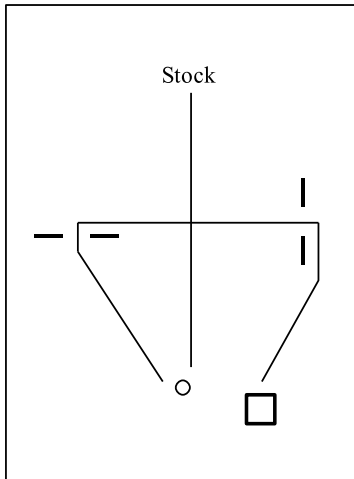

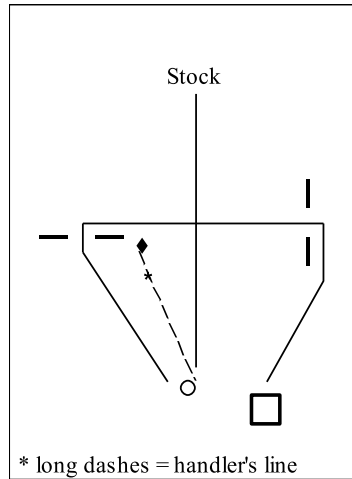
## HTD COURSE DIAGRAMS

The outrun may be done in either direction at all three levels.



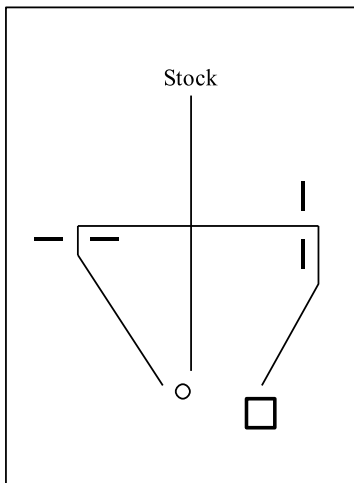
### HTD I

For the gather, the dog is placed along the centerline at a point no closer to the stock than the first set of panels; the handler may move closer to the stock.



### HTD II

For the gather, the dog is set out near the post; the handler may move forward but not past the panels. After moving the stock around the post and to the obstacle, the handler remains here  $\blacklozenge$  or anywhere behind the handler's line while the dog moves the stock through the second obstacle.



### HTD III

For the gather, the dog is set out near the handler's post. The handler remains at the post until time to go to the pen.

Gather for all levels will be 100 yards

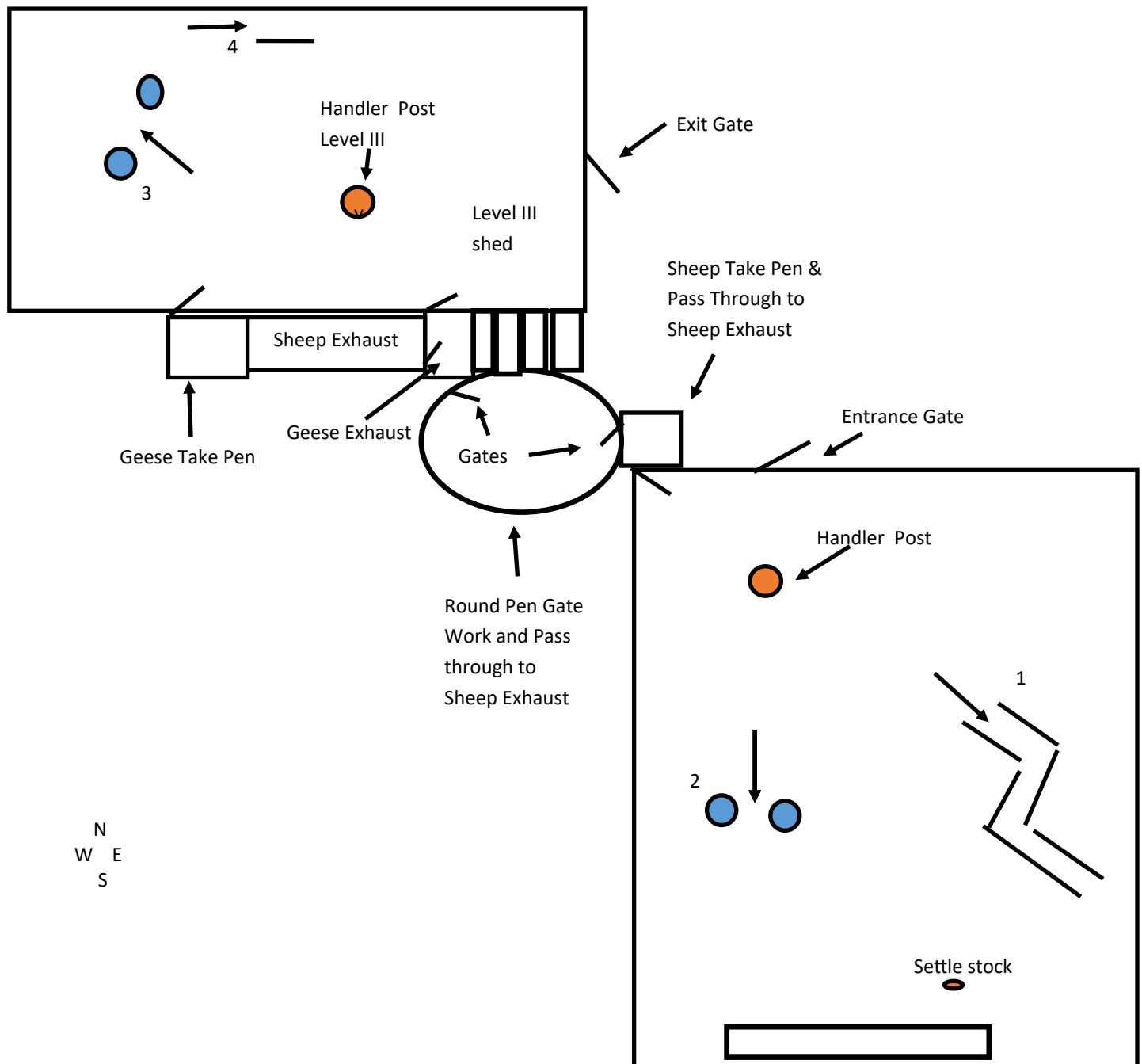
HTD I & II The hold will be after the Freestanding Pen and will be located in between the pen and the second set of panels.

HTDIII will be doing a Ribbon Pull rather than a shed

### Course Description

1. 5 Sheep are taken out of the Take Pen in the South Ring. Level I the handlers may enter the pen to assist without penalty, Level II & III handlers must remain outside of the pen to have the potential of full points.
2. Obstacle 1 Chute to Settle. The Chute is located a minimum of 10' from the East fenceline, sheep are pushed through from North to South. Dogs may or may not enter the chute, however, handlers may not enter the chute at any place. Once the sheep exit the chute they are to be settled near the marker cone approximately 10' from the exit. Handlers will determine when the stock is settled and will call dog off of the stock to prepare for the Gather.
3. Gather. In HRD III, the handler remains at the post while the dog is sent from there to gather the stock. In HRD II, the handler may leave the dog at the handler's post and move to a point approximately halfway between the post and the stock, then send the dog to gather the stock. In HRD I, the handler may leave the dog at a point approximately halfway between the post and the stock and move to approximately 15 ft. from the stock, then send the dog to gather the stock. At all three levels the stock are brought to and around the handler's post in a counterclockwise direction. The gather ends when the stock have gone just past the handler's post.
4. Wear/Drive. The stock are driven 60' to Obstacle 2. HRD III handlers must stay at handler's post. HRD II handlers may do a walking drive (approximately 15' behind the dog) to a point halfway to Obstacle 2, then must remain there for the remainder of the drive. HRD I handlers may accompany the stock up to Obstacle 2 and may fetch or drive the stock. The drive ends when the stock complete Obstacle 2.
5. Penwork to Exhaust Sheep. Once the Sheep exit Obstacle 2 they are taken through the Take Pen into the Round Pen and Exhausted into the sheep alley. Handlers at all levels should show calm stock movement through the pens as well as at the gates. Gates must be left how they are first approached. Exhaust is complete once all of the sheep have entered the sheep alley and the gate is closed.
6. Take Pen Geese. 5 geese are taken out of the Take Pen in the North Ring. Level I the handlers may enter the pen to assist without penalty, Level II & III handlers must remain outside of the pen to have the potential of full points.
7. Wear/Drive to Obstacle 3. HRD III handlers must stay at handler's post and drive the stock 60' to obstacle 3. HRD III handlers may leave the post once the stock have exited Obstacle 3. HRD I & II handlers may accompany the stock up to Obstacle 3 and may fetch or drive the stock. The drive ends when the stock complete Obstacle 3.
8. Obstacle 4. Judging for Obstacle 4 starts once the stock have exited Obstacle 3 and are approaching the shed area for HRD III or the Exhaust Pen for HRD I & II. Obstacle 4 the stock will enter on the west side of the obstacle heading east.
9. Shed (HRD III Only). The geese will be taken to the designated area in between Obstacle 4 and the Exhaust Pen. Any 2 geese will be shed from the group and will be indicated by the judge when they feel that the shed is complete.
10. Exhaust Pen. The stock are taken to the Exhaust and held a short distance off the gate while it is opened and then are re-penned. The run ends when the Exhaust gate is closed after the last animal has exited the arena.
