IMPORTANT INFORMATION

AHBA RULE: Registration/tracking number is required for ALL dogs. This can be from any canine organization, or you can contact AHBA for a free number.

TEST/TRIAL RULES: Test/Trials are held in accordance with current AHBA rules posted at www.ahba-herding.org.

FARM RULES:

- All dogs must have current vaccination for rabies and other communicable diseases as recommended by your veterinarian, and should be parasite free.
- **PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS**... poop bags are available around the farm.
- All dogs must be on a leash or crated when not working.
- **NO FLEXI-TYPE LEASHES ARE ALLOWED ON THE FARM.** Please keep your dogs on a short leash at all times.
- Water pools are provided, but there is little or no shade, so plan accordingly.

FIRST HANDLER'S MEETING AT 8:00 AM

HERDING RANCH DOG (HRD)

(A Farm map and diagrams of the Weave and Box are attached)

Level III - 10 sheep - Total Points 100

Level II and I - 10 sheep - Total Points 90

1 Gather and Fetch (Level III 25 points Level II 15 points; Level I 15 points)

Level III handler goes to post, gathers 10 sheep and sheds into two groups of 5. Handler pens the sheep that were cut off. Handler tells dog to look back and picks up remaining 5 sheep, which will be held off the set out pens.

Level II handler goes to post, gathers 5 sheep and pens them ... fetch line is from set out to Pen #1. Handler takes dog back to handlers post to gather second set of 5 sheep, held off set out pens.

Level I handler goes to posts gathers 5 sheep and pens them ... fetch line is from set out directly to Pen #1.

2 Drive/Wear (Level III 10 points; Level II 15 points; Level I 15 points)

Level III drives the second set of sheep around Cone 1 and takes them to Pen #2. Handler stays outside pen #1 until sheep pass Cone 1, then Level III handler may go to second pen.

Level II handler gathers second set of sheep and drives sheep around Cone #1 and pens sheep in Pen. #2 ... Level II handler drives sheep, but may walk along side or behind the dog.

Level I gathers sheep from handlers post and wear/drive sheep around cone 1 and pens sheep in pen #2.

3 Moving to North Arena (Level III 5 points; Level II 5 points; Level I 5 points)

All levels ... handler takes sheep out of Pen #2, takes them up to first pen so handler has all sheep out of pens and together on field. Handler takes all sheep through North Arena into Big Field ... sheep should go through the gates quietly, points will be deducted if they do not. Handler may stand anywhere.

4 Taking sheep into the Big Field (Level III 5 points; Level II 10 points; Level I 10 points)

Sheep should go in as straight as possible through the gate into the Big Field ... sheep should go through the gates quietly, points will be deducted if they do not. Handler should close both gates behind them. Sheep should not escape to far gate.

5 Weave Pen (Level III 20 points; Level I 15 points; Level I 15 points)

Sheep enter left side of divided pen and exit through right side (while facing obstacle).

Level III must stand behind handlers line 5 feet away from obstacle.

Level II must stand at entrance of obstacle.

Level I may move around obstacle, but may not enter it

All levels will have four tries to get sheep started into obstacle before moving on.

6 Box Load and Unload (Level III 20 points; Level II 15 points; Level 15)

Sheep must go in north opening and exit through south exit. Points taken for sheep slipping out through side gates.

Level III must stay in one chosen quadrant.

Level II can move around two sides of obstacle.

Level I may move anywhere.

7 Bridge (Level III 10 points; Level II 10 points; Level I 10 points)

Sheep cross bridge from east to west.

Level III must stand in one place at entrance to bridge.

Level II may move around bring.

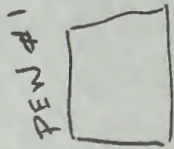
Level I can cross bridge with sheep. **ALL handlers must cross bridge either before or after sheep.**

8 Repen (Level III 5 points; Level II 5 points; Level I 5 points)

All 10 sheep should be penned into Maple Arena and then into the Gravel Arena.

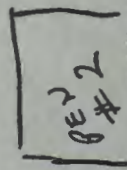

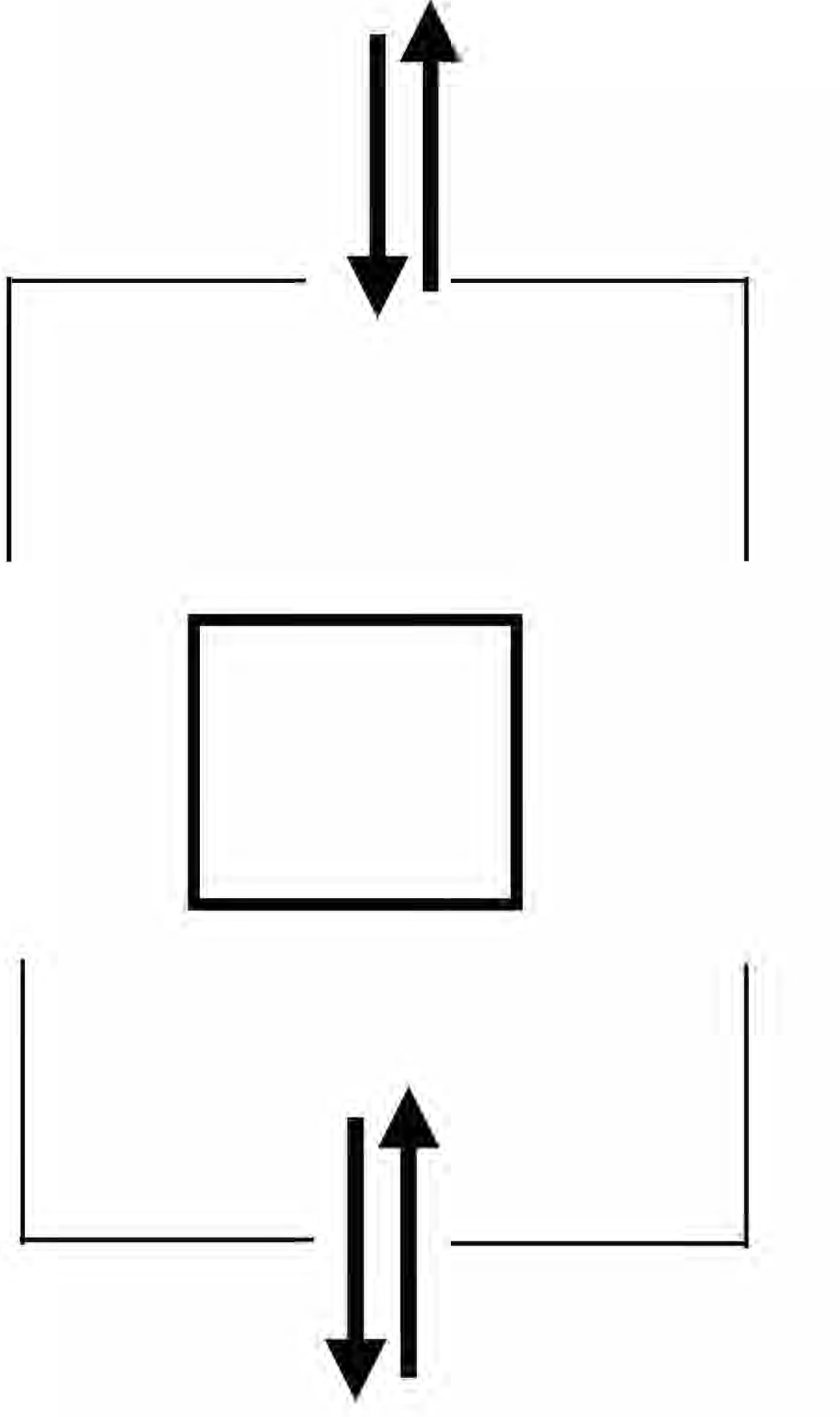

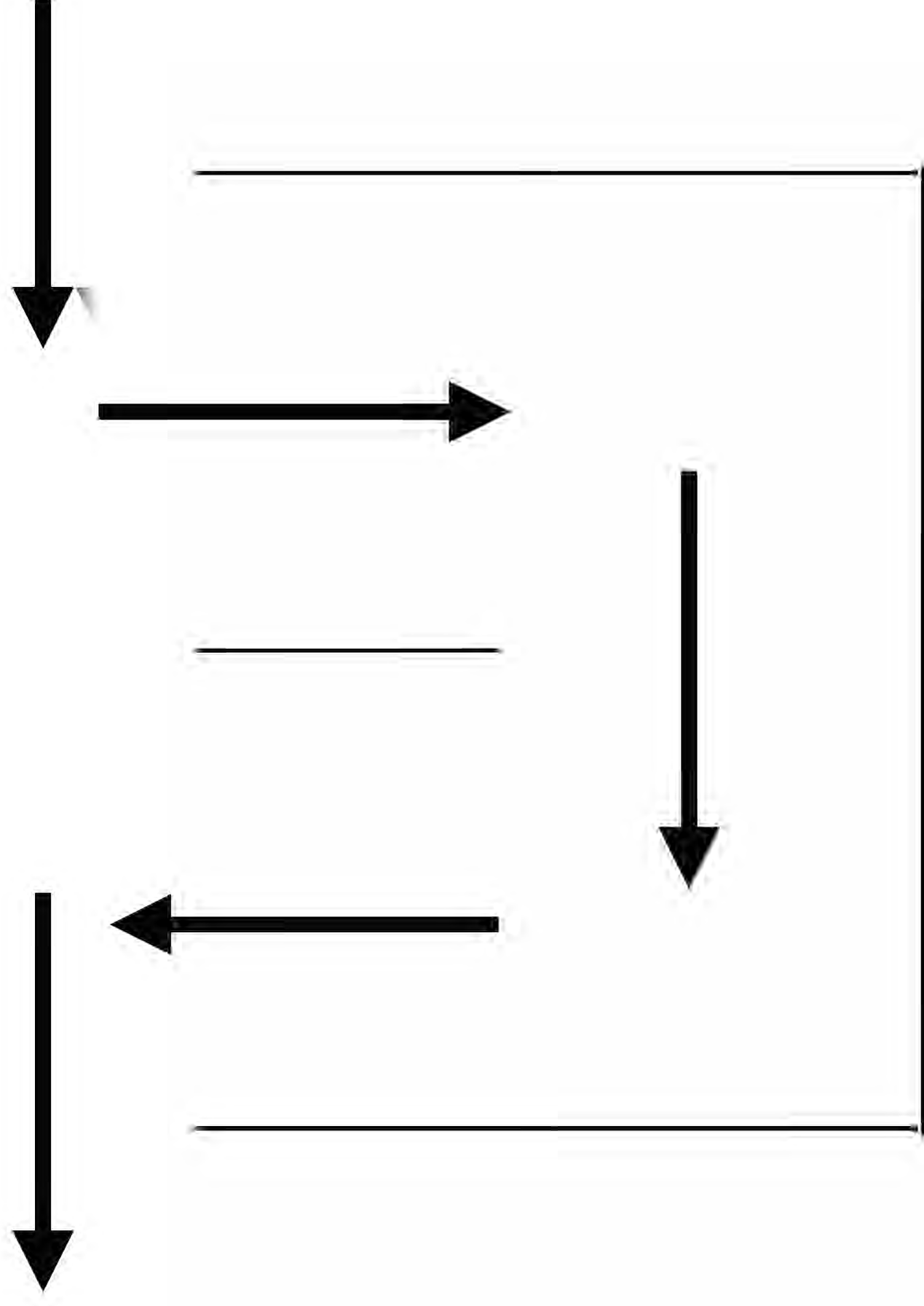

Handler and Owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property. In the event the entered dog injures any livestock, the owner will pay for veterinarian services. If the injury is severe, the owner will pay the market value or value stated in the premium list of the stock injured.

Handler and Owner acknowledge that herding events are inherently dangerous and have risks of injury to persons. Handler and Owner agree to assume the risk of any harm arising from the hazards associated with the herding event which include but are not limited to, parking areas, ground conditions, animals, stock used in the herding event, and other dogs.

Handler and Owner hereby release AHBA, its officers, directors agents and members, including Shannon Wolfe, Magic's Legacy (its officers, agents and directors) and the owners of the site of the event, from any and all liability for any injury, loss or damage, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property which occurs directly or indirectly or associated with the herding event.
