Eligibility: Trial is open to all breeds 9 months of age and older. Dogs must be sound and of good health.

Sheep Count: We will be using 5-6 sheep for HRD, 3-4 sheep for JHD and HCT.

Ducks Count: We will be using 5 ducks

Stock replacement value per head: \$250 per sheep, \$75 per duck

There is an additional fee of \$2.00 per entry for online entries.

Entry forms can be mailed and then followed up with PayPal payment to chdogevents@aol.com. Entries are considered accepted when entry form and payment are matched up – confirmation will be sent out as soon as that occurs.

Confirmation of Entry will be sent to the email address(s) on the Official entry form within 48 hours of receipt, if you do not receive email confirmation promptly please contact Trial secretary. Judging Schedule will be sent after close of entries.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTER-NATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, (unless replaced by an alternate), disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Post Dated Checks & Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

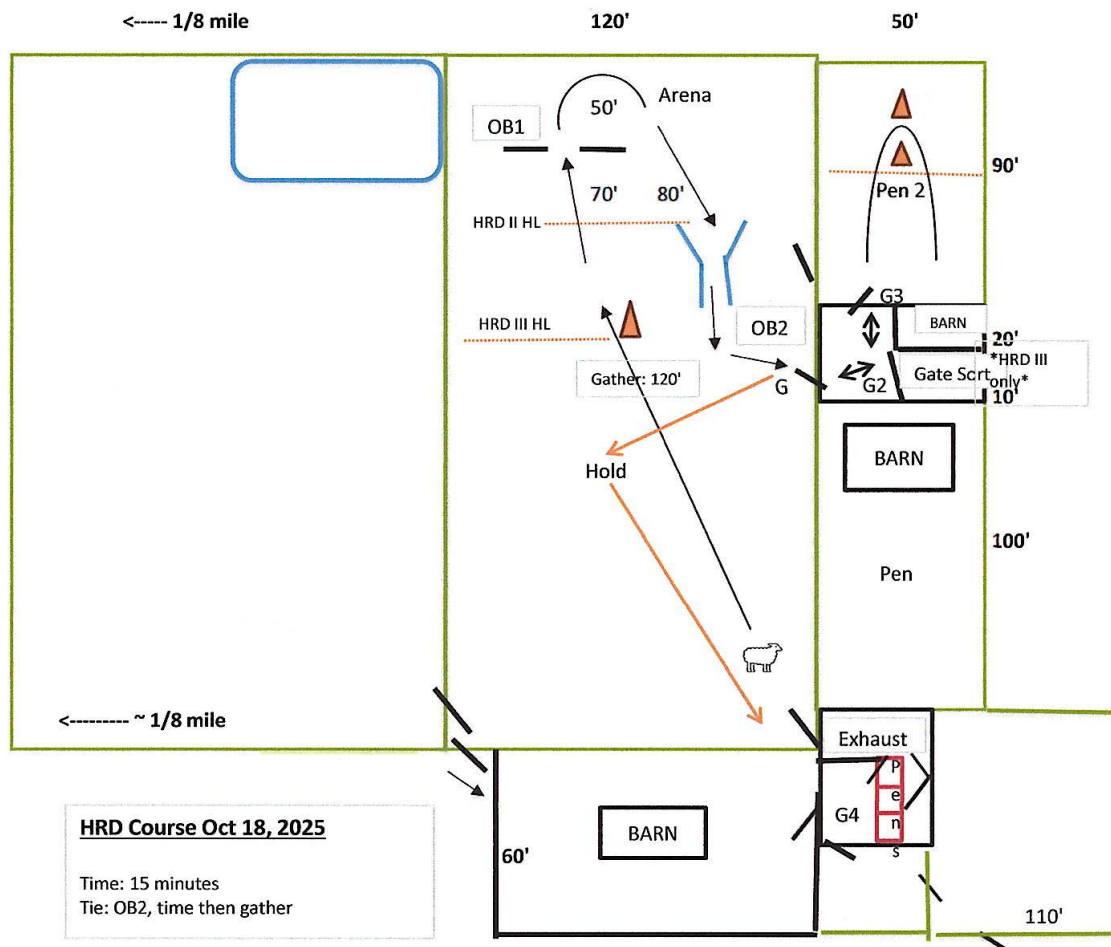
High Scoring Australian Shepherd Rosette and toy – offered by Champion Dog Events each day

Owners/handlers will be expected to clean up after their dogs. Dog walking area will be along the dirt road north of the white fence. A scoop and bags will be provided if needed.

Please be prepared with shade cloths, easy-ups, rain gear, sun screen etc.....weather can vary throughout the day. A bath/cool off tub will be provided.



1. Gather: III- H and dog at cone, II - Dog at cone H 1/2way to sheep, I- Dog 1/2way, H up to 15' from sheep. F/D to cone.
2. Fetch/Drive (F/D) to/past cone to/Thru OB1: III - H at cone until sheep exit OB2, II- H may walk up 1/2 way between OB1 and cone (may move laterally after sheep exit OB1), I- H may walk anywhere including thru OB1.
3. Right turn/east to OB2: III- still at cone, may walk when sheep exit OB2, II- stay on HL, but may move laterally once sheep exit OB1 (may walk after sheep exit OB2), I - may walk anywhere but thru OB2
4. All levels: F/D to G1, sheep into pen.
5. ***Level III **EXTRA****. Gate Sort 2 sheep into alleyway (thru G2): **5 pts sort**
6. All levels- sheep thru G3 f/d into pen 2. F/D thru cones and back to G3 (either direction). III and II cannot cross plane of cones, I- may walk anywhere, including thru the cones.
7. Exhaust sheep back thru G3 into pen.
8. ***Level III **EXTRA****- gather all sheep back together from alleyway (**5 pts**)
9. All sheep thru G1 back to arena. Out to middle for a HOLD.
10. F/D to Exhaust: III- must show hold off open gate to exhaust. II- must show hold off partially open gate, I- show hold off closed gate.

CONCESIONS: Lunch, Snacks and bottled water will be provided. Bring chairs and canopies for shade.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

4500 Private Rd 162, Elizabeth, CO 80107
(Second house on the left, white with black trim)

From Castle Rock:

Take Hwy 86 through Franktown and through the town of Elizabeth. At the top of the hill--turn left/north on County Rd 21. Go north on CR 21 for 5.7 miles to Private Rd 162. Turn left/west on PR 162 (dirt road).

From Castle Pines:

Take Hess Rd east --will turn into Hilltop ~1 mile after crossing Parker Road-- stay on for another 4-5 miles to Singing Hills (can only turn left/east). Stay on Singing Hills east for approx. 7 miles (past 2 four-way stops) to County Rd 21 (First right after the second four-way stop). Can only turn right/south at CR 21. Go 1 mile south to Private Rd 162. Turn right/west on PR 162 (dirt road).

From Parker:

Parker Road/Hwy 83 to Hess Rd. Left/east on Hess Rd— will turn into Hilltop after about a mile--stay on for another 4-5 miles to Singing Hills (can only turn left/east again). Stay on Singing Hills east for approx. 7 miles (past 2 four-way stops) to County Rd 21 (First right after the second four-way stop). Right/south at CR 21. Go 1 mile south to Private Rd 162. Turn right/west on PR 162 (dirt road).

From Colorado Springs:

(I-25) North to Castle Rock (Wilcox exit) North to Hwy 86. East on 86 through Franktown to Elizabeth. Continue through Elizabeth--look for County Rd 21 at the top of the hill on your way out of Elizabeth. Left (North) on CR 21 for 5.7 miles to Private Rd 162. Left (west) on Private Rd 162 (dirt road). You can also come up from Colorado Springs on Hwy 83 to Franktown, then turn right (west) on Hwy 86 to Elizabeth and continue. More scenic and usually less traffic.

Disaster and Emergency Plans for People and Dogs at this Herding Event

- **Fire:** Dial 911. All dogs should be crated or leashed securely. Owners, Handlers and Spectators must keep the main driveway clear so Emergency vehicles will have suitable access to the property.
- **Thunderstorms and Lightning:** Should lightning be observed, all people and dogs should move to the safety of their vehicles or covered buildings until the danger has passed.
- **Mass Disaster Plan – Tornado:** In the event of a tornado, dogs should be leashed and all people and their dogs should proceed to the lowest point on the property until the danger has passed.
- **Personal Injury or Health Problems:** Dial 911 for the Emergency Response Team/Ambulance, or see above.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ✓ A separate entry blank must be completed for each dog entered. Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the running order. Please notify the Trial Secretary if your bitch is in season.
- ✓ Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the trial will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.
- ✓ The Trial Secretary will void and destroy any and all checks to be refunded after the event. Checks will not be returned via mail.
- ✓ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee/Judge.
- ✓ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee/Judge, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ✓ Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Trial arena. Judge is not required to wait for dogs.
- ✓ Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- ✓ No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, extreme weather conditions, or any other cause beyond the control of the Trial Committee.
- ✓ No entry fee will be refunded in the case of duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing of entries.
- ✓ All dogs (except property owners dogs) must be on leash at all times except when in the Trial arena regardless of how well you think your dog is trained or behaved. Dogs not on leash will be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ✓ **Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition!**
