- All dogs 9 months of age or older may participate in Trials
- Use the official AHBA entry form if not entering electronically
- Each individual is responsible for any damage caused by himself, his family or his dog while in the trial arena or on the trial grounds. Livestock replacement costs: Ducks - \$75, Geese \$125, Goats -\$350, Sheep - \$300 (Double M Stockdogs retains animal). AHBA, Molly Wisecarver, Double M Stockdogs and all trial workers assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- Bitches in season will run in order.. They should be created away from trial arenas when not competing. Please let the trial secretary know.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing.
- Entry confirmation will be sent by email; please be sure to include your email address.
- The trial committee will determine run order prior to the trial.
- Entry fees will only be refunded if request is received before pre-entry closing date.
- Outdoor event – Rain or shine

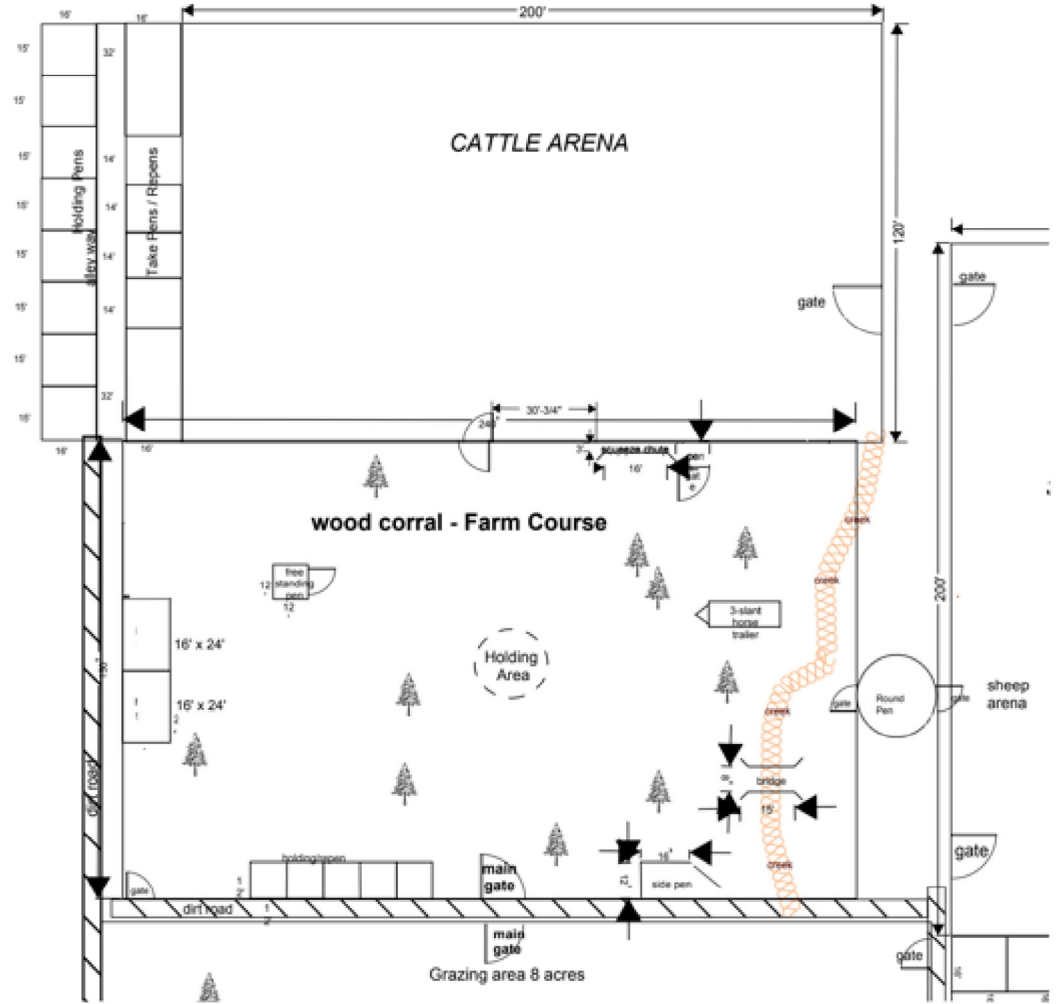

CATTLE FARM CORRAL



Handler enters the cattle arena:

GATHER:

HRD III send from the handlers post, HRD II leave dog at the handlers post and may good ½ way, HRD I may leave the dog at the ½ point and move closer to the sheep.

DRIVE:

HRDIII drive stock to the Ranch field gate staying at the handlers post. HRDII may go halfway to the gate, HRDI may fetch to the gate

GATE INTO RANCH COURSE SORT:

HRDIII sort 3 stock into the arena, shut gate, add remaining stock to the arena, HRDII sort ANY two stock into the arena, shut gate, add remaining stock to the arena, HRDI put all sheep into the arena, shut gate. Gather all stock and head to the Horse Trailer

HORSE TRAILER:

HRDIII stay at the back trailer door, HRDII may move side to side staying within 10 feet of the back door, HRDI may go anywhere.

SIDE PEN:

HRDIII & HRDII pen all stock into the side pen holding onto the rope, HRDI may let go of the rope and move about the pen

BRIDGE:

HRDIII take sheep over the bridge from the East to the West, staying on the east side until all stock is over the bridge, HRDII take sheep over the bridge from the east to the west staying on the East side. HRDI may go anywhere

SINGLE CHUTE:

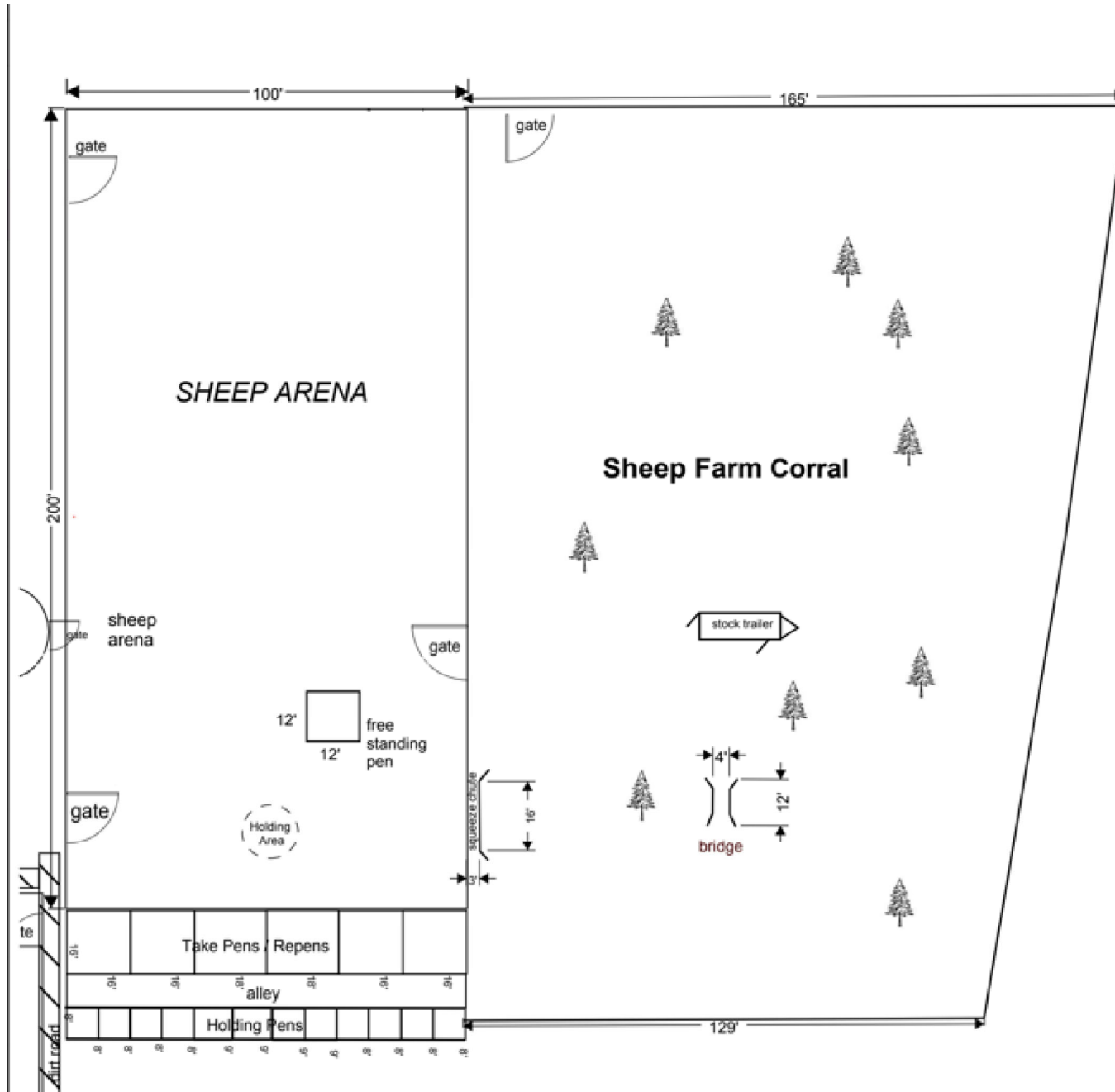
Load stock from the West to the East. HRDIII stay at the back of the chute during loading, moving to the front once loaded, HRDII may walk from the back to the front during loading staying within 5' of the chute, HRDI may go anywhere

GATE TO ARENA:

All levels put the stock back into the arena

RE-PEN

Put your stock into the re-pen, shut gate your run is complete



Handler enters the sheep field ranch course.

GATHER:

HRD III send from the handlers post, HRD II leave dog at the handlers post and may good ½ way, HRD I may leave the dog at the ½ point and move closer to the sheep.

HORSE TRAILER:

HRDIII stay at the back trailer door, HRDII may move side to side staying with in 10 feet of the back door, HRDI may go anywhere.

SINGLE CHUTE:

HRDIII stay at the back of the chute during loading, moving to the front once loaded, HRDII may walk from the back to the front during loading staying within 5' of the chute, HRDI may go anywhere.

BRIDGE:

HRDIII take sheep over the bridge from the East to the West, staying on the east side until all stock is over the bridge, HRDII take sheep over the bridge from the east to the west not passing the middle of the bridge until all stock is over the bridge, HTDI may go anywhere

GATE INTO ARENA SORT:

HRDIII sort 2 marked sheep into the arena, shut gate, add remaining stock to the arena, HRDII sort ANY two sheep into the arena, shut gate, add remaining stock to the arena, HRDI put all sheep into the arena, shut gate.

DRIVE:

HRDIII drive stock to/through the panels at the end of the arena not passing the handlers line, HRDII may go half way to the panels, HRDI may fetch through the panels NOT going through them.

PEN:

HRDIII & HRDII pen all stock into the freestanding pen holding onto the rope, HRDI may let go of the rope and move about the pen

RE-PEN:

ALL LEVELS re-pen all stock
