Livestock replacement costs are as follows: Ducks - \$50, Turkeys - \$75, Geese - \$150.00, Sheep - \$200.00, Goats - \$300.00. AHBA, Carolina Canine Pet & Performance, Not Quite Right Farm, and all trial workers assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- Bitches in season will run last in test runs. They will run in order for trial runs. They should be crated away from trial arenas when not competing.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing.
- Entry confirmation will be sent by email; please be sure to include your email address.
- Trial committee will determine run order prior to the trial.
- Entry fees will only be refunded if request is received before pre-entry closing date.

All dogs nine months of age or older are eligible to participate in Herding Trials and JHD. Dogs classified as Herding Dogs in AHBA are eligible for HERDING TEST (HCT) and may participate at six months of age or older. No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any Test/Trial. Bitches in season shall run in drawn running order without adjustment.

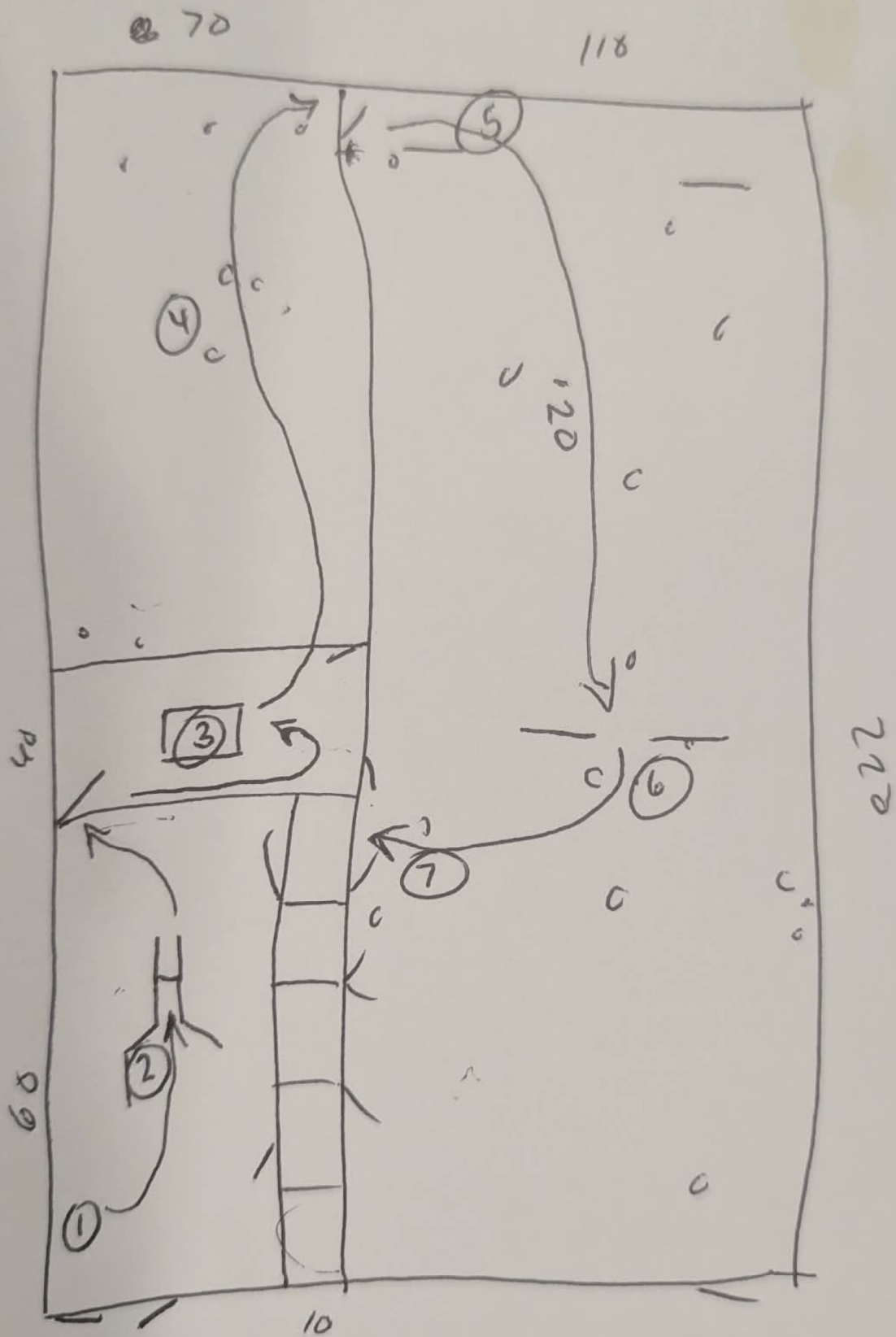

HRD sheep at NQR Farm

Time:1: 15 2: 15 3: 20
Tiebreak 1: Sort 2:Gather

Gather:

Sheep are gathered in barn area and taken to the handling chute

1. Handler may go anywhere in barn
2. Handler may go halfway to sheep
3. Handler must stay within a crook length of chute (15)

Chute:

Sheep are run through the headchute, and then taken into the dry lot area

1. All sheep are run through the chute
2. All sheep are run through the chute
3. Last 2 sheep are blocked and turned back.(15/20)

Trailer load:

Sheep are loaded onto trailer by the team and gate closed. They are then unloaded.

1. Handler and dog unload on lead by side door
2. Handler and dog may unload on lead by side door.
3. Dog unloads, by side door or back.(20 pts)

Trees:

Sheep are taken through gate into tree lot, through patch of trees to far gate and enter Sheep arena.(15pts)

Drive:

Sheep are driven around panel 5 to panel 6

1. Handler remains near panel 5 until sheep clear panel 6
2. Handler may go halfway to panel 6 to start drive
3. Handler may go anywhere but inside panel 6 .(10/15)

Repen::

Sheep are exhausted through pen at 7 (15pts)

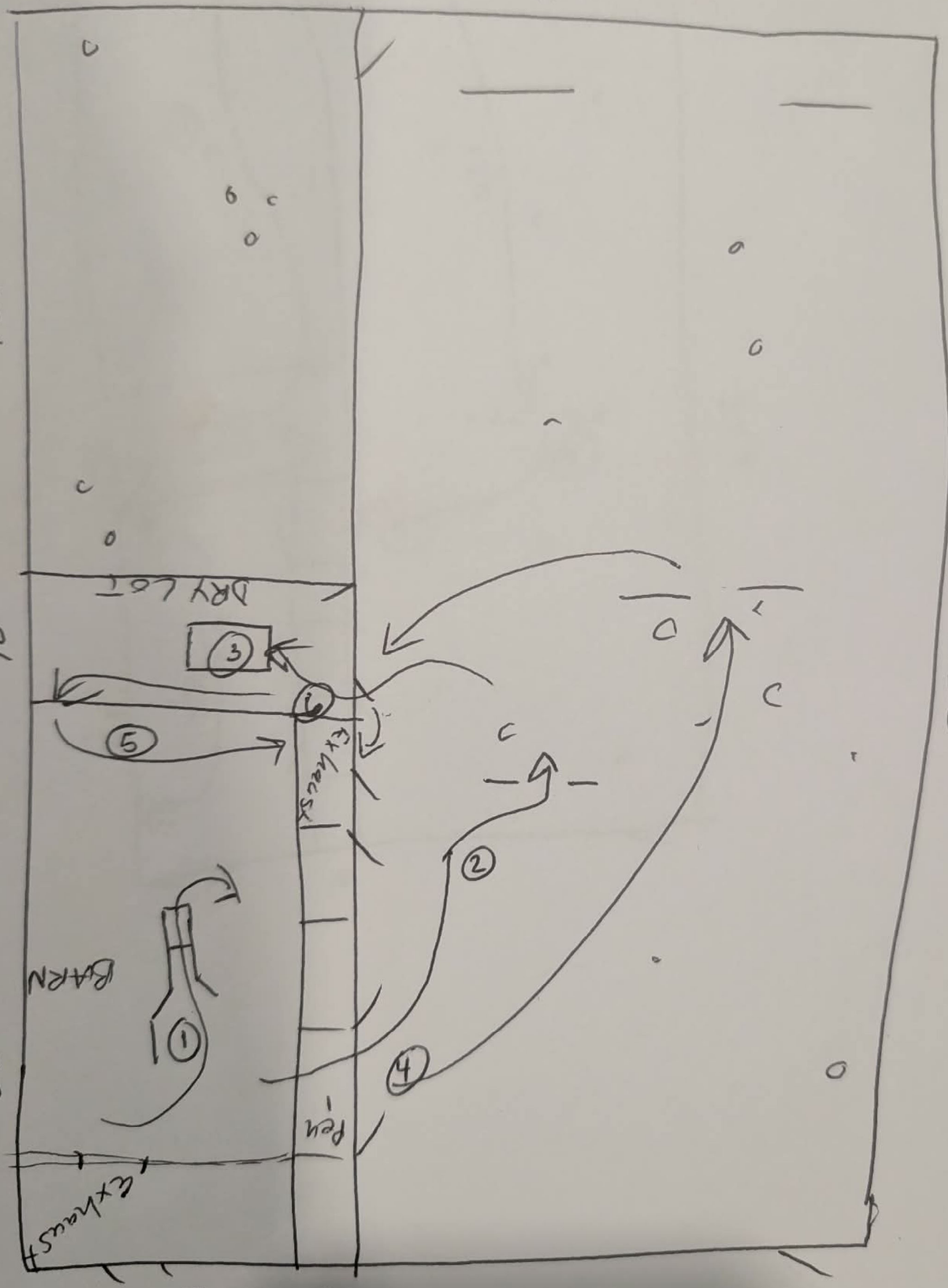

HRD multi at NQR Farm

Time:1: 15 2: 15 3: 20

Tiebreak 1:Birds Trailer load 2:Sheep panels

Birds:

Take control of birds and gather, then take birds through headgate chute and into Pen 1.

3: Handler stays within a crook length from chute at all times

2: Handler may move to halfway to birds on gather.

1: Handler may move anywhere necessary

(20)

Bird panels:

Birds are taken out of Pen 1 and taken through free standing panels to gate (10)

Birds trailer:

Birds are taken through gate and loaded onto trailer and trailer secured.

(15)

Sheep panels:

Sheep are taken from Pen 1 and fetched/driven through free standing panels. Once sheep are turned left driving handlers may move to gate.

3. Handler must stay at Pen 1 arena side gate

2. Handler may go ½ way to panels, dog near Pen 1 arena side gate

3. Handler may fetch/drive but not walk through panels

(15/20)

Sheep repen:

Sheep are gate sorted into dry lot behind barn. Upper level groups take 3 into barn then into repen, return and exhaust 2 into same pen from arena side. Level one takes all 5 into barn into repen.

(10/15)

.Bird Repen:

Birds are removed from trailer by handler, taken into barn and exhausted at far end of barn.(15)

3: Birds are removed by handler, dog waits outside

1 & 2 Birds are removed by handler, dog may be tied off to the side safely only during unload.

(20 pts)

RLF TURKEY at NQR Farm (Sept2025)

Sort:

Turkeys are gathered from take pen(1).

1: No turkeys are sorted, all are gathered.

2: No turkeys are sorted, all are gathered.

3: 5 white/sweetgrass/palm/calico turkeys are sorted back into the take pen.

(10/20pts)

Gather:

Turkeys are gathered (2) and taken counter clockwise around the handlers post/mulberry tree (3) then fetched to the area of the sycamore tree(4).

1. Handler can set dog half way and go to within 15 ft for gather, fetch or drive.
2. Handler can set dog at handler's post and go half way to stock for gather, fetch or drive
3. Handler send dog from foot at handler's post for gather, fetch or drive(20pts)

Drive:

Turkeys are taken clockwise around the sycamore (4) and then driven to corner obstacle entrance(5).

- 1: Turkeys are fetched/driven.
- 2: Turkeys are fetched/driven to level with handler's post, then driven to obstacle entrance
- 3: Turkeys are driven to obstacle entrance(20pts)

Barrels:

The turkeys are then fetched/driven through the corner obstacle, ensuring that no birds are left behind, and taken to gate to Duck arena (6).

1. Turkeys are fetched/driven though corner obstacle, handler may enter obstacle
2. Turkeys are fetched/driven though corner obstacle, handler may not enter.
3. Turkeys are driven through corner obstacle, handler may come up to handler's post line (20 pts)

Return :

Turkeys are taken through gate into Duck Arena (6) and fetch/drive through tree/panel to exhaust gate. Turkeys are then exhausted through gate(20pts)

1. Fetch/drive
2. Fetch/drive. Gate sort 5 in, then the rest.
3. Fetch/drive. Gate sort 5 in, then the rest.(20pts)
