at post and sends dog to gather, can move as soon as stock are headed towards Freestanding obstacle

II-Handler may leave dog at handlers post and go ½ way towards stock.

I- Handler may leave dog ½ way from HP to stock and then may walk within 15' (10' for ducks)

Scoring ends when stock have gone around HP and are headed towards Freestanding Obstacle

Freestanding Obstacle - Take 10 sheep to the Shelter. Fetch all 10 sheep through shelter and into the trial arena.

All levels may fetch.

Obstacle #1- Gather stock in trial arena and move through obstacle 1 Stock will enter at south end of chute.

III- Handlers will remain at opening of chute until all stock have exited.

II- Handlers will remain along wing of chute until all stock have exited

I- Handlers may walk anywhere along outside of obstacle, they may not enter it.

Scoring ends when stock have exited the chute.

Drive #1-50'/Obstacle #2 After the stock have exited obstacle #1 they are taken North along fence and turned east. Once the stock arrived at the cone, placed 20' feet of north fence & 60' from east fence the stock will be driven in II & II, fetched for I to the opening of obstacle # 2

III- handlers will remain at cone until stock are at the opening of obstacle # 2

II- handlers may accompany the stock ½ way to obstacle # 2, then remain there for the rest of the drive.

I- Handlers may accompany the stock to obstacle # 2, but may not walk through it

Scoring ends when stock exit obstacle #2

Hold- the stock is taken to the hold area and briefly held in place. There is no required position for the dog or handler. The judge signals the end of the hold/settle. Judging ends at judges signal.

Drive # 2-50'(25' for ducks) Stock is fetched/driven south along fence to cone. From cone stock is fetched/driven towards obstacle # 3

III- handlers will remain at cone until stock arrive at opening of obstacle # 3.

II- Handlers may accompany stock ½ way to obstacle # 3, then remain until stock has arrived at opening of obstacle # 3 I-

Handlers may accompany stock to obstacle # 3

Scoring ends when stock reach a point 10'(5' for ducks) in front of obstacle # 3.

Obstacle # 3- stock is moved south through free standing panels.

Handlers at all levels must remain at panels and may not walk through.

Stock is then taken to the Shed area for cattle or the reopen gate for sheep & ducks.

Scoring ends when stock arrive either at the shed area or reopen gate.

Sort- Level III- stock will be taken to the Reopen gate. 2 marked sheep (any 2 ducks) will be sorted into the reopen.

Scoring ends when stock sorted have been penned.

Reopen- For level III remaining stock will be reopened. II & I all stock will be reopened.

Scoring ends when all stock are reopened and gate is closed.

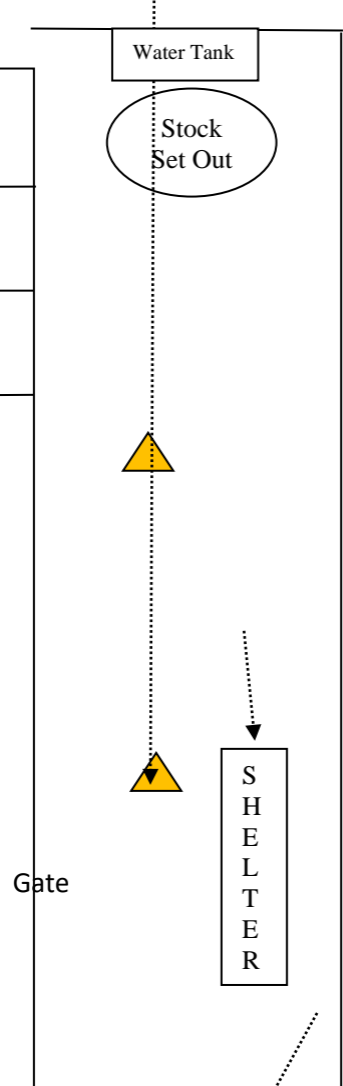
