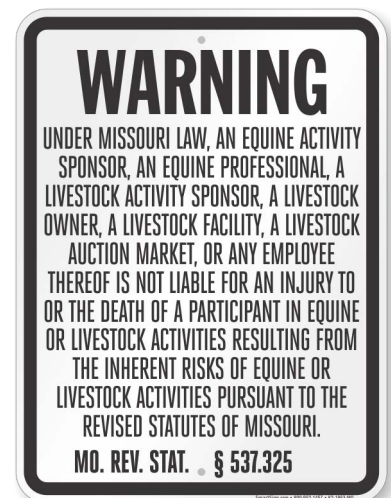
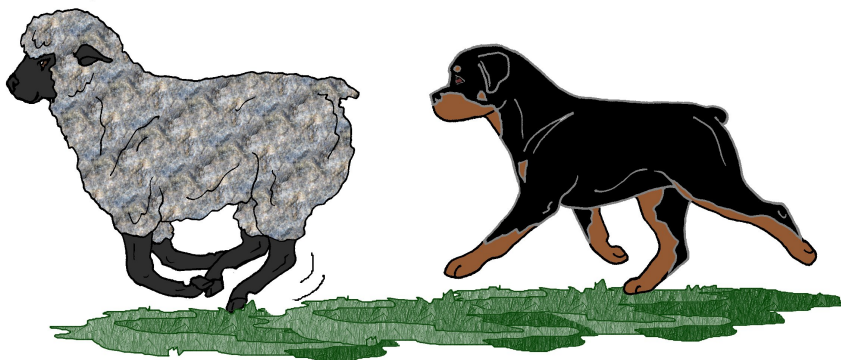

Notice to Exhibitors

The Trial Secretary is not responsible for emails not received. If you have not received a response to an email after 48 hours, please call the Trial Secretary by telephone.

The Safety of the dogs and stock is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and venue.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the veterinarian, judge, or Trial Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the sponsor.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Post Dated and Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be placed at the end of the running order in Tests and in catalog order for Trial classes.

It is expressly understood that **exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.** Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show site and all hotel, motel, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. RottiEwe Farm has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public-address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the arena when required. All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times except when in the arena.

Dogs must wear a simple well-fitting buckle, snap lock, or slip collar (no tags) or may work without a collar at Trial levels. RottiEwe Farm and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

Eligibility All dogs nine months of age or older are eligible to participate in Herding Trials and JHD. Dogs classified as Herding Dogs in AHBA are eligible for Herding Test HCT and may participate at six months of age or older. No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any test/trial. Bitches in season shall run in drawn running order without adjustment.

READ BEFORE SIGNING In consideration for participating in an event sanctioned by the American Herding Breed Association (AHBA), I agree to assume all responsibility for any claim, loss or damage, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, which may be caused at or near this event, either directly or indirectly, by me or the dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event. I further agree that I will hold the AHBA, RottiEwe Farm, Don and Tracy Parciak, its officers, directors, agents and members harmless and defend them from any and all liability for any injury, claim, damage or loss, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, caused at or near this event, whether directly or indirectly, by me or any dog I have entered in or brought to this event. I agree to indemnify the AHBA, RottiEwe Farm, Don or Tracy Parciak, its officers, directors, agents or members for any loss, cost or expense including attorney's fees and costs, to which the AHBA, RottiEwe Farm, Don or Tracy Parciak, its officers, directors, agents or members might be subject as a result of any claim, suit, loss or damage caused in any way by any act or negligence on my part or on the part of any dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event. I acknowledge that while the AHBA may provide sanctioning for this event with regard to the issuing of titles, it does not have and does not exercise control over the conduct of the event or those present.

I (we) will pay for injuries or replacement value (\$300.00) for Sheep (\$75.00 per head) ducks in the event of the death of any livestock by my or our dogs. If injury to any stock is caused by my/our dog entered or brought to this even, I we assume full responsibility for any damage. I we agree to pay full market value of the injured animal in case of injury or the veterinary bill for the injury, whichever is agreed to by the livestock owner.

I CERTIFY and represent that the dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event is/are not a hazard to other dogs, other animals, or to people. I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owners whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I we agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the AHBA in effect at the time of this herding Test or Trial or both, and further agree to be bound by the agreement printed above. The entry is submitted on the foregoing representation and agreement.

AHBA HRD Course– RottiEwe Farm – 8 Head of Sheep – 20 minutes for Started, 25 minutes for Intermediate and Advanced.

TAKE PEN – (10/10 PTS) **Gate 1** Remove 10 Sheep from the Round Pen/Take Pen. All stock must leave the take pen. Max points for stock leaving the pen calmly and the dog maintaining control of the sheep while the handler is closing **Gate 1**. Element finished when the gate is closed.

Level III – Handler must remain outside the pen.

Level II – Can stand just inside the Gate.

Level I – Handler may enter the pen and may move around to assist the dog.

OBSTACLE 1 Free Standing Wear/Drive Panels. (10/10 PTS) (Sheep will draw to the holding pens) Team should maintain control and try to avoid letting sheep run to the holding pens for maximum points. Team proceeds (Fetch/Drive) to and through PVC Panel Obstacles. Maximum points awarded for negotiating all stock calmly and in control through the obstacles. Handler may not pass between the panels ANY level. Team proceeds to **Gate 2**. Element finished once sheep have reached **Gate 2**.

Level III – Must remain behind Advanced Handlers Line until all stock have cleared the obstacle

Level II – May fetch drive to halfway between obstacle and Advanced handlers line. Handler must remain there until all stock have cleared the obstacle

Level I – May fetch or drive through the obstacles. Handler may not go through the obstacle.

GATHER (10/10 PTS) Team allows sheep to enter field through **Gate 2**. Fetch/Drive sheep to set out area marked with a cone and feed pan. Team proceeds to the appropriate handler cone to perform an OLF. Dog can be sent in either direction and must gather all sheep to the cone. Element finished once sheep have reached the handler at the cone.

DRIVE/FETCH (20/20 PTS) Team Fetch/Drive sheep to **Gate 2**. Sheep should be moved in a straight line in a calm efficient manner. Allow sheep through Gate 2 back into narrow field. Maintain control of sheep and proceed to **Gate 3**. Allow sheep to enter the field through **Gate 3** maintaining control of sheep as they enter the field. Team proceeds Drive/Fetch. Once completed team proceeds to the free-standing pen. Element finished once sheep are within 20 ft of pen.

Level III – Handler must remain at first cone and drive sheep passed the cone at the bottom of the field.

Level II – Fetch/Drive to second cone. Handler must remain 15 ft behind the dog during drive from second cone to cone at bottom of field.

Level I – Fetch/Drive sheep to the cone at bottom of field free-standing pen.

FREE STANDING PEN (15/15 PTS) Team pens all 10 head of sheep into the freestanding pen. Element complete when all sheep have been penned. Sever deduction for NOT penning all the sheep.

Level III – Handlers must hold onto the rope and may not enter the pen.

Level II – Handlers do not have to hold the rope and may enter the pen.

Level I – Handlers do not have to hold the rope and may enter the pen.

Team removes the sheep from the pen and proceeds to **Gate 4**. Team should not allow sheep to crowd **Gate 4**. All 10 sheep enter A Field through **Gate 4**. Maintaining or gain control as sheep enter the A field. Team takes sheep to **Gate 5**. Element finished once sheep are being held by **Gate 5**.

SORT/ALLEYWAY (15/15 PTS) Team works to sort 3 sheep into Gate 5.

Level III – Must sort three marked sheep.

Level II – Must sort two marked sheep.

Level I – Must sort any three sheep.

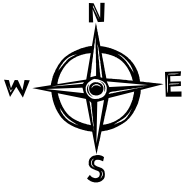
Team leaves 3 sheep in the alleyway pen and proceeds to take the 7 sheep back to **G 4** and leaves the sheep in the PT field. Team goes back to **G5** and enters pen. Team takes 3 sheep to **G6** and reunites 3 sheep with the 7 into the field. Element finished when all 10 sheep are in the field and **G6** is shut.

STOCK TRAILER (0/10 PTS) Team gathers sheep and moves them to **G3**. Team moves sheep into narrow field and proceeds to the Stock trailer. Team may open Trailer door prior to attempting to load trailer. All sheep must be loaded and door closed. Element complete once all sheep have been loaded and unloaded from the trailer.

Level III – Must remain outside the trailer while loading. The Handler may unload/remove the sheep without the dog without penalty.

EXHAUST PEN (10/10 PTS) Team proceeds to **Gate 1**. A hold should be demonstrated before penning the stock. Element finished once all stock are re penned and gate is closed.
