Location: Free To Be Ranch, 54 Curandera Rd. Mountainair, NM

Times: Day of Trial Entries—8:00a.m. each day

Handlers' meeting—8:30a.m. each day Judging to immediately follow handlers' meeting.

Classes/Stock: All classes on mixed hair sheep. Replacement Cost \$200.

HTAD Course 3—Levels I, II, & III (\$50.00)

HTD—Levels I, II, & III (\$50.00)

JHD(\$50.00)

Entries open March 20, 2025. Closing date—April 20, 2025. No entries accepted prior the postmark date. No DHL, UPS, telephone, email, or faxed entries accepted. Late entries accepted until April 25 or until the trial is full (25 runs per day). Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. No refunds after close date.

*A \$50 service fee will apply to all returned checks. Returned checks will not constitute a valid entry.

Eligibility: Trial class and JHD dogs must be 9 months of age or older. Bitches in heat will run in the order drawn. Non-competing runs will be allowed; such runs will be judged solely as exhibition only and are not eligible for placement or prizes. A dog may be entered at any level for which it is trained. There are no title prerequisites. A dog may not be entered in both a test class (JHD) and a trial class (HTD or HTAD).

Order of Events for both days: Trial will be run from most advanced to least beginning with Level 3 HTD first, followed by level 2 and 1. HTAD Level 3 will follow, then levels 2 and 1. JHD will run last.

Herding Trial Arena Dog (HTAD) Course 3: A pen will be used at all levels. Sheep will be set out for all levels. A ribbon pull will be used for Level 3. Review all other course specifics on the AHBA website.

HTD: Ribbon pull rather than a shed.

Awards: First, second, and third place ribbons awarded in trial classes, and qualifying ribbons for test classes.

Food: Lunch provided for judges and workers only.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO FREE TO BE RANCH

Mountainair is located 60 miles south east of Albuquerque. The ranch is 30

minutes from either Interstate 40 or from Interstate 25.

The ranch is 1/2 mile off Hwy 60 on Curandera Road - Curandera Road is between mile marker 208 & 209 on Hwy 60.

DIRECTIONS FROM INTERSTATE 40 IN NEW MEXICO:

Take exit 196 in Moriarity, go south on Hwy 41 until it dead ends into Hwy 60 Take a right (west) onto Hwy 60 - go approximately 7 miles on Hwy 60 On Hwy 60 go 1/2 mile past mile marker 209 to CURANDERA RD Turn right (North) onto CURANDERA RD - We are the first ranch on your left

DIRECTIONS FROM INTERSTATE 25 IN NEW MEXICO:

Take Exit 175 in Bernardo, go east on Hwy 60 Go thru blinking light in the town of Mountainair (we are about 4 1/2 miles from the light) On Hwy 60 go 1/2 mile past mile marker 208 to CURANDERA RD Turn left (North) onto CURANDERA RD - we are the first ranch on your left.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Entry fee refunds will be issued after close of pre-entries only if there is a waiting list and somebody takes your run. Should an additional judge need to be hired due to an abundance of entries, no refund will be given after close of pre-entries.

Registered Owner of dog shall be responsible for replacement cost of livestock at the following prices: SHEEP - \$200.00 per head.

I assume full responsibility and liability of the dogs I enter and certify that they are current on all vaccinations. I also agree to be responsible for paying the market value for any animal mortally injured by my dogs and for any vet bills incurred on any animals injured by my dog(s). I understand that attendance at this event is not without risk to myself or my dog(s) because some of the dogs and livestock to which I will be exposed may be difficult to control and may be the cause of injury even when handled with the greatest amount care.
