Step-by-Step Course Description

1. Take-Pen

Score-sheet item: Take-pen; movement of stock through gates; stock settled behind Corn Crib.

Starts when the handler opens the take-pen gate. Ends when the stock are settled behind the Corn Crib. HRD I handlers may enter the take pen. HRD II handlers may go just inside the entrance. HRD III handlers may not enter the pen.

2. Gather

Score-sheet item: Gather stock; wear/dive through center panel obstacle P1; wear/dive to 20 ft from corner panel obstacle P2.

Starts when the handler and dog reach the designated handler position at P1. Ends when the stock reach a point 20 ft from P2. P1 consists of two 12-ft panels with a 12-ft opening and is approximately 120 ft from the stock gather location. HRD III handler position is the marked 20-ft window centered on P1, extending 10 ft north and 10 ft south.

3. Proceed through Obstacle P2 and then Wear/Drive Along Back Fence — Cross-Drive Part 1

Score-sheet item: Wear/dive along back fence from 20 ft from corner panel obstacle P2 to G3 (cross-drive part 1).

Starts when the stock reach the 20-ft point from P2. Ends when the stock reach G3. HRD III handler remains at the designated Section 2 handler position until the stock reach G3.

4. Drive G3 → P3 → G1 — Cross-Drive Part 2

Score-sheet item: Wear/dive from G3 through center alley obstacle P3 to G1 (cross-drive part 2).

Starts when the stock reach G3. Ends when the stock reach G1. HRD II handler position is the marked line at the mouth of P3. HRD III handler begins at the post at G3 and may leave that post when the stock complete P3. P3 consists of 12-ft panels with a 4-ft alley and approximately 45-degree wings.

5. Crowding Pen / Chute / Sort / Repen

Score-sheet item: Crowding pen; chute; sort; repen; movement of stock to G4.

Starts when the stock enter the Handling Pen. Ends when the stock reach G4. HRD I and HRD II perform a ribbon-pull sort; HRD III performs a shed/sort of two sheep. Repenning is included in this section.

6. Trailer Load

Score-sheet item: Movement from G4; trailer load; movement through trailer/Y-chute.

Starts when the stock reach G4. Ends when the trailer load is complete. The trailer/Y-chute is the designated loading obstacle. The final trailer load is scored here; unloading is not part of this section.

7. Exhaust

Score-sheet item: Unload from trailer; movement of stock to exhaust.

Starts after the trailer load is complete. Ends when the stock reach the designated exhaust. This section establishes the end of the course and is scored separately from the trailer load.
