AGREEMENT

In consideration for participation in an event sanctioned by the American Herding Breed Association (AHBA). I agree to assume all responsibility for any claim, loss or damage, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, which may be caused at or near this event, either directly or indirectly, by me or the dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event. I further agree that I will hold the AHBA, its officers, directors, agents and members harmless and defend them from any and all liability for any injury, claim, damage or loss, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, caused at or near this event, whether directly or indirectly, by me or any dog I have entered in or brought to this event. I agree to indemnify the AHBA, its officers, directors, agents and members for any loss, cost or expense including attorney's fees and costs, to which the AHBA, its officers, directors, agents or members might be subject as a result of any claim, suit, loss or damage caused in any way by any act or negligence on my part or on the part of any dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event. I acknowledge that while the AHBA may provide sanctioning for this event with regard to the issuing of titles, it does not have and does not exercise control over the conduct of the event or those present. I certify and represent that the dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event is/are not a hazard to other dogs, other animals, or to people.

I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test and Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in the Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and the "Rules for Herding Tests and Trials" have been made available to me (us) and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. Action K9 Sports Herding Events Disaster & Emergency Plan for People & Dogs

Cell and Landline phones available.

FIRE: Dial 911 - All dogs should be crated or leashed securely and owners/handlers must make sure that they, their dogs and vehicles are out of driveways that Fire and Emergency vehicles would use for approach to the site of the fire. Escondido Fire Department responds to this site.

Forest Fire: All people and their secured dogs should immediately follow fire/emergency personnel evacuation directions and orders

Earthquake: Remain on the site with dogs secured. Use arenas for emergency animal housing if necessary. Use barn or house if safe. Wait for instructions via radio.

FOR ALL INJURIES: First Aid Kit is at Clubhouse with Trial Secretary.

INJURY OR HEALTH PROBLEM WITH A PERSON: If injury is life-threatening -- **Dial 911** immediately for the emergency response team for the area. For serious, but not immediately life-threatening injury or illness, **Dial 442-281-5000** to alert **Palomar Medical Center:** 2185 Citracado Parkway, Escondido, CA 92029. Proceed with victim to the hospital.

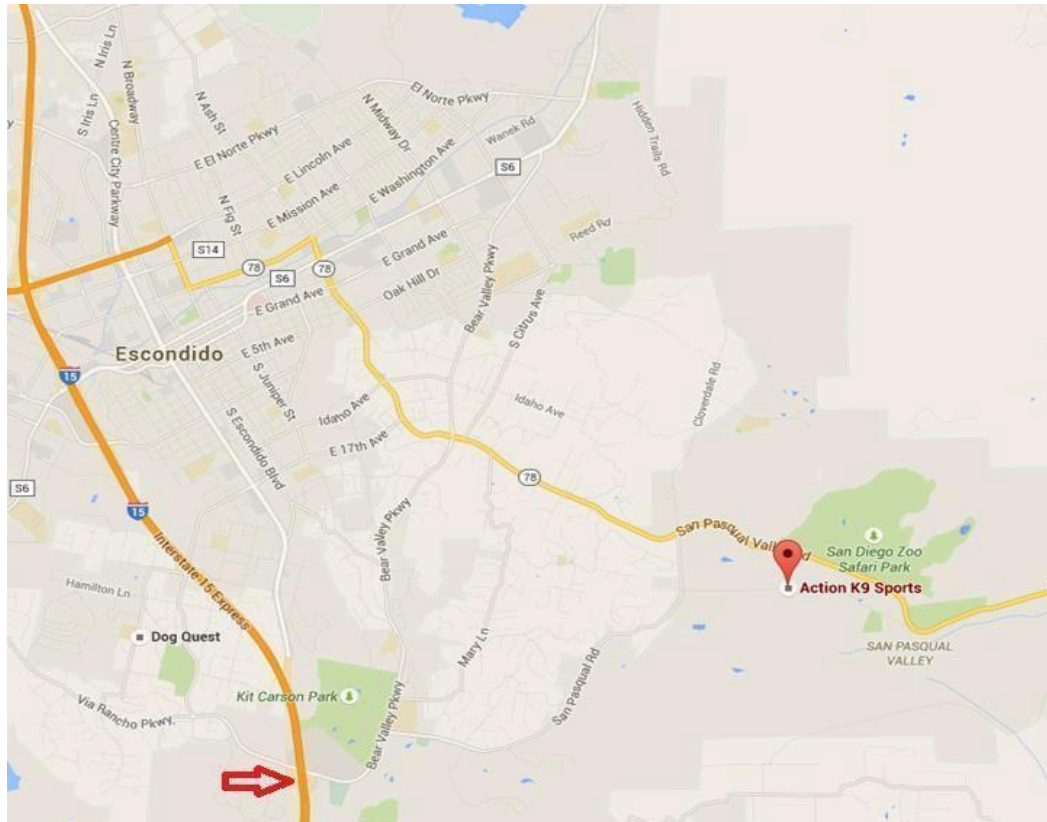

- Left at light onto 78
- Left onto 17th/Felicita
- Left at light onto S Escondido Blvd.
- Left onto West Citracado Parkway
- Clinic on left.



Action K 9 Sports, 15671 Old Milky Way, Escondido, CA



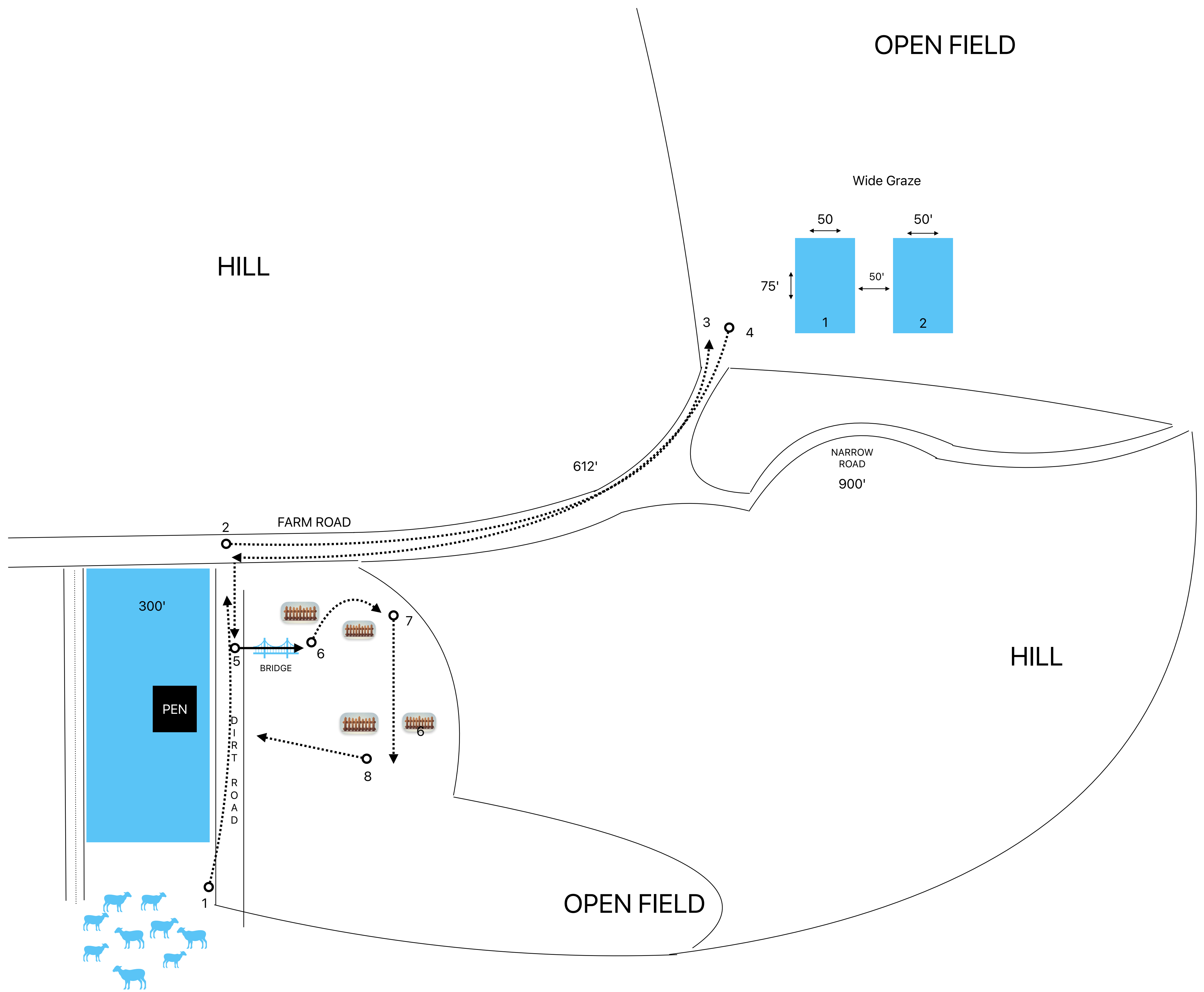
DIRECTIONS TO ACTION K9 SPORTS FROM I-15

Take exit 27/Via Rancho Parkway
Go East onto W Via Rancho Pkwy
Continue on Bear Valley Pkwy S
Turn right onto San Pasqual Rd
Turn right onto Old Milky Way

Go for 0.6 m
Go for 0.3 m
Go for 2.9 m
Go for 1.6 m

Arrive at 15671 Old Milky Way turn Left onto the dirt road for Action K9 Sport





Large Flock Diagram & Description

Level III

1. **Outrun / Lift / Fetch:** Handler & dog start at the Handler post. Gather, lift, fetch 25 head of sheep from the field to the handler.
2. **Roadwork:** Move sheep along the Farm Road to the graze, staying left at the fork. Dog may move the stock by pushing from behind, working the sides or moving to the heads to control speed.
3. **Graze:** Enter the left hand side of the field with the marked graze areas. Turn right and continue along the leading edge of the field until reaching your assigned graze. Enter the wide graze. Dog is to keep the sheep in the graze while staying outside of the graze using the Borders.
4. **Return to Ranch:** Return to the ranch, again using Farm Road. Turn left at the Dirt Road and head down hill towards the bridge.
5. **Bridge:** Turn left onto the adjacent field. All sheep, dog and handler must cross the bridge.
6. **Drive Away:** As the sheep exit the bridge, the handler stays at the exit while the dog drives the sheep through the 1st set of panels.
7. **Cross Drive:** Handler continues to remain at exit of the bridge while dog turns the sheep right and drives them through the Cross Drive panels.
8. **Pen:** Handler meets dog at the pen to secure the stock.

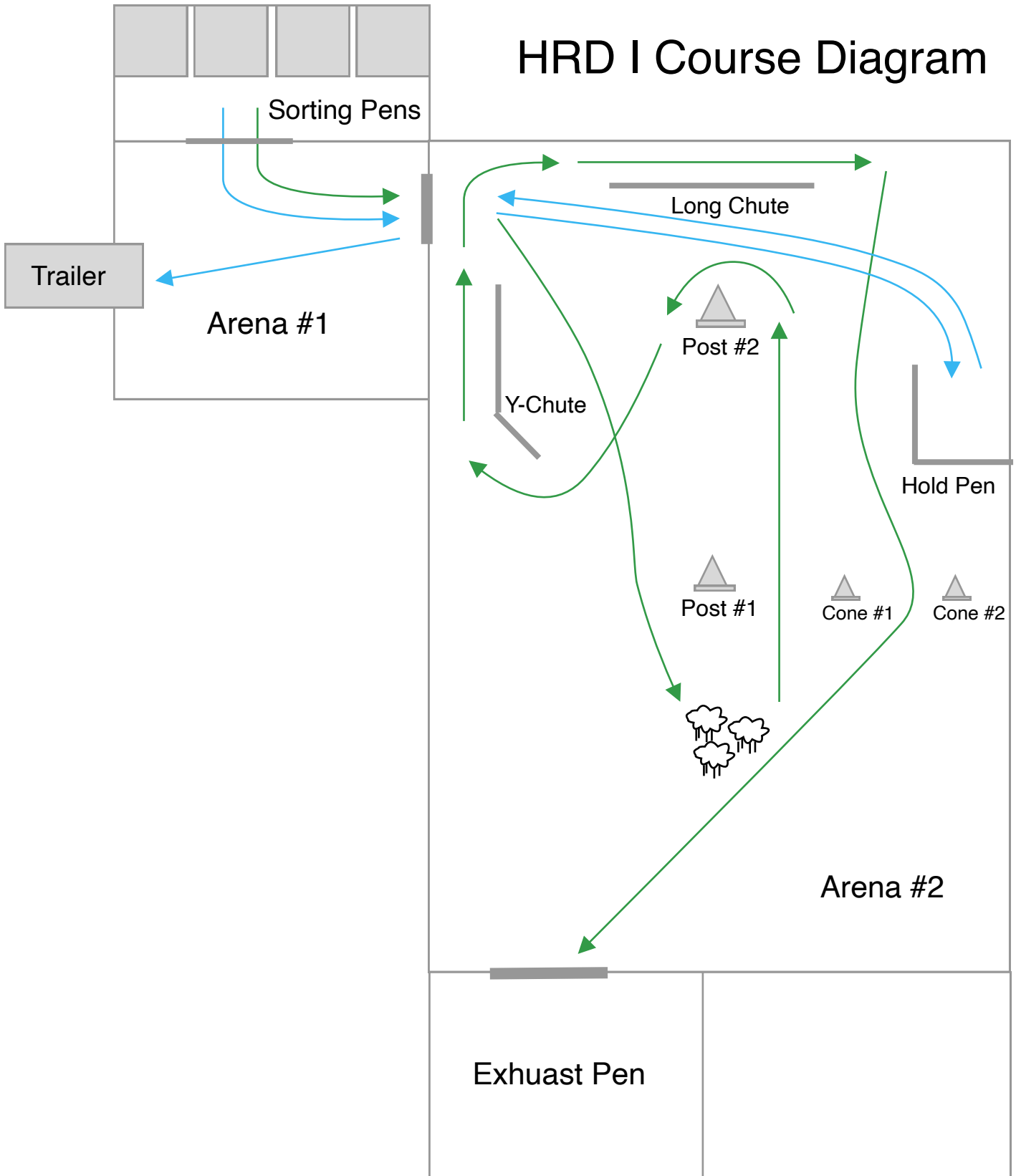
Level II

1. **Outrun / Lift / Fetch:** Dog is placed at post. Handler may go half-way to the stock. Gather, lift, fetch 25 head of sheep from the field to the handler, continuing up the Dirt Road toward Farm Road.
2. **Roadwork:** Move sheep along Farm Road to the Graze, staying left at the fork. Dog may move the stock by pushing from behind, working the sides or moving to the heads to control speed.
3. **Graze:** Enter the left hand side of the field with the marked graze areas. Turn right and continue along the leading edge of the field until reaching your assigned graze. Enter the Graze. Dog is to keep the sheep in the Graze while staying outside of the graze using the Borders.
4. **Return to Ranch:** Return to the ranch, again using Farm Road. Turn left at the Dirt Road and head down hill towards the bridge.
5. **Bridge:** Turn left onto the adjacent field. All sheep, dog and handler must cross the bridge.
6. **Drive Away:** After exiting the bridge, the handler & dog fetch/drive to the first set of panels.
7. **Cross Drive:** Once the sheep are through the Drive Away Panels, Handler stays at the panels and turns the sheep right and then through the second set of panels.
8. **Pen:** After the sheep have passed the second set of panels, Handler moves to the pen to secure the stock.

Level I

1. **Outrun / Lift / Fetch:** Dog is placed halfway between post & the stock. Handler can be within 15' of the stock. Handler may fetch or drive throughout, with the Handler in any position.
2. **Roadwork:** Move sheep along Farm Road to the Graze, staying left at the fork. Dog may move the stock by pushing from behind, working the sides or moving to the heads to control speed.
3. **Graze:** Enter the left hand side of the field with marked graze areas. Turn right and continue along the leading edge of the field until reaching your assigned graze. Enter the Graze. Dog is to keep the sheep in the Graze while staying outside of the graze using the Borders.
4. **Return to Ranch:** Return to the ranch, again using Farm Road. Turn left at the Dirt Road and head down hill towards the bridge.
5. **Bridge:** Turn left onto the adjacent field. All sheep, dog and handler must cross the bridge.
6. **Drive Away:** Upon successfully crossing the bridge, stock is to move through the 1st set of panels.
7. **Cross Drive:** Once through the Drive Away Panels, stock is to be turned right and moved through the Cross Drive Panels.
8. **Pen:** Upon completing the Cross Drive, stock is to be moved to and secured in the pen.

HRD I Course Diagram



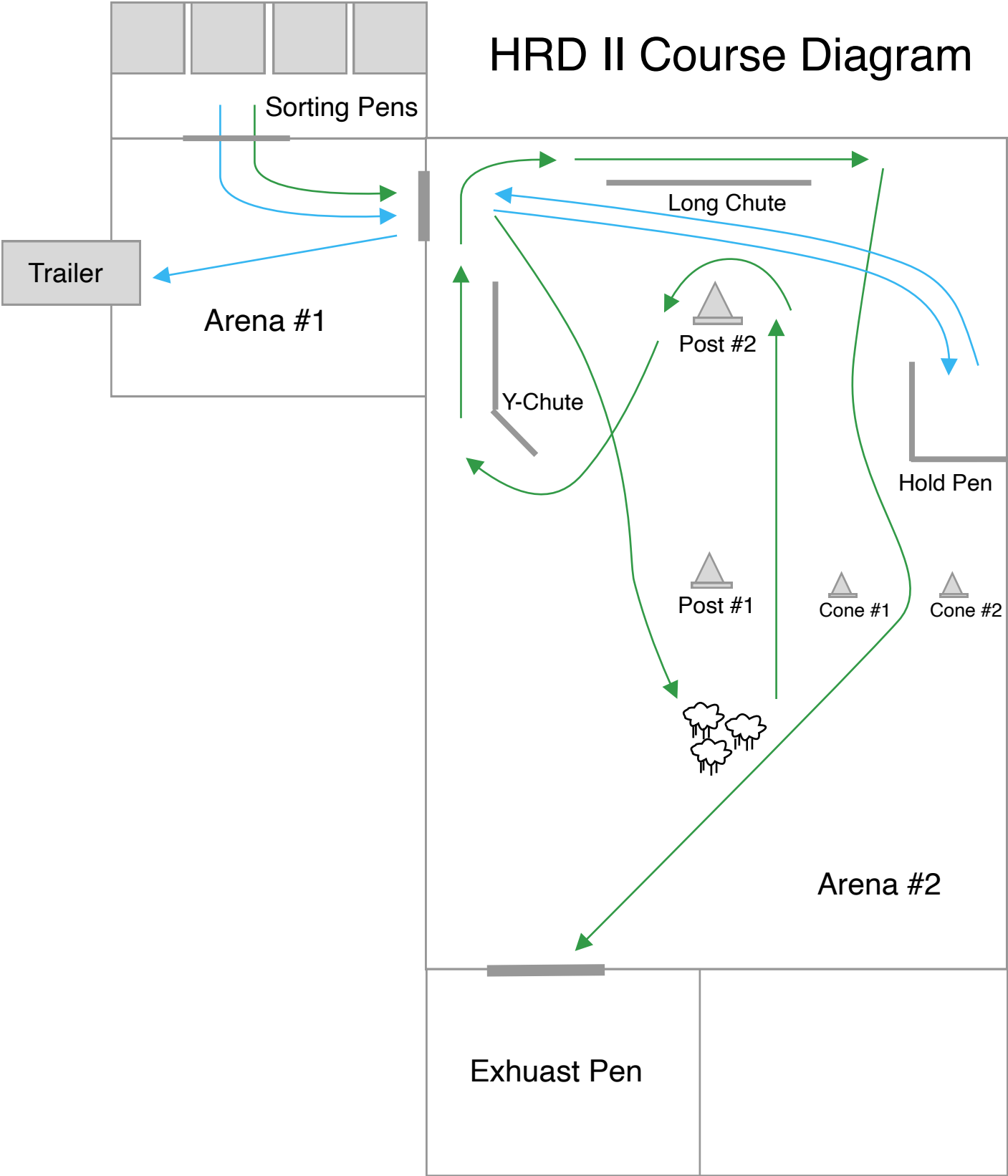
HRD I Course Description:

1. Handler and dog go into Sorting Pens and to take out 10 sheep.
 2. Puts those ten sheep into Arena #1.
 3. Handler and dog will bring the 10 sheep to the gate to start sorting.
 4. Sort any 5 sheep into Arena #2. If you're having trouble sorting, the handler may use the Sorting Pens to put and leave any unwanted sheep in.
 5. Once all sheep are in Arena #2, dog and handler will go into Arena #2 and make sure that the sheep are on the hay. There will be hay in the arena and the sheep should naturally go to the hay.
 6. Place dog at Post 1; handler can go to within 15 feet of sheep.
 7. Send dog, either direction to gather sheep.
 8. Handler, dog, and sheep will walk up to and around Post #2 then head to the Y-Chute.
 9. Once the Y-Chute is completed, proceed to Long Chute. Help your dog move the sheep through the Long Chute. Dog must follow sheep through Chute.
 10. After Long Chute, start walking towards and through, Cone #1 and Cone #2.
 11. Then proceed to Exhaust Pen to pen sheep.
 12. Go back to Arena #1 and gather the 5 sheep you left, and bring those 5 sheep into Arena #2.
 13. Proceed to the 3-sided inspection Holding Pen. The Judge will let you know when you can let them out, then proceed back to Arena #1
 14. Once in Arena #1, load sheep into trailer. Remember to close the door.
- The course is now complete.

HRD II Course Diagram



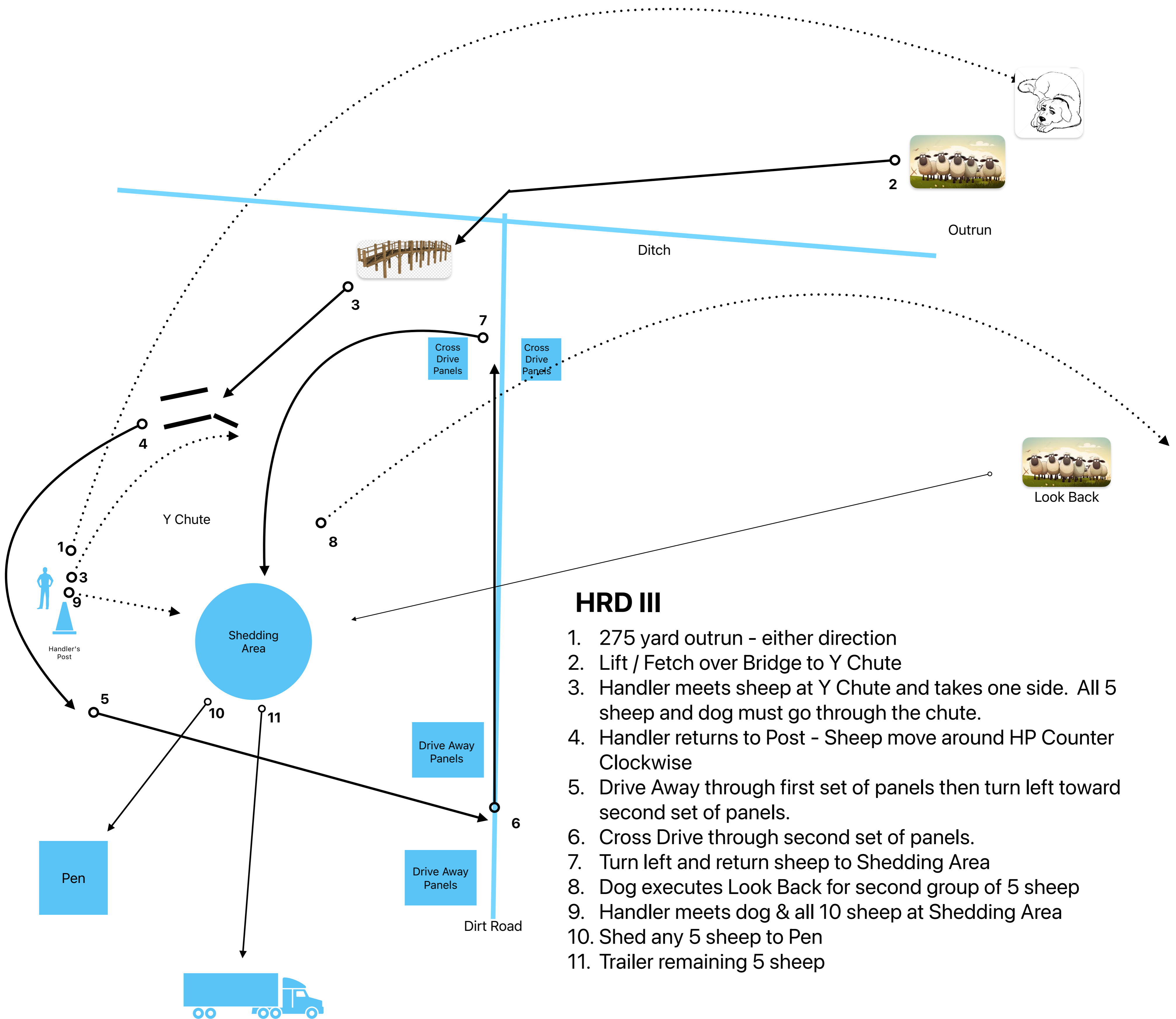
HRD Level II Course:

1. Handler and dog go into Sorting Pens and take out 10 sheep.
 2. Puts those 10 sheep into Arena #1.
 3. Handler and dog will bring the 10 sheep to the gate to start sorting.
 4. Sort 5 sheep; two will be marked into Arena #2. If you're having trouble sorting, the handler may use Sorting Pens to put and leave the unwanted sheep in.
 5. Once all sheep are in Arena #2, dog and handler will go into Arena #2 and make sure the sheep are on the hay. There will be hay in the arena and the sheep should naturally go to the hay.
 6. Place dog at Post 2; handler can go 1/2 way to sheep.
 7. Send dog, either direction to gather sheep.
 8. Handler, dog, and sheep will walk up to and around Post #2 then head to the Y-Chute.
 9. Once the Y-Chute is completed, the handler must stay at the Y-Chute and drive sheep to the Long Chute. Handler may proceed to Long Chute when the first sheep reaches the opening. All sheep must go into the chute and the dog must be in the chute sufficiently to hold the sheep. The handler opens the gate at the exit and dog must stay in the chute and push all sheep through the exit gate
 10. When the Long Chute is completed, the Handler will stay at the Long Chute and drive sheep through Cone #1 and Cone #2.
 11. Once the last sheep pass the cones, the handler can leave and head to the Exhaust Pen to pen sheep.
 12. Go back to Arena #1 and gather the 5 sheep into Arena #2.
 13. Proceed to the 3-sided inspection Holding Pen. The Judge will let you know when you can let them out, then proceed back to Arena #1
 14. Once in Arena #1, load sheep into trailer. Remember to close the door.
- The course is now complete.

Tiebreaker: (1) Drive to the long chute (2) Sort marked sheep (3) Time

HRD III Diagram & Description



HRD III

1. 275 yard outrun - either direction
2. Lift / Fetch over Bridge to Y Chute
3. Handler meets sheep at Y Chute and takes one side. All 5 sheep and dog must go through the chute.
4. Handler returns to Post - Sheep move around HP Counter Clockwise
5. Drive Away through first set of panels then turn left toward second set of panels.
6. Cross Drive through second set of panels.
7. Turn left and return sheep to Shedding Area
8. Dog executes Look Back for second group of 5 sheep
9. Handler meets dog & all 10 sheep at Shedding Area
10. Shed any 5 sheep to Pen
11. Trailer remaining 5 sheep
