## TEST/TRIAL RULES

1. Bitches in season may run at the end of TESTS and at any time in TRIALS.
2. For Exhibition Only (FEO) runs are allowed at this trial, and you may run your dog in a class for which it has already qualified. Sanctioned runs take priority. If your run is out of control, you may be asked to end the run. FEO runs will be held immediately after the competitive runs in each class during the day. No dog running a competitive class may also be entered in an FEO run in the SAME class.
3. A registration/tracking number is required for ALL dogs. If your dog is not registered with another organization (AKC, UKC, ASCA, ABCA, etc.), you must apply for a registration number with AHBA.
4. All dogs must be vaccinated for rabies as required by law, vaccinated for other communicable diseases as recommended by your veterinarian, and parasite free.
5. PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS. Poop bags and trash cans are located in multiple locations around the property.
6. All dogs must be on leash or crated except when working.
7. There is very little shade around the herding fields, but there is some shade around the parking areas. Plan accordingly. Water pools will be provided to cool your dog. (And bring yourself a chair!)

## DIRECTIONS TO "AT THE FARM"

1. From I-80 Exit 45 / IL-40 at Sheffield (Exit 45 is the IL-40 / Peoria / Sterling exit)
2. Take the ramp to IL-40 South toward Sheffield, at the Stop Sign, Turn Right.
3. Drive south to the Stop Sign, approx. 3 miles.
4. Turn right/south on N Mason Street/Rt 6, approx. 4.5 miles.
5. 310 N Mason St will be on your left as you enter town, second house with tall evergreens and 6ft wood fence in the front, a long driveway, open grass parking in front (Corner Stone Community Center is next door to our South, old style mobile homes are to our West side of the street)
