IMPORTANT INFORMATION

AHBA RULE: Registration/tracking number is required for ALL dogs. This can be from any canine organization, or you can contact AHBA for a free number.

TEST/TRIAL RULES: Test/Trials are held in accordance with current AHBA rules posted at www.ahba-herding.org.

- Dogs must be 6 months or older for AHBA HCT Tests and 9 months or older for JHD Test and all Trial classes.
- Bitches in season may run at the end of **TESTS** and anytime during **TRIALS**.
- All HCT entries are required to be on AHBA's list of Accepted Herding Breeds. mixes cannot enter HCT. All breeds and mixes may enter JHD and al Trial classes. Contact the Event Secretary if you have questions.
- Fun Runs: FEO runs are allowed at this trial, if there is room. However, you may only run your dog in a class for which he has already qualified. If your run is out of control, you may be asked to end the run. Fun runs will be held immediately after the competitive runs in each class. No dog running a competitive class may also be run FEO in the same class. Contact Shannon Wolfe for more information, min@magicslegacy.com.

FARM RULES:

- All dogs must have current vaccination for rabies and other communicable diseases as recommended by your veterinarian, and should be parasite free.
- **PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS**... poop bags are available around the farm.
- All dogs must be on a leash or crated when not working.
- **NO FLEXI-TYPE LEASHES ARE ALLOWED ON THE FARM.** Please keep your dogs on a short leash at all times.
- Water pools are provided, but there is little or no shade, so plan accordingly.
- Handlers and spectators should keep their dogs at least 15 feet back from the fenced arena while a dog is working.

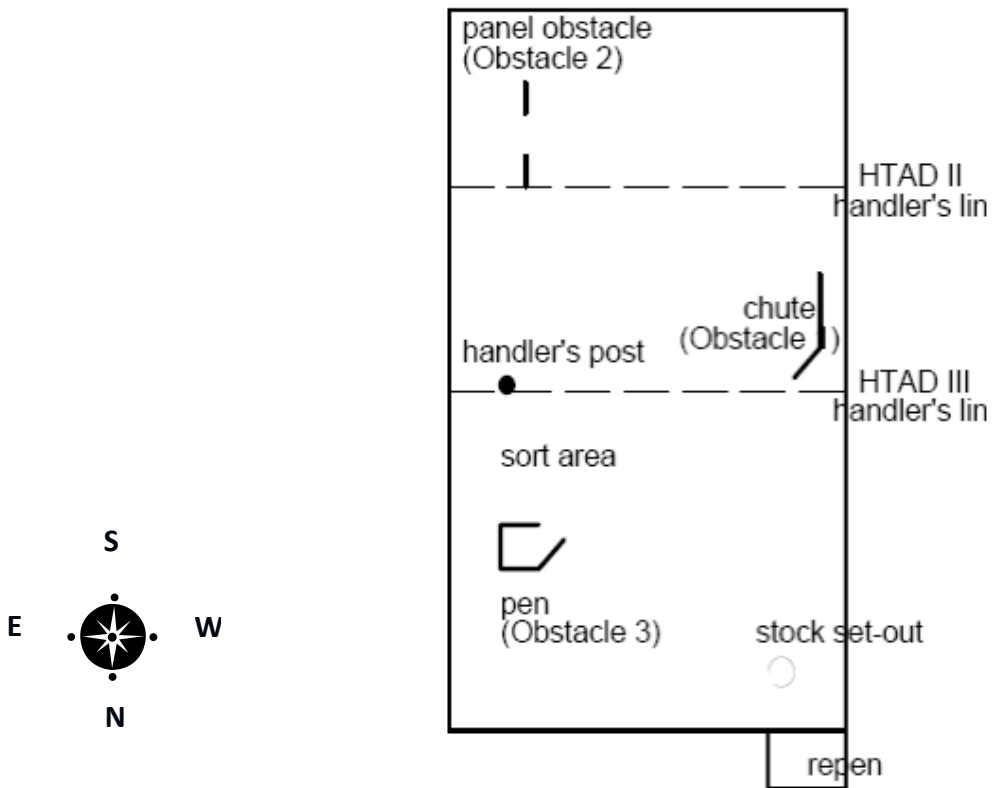

HTAD (Sheep) Course #2

COURSE #2



90/100 - 10 min. I & II; 12 min. III - 5 Animals
Ties Determined by (1) gather/take-pen, (2) re-pen, (3) time

SAT - Take Pen; and at #6 - III will do a gate sort
SUN - Gather; and at #6 - III will do a gate sort

HTAD (Sheep) Course #2

1. Gather or Take-Pen

Gather: The stock are let out at the re-pen gate and allowed to settle. HTAD I handlers take the dog to a point approximately one-half the distance from the handler's post to the stock and leave the dog; the handler may move to approximately 15 ft. from the stock and send the dog to gather. HTAD II handlers leave the dog at the handler's post and move to a point approximately halfway between the post and the stock and send the dog to gather. HTAD III handlers and dogs stay at the handler's post, and the dog is sent from there to gather the stock. At all three levels the stock are brought to and around the handler's post, on the side between the post and the Y chute. The gather ends when the stock have gone just past the handler's post.

Take-Pen: HTAD III handlers must remain outside the pen while the dog brings out the stock. HTAD II handlers may enter the pen with the dog but should not move the stock themselves. HTAD I handlers may enter the pen and assist the dog in moving the stock. If the stock come out on their own volition without the handler or dog entering, there is no penalty. The stock are then taken to the point on the course where the handler's post would be located for the gather. Scoring for the take-pen ends when the stock have reached that point at which the handler's post would be located. The course then proceeds as indicated in the description.

2. Drive

The stock are taken NORTH between the EAST fence and the freestanding pen, then around the pen to a point just in front of the pen gate. Handlers at all levels may accompany the stock to this point. The stock are then driven to the Y chute. HTAD I handlers may accompany the dog and stock, fetching or driving or a combination of both. HTAD II handlers may accompany the stock and dog to a point halfway to the Y chute. HTAD III handlers must remain at the position in front of the pen while the stock are driven to the Y chute. The drive ends when the stock reach a point 10 ft. in front of the Y chute.

3. Obstacle 1

The stock are taken through the Y chute. HTAD II and III handlers remain at the designated location until the stock have cleared the Y chute. HTAD I handlers remain at the entrance of the Y chute until the stock have cleared it. Obstacle 1 ends when the stock have cleared the Y chute.

4. Obstacle 2

Upon the stock exiting the Y chute, HTAD I handlers may fetch or drive the stock through the freestanding panels, Obstacle 2 (none of the handlers may go through the panels). HTAD II handlers must stay on the post side of the handler's line (which runs across the width of the arena, even with the outside edge of the panel obstacle that is nearest the center of the arena) until the stock have cleared the panel obstacle. HTAD III handlers will remain behind a handler's line that runs the width of the arena even with the handler's post until the stock have cleared the panel obstacle. Once the stock have cleared the panel obstacle, the stock are turned to the left and taken to the pen; all handlers may take any position relative to the stock when going to the pen. Obstacle 2 ends when the stock have cleared the panels.

5. Obstacle 3

The stock are penned in the freestanding pen. Scoring for the pen ends when the pen gate is closed.

6. Sort

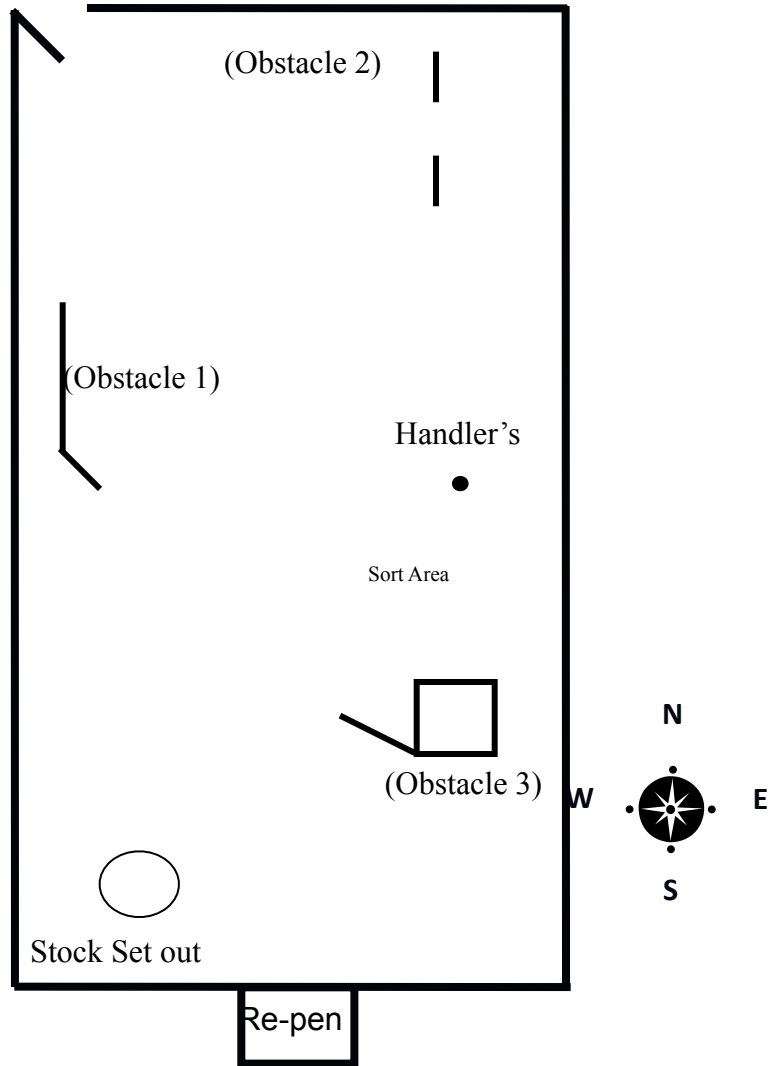
The animals are removed from the pen and taken to the sorting area. HTAD I and II handlers briefly hold the stock, then take them to the re-pen. For HTAD III handlers, the sort may be one of the following: (a) Gate sort of designated animals, (b) Ribbon-removal, or (c) Shed. The sort ends for HTAD I and II at the conclusion of the hold, and for HTAD III when the gate is closed on the sorted animals, or when the ribbon has been removed, or animals have been shed.

6. Re-pen

The stock are taken to the re-pen and held a short distance off the gate while it is opened, and then they are re-penned. When a gate-sort has been used, the animals that had been left out in the arena are re-penned. The run ends when the re-pen gate is closed.

HTAD (Ducks) Course #2

(50' x100")



90/100 — 10 min. I & II; 12 min. III — 5 Ducks

Ties Determined by (1) gather, (2) shed, (3) time

SAT & SUN - Gather; and at #6, III does a 3/2 shed

HTAD (Ducks) Course #2

7. Gather or Take-Pen

Gather: The stock are let out at the re-pen gate and allowed to settle. HTAD I handlers take the dog to a point approximately one-half the distance from the handler's post to the stock and leave the dog; the handler may move to approximately 15 ft. from the stock and send the dog to gather. HTAD II handlers leave the dog at the handler's post and move to a point approximately halfway between the post and the stock and send the dog to gather. HTAD III handlers and dogs stay at the handler's post, and the dog is sent from there to gather the stock. At all three levels the stock are brought to and around the handler's post, on the side between the post and the Y chute. The gather ends when the stock have gone just past the handler's post.

Take-Pen: HTAD III handlers must remain outside the pen while the dog brings out the stock. HTAD II handlers may enter the pen with the dog but should not move the stock themselves. HTAD I handlers may enter the pen and assist the dog in moving the stock. If the stock come out on their own volition without the handler or dog entering, there is no penalty. The stock are then taken to the point on the course where the handler's post would be located for the gather. Scoring for the take-pen ends when the stock have reached that point at which the handler's post would be located. The course then proceeds as indicated in the description.

8. Drive

The stock are taken SOUTH between the EAST fence and the freestanding pen, then around the pen to a point just in front of the pen gate. Handlers at all levels may accompany the stock to this point. The stock are then driven to the Y chute. HTAD I handlers may accompany the dog and stock, fetching or driving or a combination of both. HTAD II handlers may accompany the stock and dog to a point halfway to the Y chute. HTAD III handlers must remain at the position in front of the pen while the stock are driven to the Y chute. The drive ends when the stock reach a point 10 ft. in front of the Y chute.

9. Obstacle 1

The stock are taken through the Y chute. HTAD II and III handlers remain at the designated location until the stock have cleared the Y chute. HTAD I handlers remain at the entrance of the Y chute until the stock have cleared it. Obstacle 1 ends when the stock have cleared the Y chute.

10. Obstacle 2

Upon the stock exiting the Y chute, HTAD I handlers may fetch or drive the stock through the freestanding panels, Obstacle 2 (none of the handlers may go through the panels). HTAD II handlers must stay on the post side of the handler's line (which runs across the width of the arena, even with the outside edge of the panel obstacle that is nearest the center of the arena) until the stock have cleared the panel obstacle. HTAD III handlers will remain behind a handler's line that runs the width of the arena even with the handler's post until the stock have cleared the panel obstacle. Once the stock have cleared the panel obstacle, the stock are turned to the left and taken to the pen; all handlers may take any position relative to the stock when going to the pen. Obstacle 2 ends when the stock have cleared the panels.

11. Obstacle 3

The stock are penned in the freestanding pen. Scoring for the pen ends when the pen gate is closed.

6. Sort

The animals are removed from the pen and taken to the sorting area. HTAD I and II handlers briefly hold the stock, then take them to the re-pen. For HTAD III handlers, the sort may be one of the following: (a) Gate sort of designated animals, (b) Ribbon-removal, or (c) Shed. The sort ends for HTAD I and II at the conclusion of the hold, and for HTAD III when the gate is closed on the sorted animals, or when the ribbon has been removed, or animals have been shed.

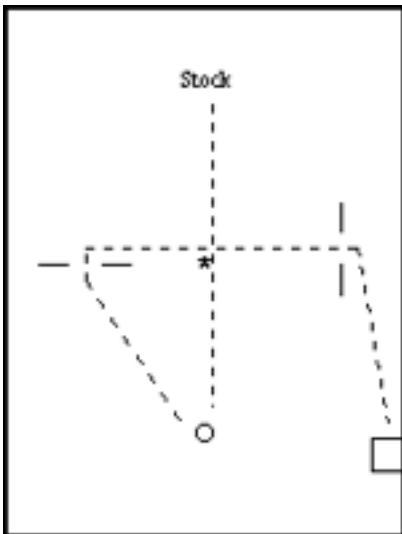
12. Re-pen

The stock are taken to the re-pen and held a short distance off the gate while it is opened, and then they are re-penned. When a gate-sort has been used, the animals that had been left out in the arena are re-penned. The run ends when the re-pen gate is closed.

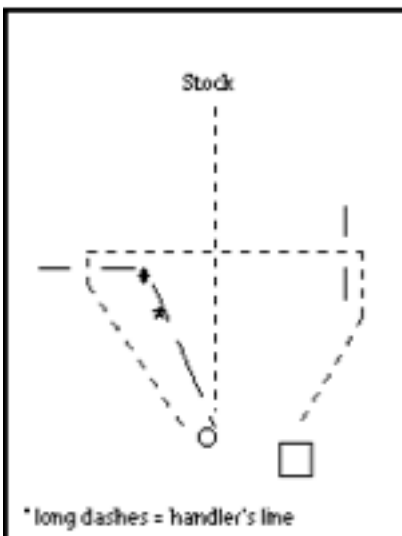

Ties broken by: 1. Fetch, 2. Pen, 3. Time



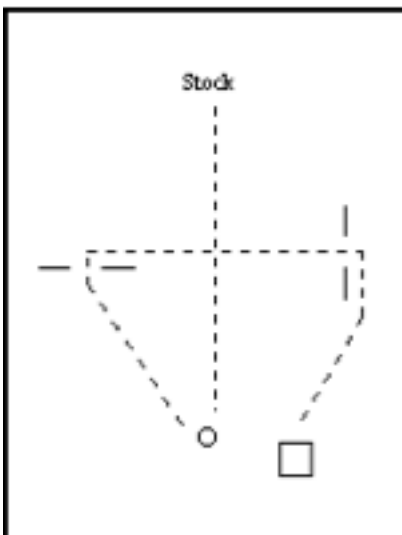
HTD-I

For the gather, the dog may be sent out here*; the handler may move closer to the stock.



HTD-II

For the gather, the dog is set out near the post; then handler may move forward but not past the panels. After moving the stock around the post and to the obstacle, the handler remains here* or anywhere behind the handler's line while the dog moves the stock through the second obstacle.



HTD-III

For the gather, the dog is set out near the handler's post. The handler remains at the post until time to go to the pen. the second obstacle.

If the injury is severe, the owner will pay the market value or value stated in the premium list of the stock injured.

Handler and Owner acknowledge that herding events are inherently dangerous and have risks of injury to persons. Handler and Owner agree to assume the risk of any harm arising from the hazards associated with the herding event which include but are not limited to, parking areas, ground conditions, animals, stock used in the herding event, and other dogs.

Handler and Owner hereby release AHBA, its officers, directors agents and members, including Shannon Wolfe, Magic's Legacy (its officers, agents and directors) and the owners of the site of the event, from any and all liability for any injury, loss or damage, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property which occurs directly or indirectly or associated with the herding event.
