DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From Highway US 64 (traveling East)

from the junction of US 421 and US 64 for 8.9 mi. Turn right onto Alex Cockman rd. for 2.2 mi. Turn left on Alston Chp rd. for 1.8 mi. Turn left on Old Cedar Rd and travel 0.3 mi to end.

From US 64 (traveling West)

take exit 368 (bus 64) 3.5 mi. Turn left onto NC-87 S/NC-902 W .2 mi.
Turn right onto Old Goldston Rd 0.4 mi. Turn right onto Alston Chapel Rd 3.2 mi. Turn right onto Old Cedar Dr drive 0.3 mi to end.

From US 501 (traveling North)

Turn left onto N Carolina 87 Bypass/NC-87 0.7 mi. Turn left onto Old Goldston Rd 0.3 mi.
Turn left onto Alston Chapel Rd 3.2 mi. Turn right onto Old Cedar Dr 0.3 mi drive to end

From US 501 (traveling South)

At the traffic circle in Pittsboro, take the 1st exit onto US-64 BUS W 0.5 mi. turn left onto NC-87 S/NC-902 W 0.2 mi.
Turn right onto Old Goldston Rd 0.4 mi. Turn right onto Alston Chapel Rd 3.2 mi. Turn right onto Old Cedar Dr drive 0.3 mi to end.

From NC 87 (traveling South)

At the traffic circle in Pittsboro, take the 2nd exit and stay on NC-87 S 0.4 mi. Turn right onto Old Goldston Rd 0.4 mi.
Turn right onto Alston Chapel Rd 3.2 mi. Turn right onto Old Cedar Dr drive 0.3 mi to end.

All dogs nine months of age or older are eligible to participate in Herding Trials and JHD. Dogs classified as Herding Dogs in AHBA are eligible for HERDING TEST (HCT) and may participate at six months of age or older. No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any Test/Trial. Bitches in season shall run last.

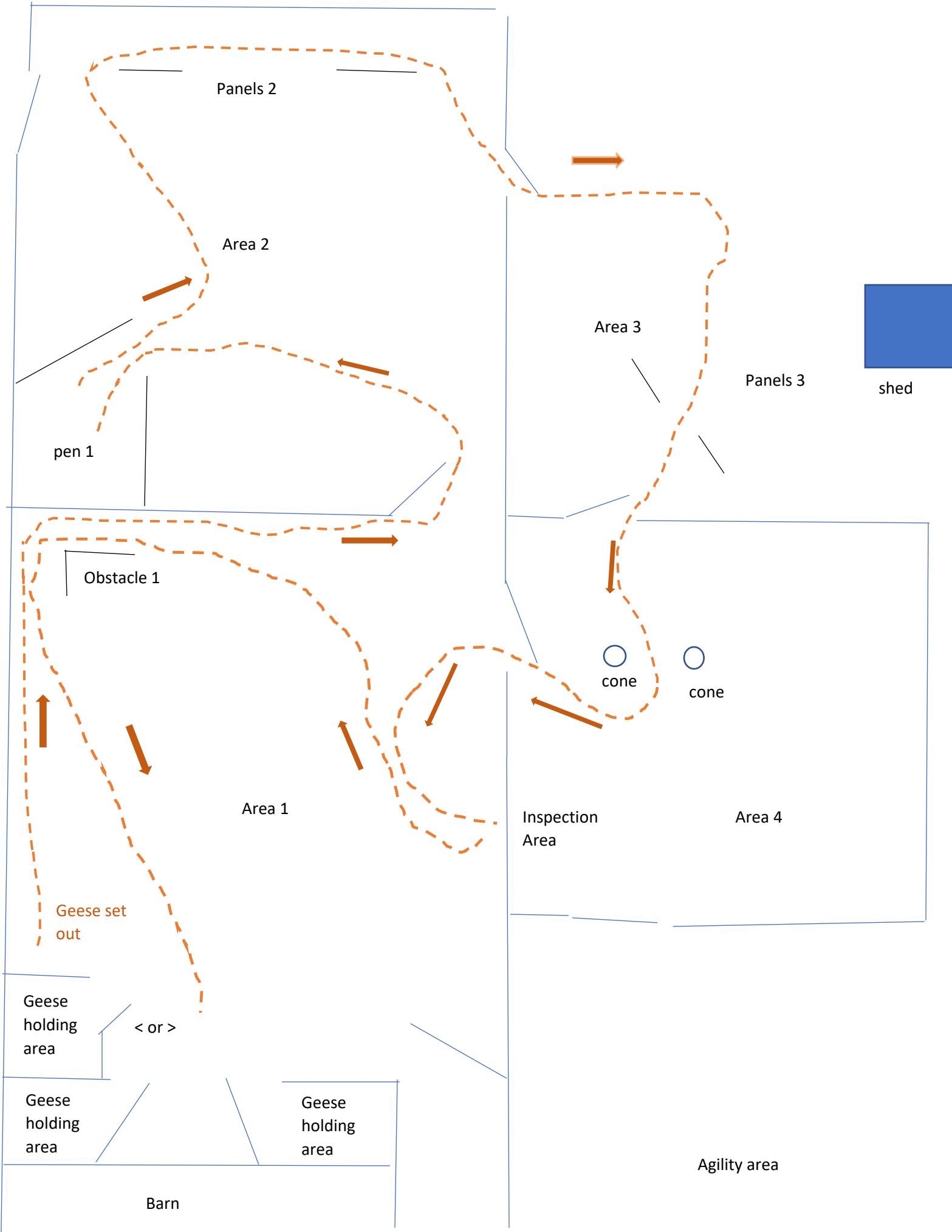

Middle Tree Farm hrd geese

** Handler may not move into the pen nor through any panels / obstacles **

Geese are set out in “area 1”	points
Handler and dog enter “area 1”	
Geese are gathered – time starts when dog is released to gather geese are moved along left-hand fence and clockwise around “obstacle 1”	10 / 10
geese are moved along far fence geese are moved quietly through gate into “area 2” and held while gate is closed	10/ 10
geese are penned in “Pen 1” and pen gate is shut	10/10
geese are released from “pen 1” and moved clockwise around “panels 2” at the far end of area 2 and then moved quietly to and through the gate into “area 3” and gate is closed	10/10
geese are moved clockwise around to the rear of “Panels 3” and pass through panels from rear. Level 1 handler may move anywhere with dog Level 2 handler can advance to ½ distance between the entered gate And “Panels 2” Level 3 handler must remain at entered gate Level 2 and 3 handlers may again move anywhere as geese completely pass through “panels 3” from the rear	10/15
geese are moved to and through the gate into “area 4” and the gate is closed geese are then moved between the two cones	10/10
geese are moved through gate and into area 1 and the gate is closed geese are moved to “inspection area” to be reviewed for sale and held until released by judge	10/10
geese are then moved counter clockwise through obstacle 1 Level 1 handler may move anywhere with dog Level 2 handler can advance to ½ distance between the inspection area And obstacle 1 Level 3 handler must remain at the inspection area Level 2 and 3 handlers may again move anywhere as geese completely exit obstacle 1	10/15
geese are returned to holding pen from which they came and gate is closed	10/10

Gather. (level 1 handler – dog at halfway to stock, handler up to 15 ft away from stock. Level 2 handler -dog at post, handler may advance halfway to stock. Level 3 handler and dog at post) Time starts when dog is sent. Move stock clockwise around handler post	10	10
Move stock to and into free standing pen. All handlers may move anywhere **	10	10
Move stock to a point approximately one half the distance between free standing pen and entrance to bridge Hold stock until released by judge Level 3 handlers must do a ribbon pull	10	15
Move stock across the bridge clockwise Level 1 handler can move anywhere ** Level 2 may move to exit panel of bridge after hold is completed Level 3 handler stays at point of hold until stock has exited the bridge and then may move anywhere **	10	10
Move stock (backwards) through free standing y chute-dog may move through y chute Level 1 handler can move anywhere ** Level 2 may move to left side of the entry y chute when stock has completely exited the bridge Level 3 returns to post	15	20

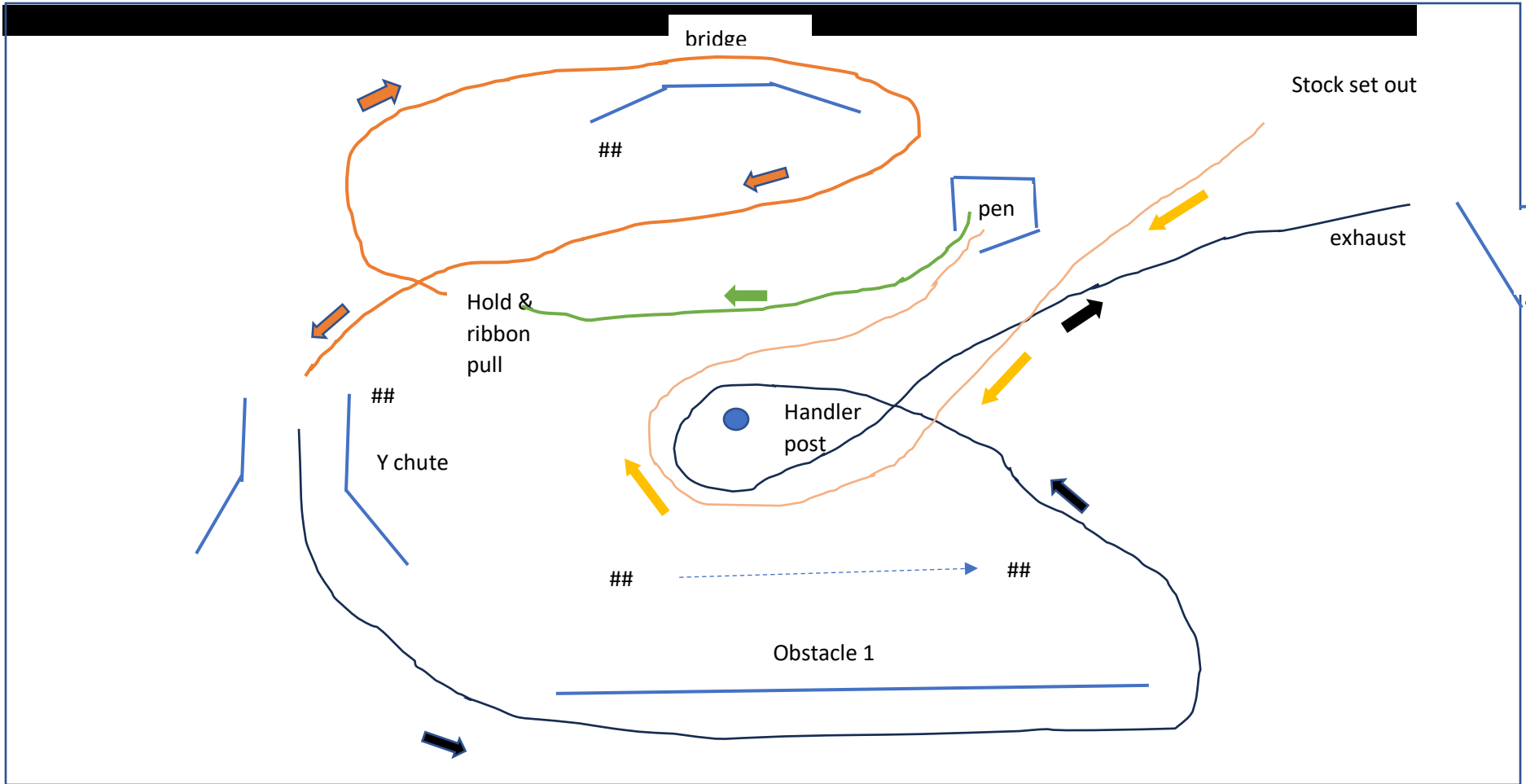
